## OUTSTANDING FIELDS FOR APG ELIMINATORS

**IT MAY ONLY BE A TUESDAY AFTERNOON FIXTURE, HOWEVER, TABCORP PARK MENANGLE'S 10-RACE PROGRAM IS SET TO BE ONE OF THE MOST TALKED ABOUT THIS YEAR!**

In fact, the amount of young pacing talent for the heats of the Australian Pacing Gold on Tuesday is such that the program could dominate headlines during an Inter Dominion week.

Names such as Major Bronski, For A Reason, Renaissance Man, Chariot King, Cuttheattitude and Stunin Girl will all contest heats of the APG, with all qualifiers run over 1609 metres.

In the Colts and Geldings division, crack youngsters For A Reason will go head-to-head with Renaissance Man in the first heat, with the pair drawing barriers one and five respectively.

In the second heat for the boys, emerging star Major Bronski has come up with the pole and should dominate the event from start to finish, with Composed (10), Blacker Than Red (seven) and Its My Pleasure (eight) likely to fight out the minors.

The final heat will see the top ranked NSW youngsters in Cuttheattitude (three) and Chariot King (four) do battle with another local, the emerging Clarrie Greene (eight),

Queenslander Maywyn Jasper (two) and talented Victorian, Remember El (one).

As for the fillies, Pink Bonnet winner Natural Ace (two) looks to be a good hope along with Victorian Rocknrolla (four), while Dancewithagrin (one) and Wattabout A Smile (nine) the others with claims.

APG two-year-old champion Mach And Me resumes from gate four in heat two and will do battle with the talented Stunin Girl (eight), Bonnie Mahoney (seven) and impressive debut winner, Reneging (two).

The last heat for the fillies has Morgan Abby (nine), Art Princess (seven), Gemmia (three) and Grecian Promise (five) engaged in what should be a keenly contested affair.

As well as the heat of the APG, there are four support races on the card which contain full fields and a host of talent.

The standout will be the opening heat of the Alabar Australasian Young Drivers Championship, with the best young talent in both Australia and New Zealand doing battle over a number of rounds.

First race on the program is at 12:45pm.
