The Inter-Dominion Championship.—This non-penalty race is divided into nine heats each of £1,000 and a Final of £10,000. The heats will be run as follows:—

- 3 heats over 11 furlongs on 11th February.
- 3 heats over 2 miles less 110 yards on 18th February.
- 3 heats over 12½ furlongs on 22nd February.

The £10,000 final will be run over 14 furlongs at 9.45 p.m. on 25th February.

The maximum handicap allotted any horse shall not exceed 36 yards. There shall be no re-handicaps after the issue of the original handicaps for the various heats.

Qualifying points shall be awarded to the placed horses in each heat as follows:—First horse, 4 points; second horse, 2 points; third horse, 1 point. Two points shall be awarded to the horse running the fastest time in each heat, and one point shall be awarded to the horse running the second fastest time in each heat.

In the event of a dead-heat, the points of the dead-heating horses, including any for fastest or second fastest time, shall be divided equally. The ten horses which gain the greatest aggregate of points shall be eligible to start in the Final, but the Board reserves the right to increase that number and to select additional starters. Where horses gain the same number of points, the Board shall decide which shall start in the Final. The Final shall be a straight-out race. To be eligible for the Final, horses must start in at least two heats.

CERTIFICATES, etc.—A certificate will be presented to the owner of the winning horse in each heat, and Special Sashes will be presented to the owners of the horses placed first, second, third and fourth in the Final.

A COMMEMORATIVE BADGE will be presented to every driver taking part in the Championships, including heats.

The Championships comprise:—

The Hambletonian Centenary, of £1,000. This non-penalty race is for approved trotters assessed at 2.26 or better in Victoria, or the equivalent mark in other States or New Zealand at date of nomination (12th December, 1949). The race will be run here at 8.30 p.m. on 25th February, over a distance of 14 furlongs, all horses off scratch.

The Stamps (Betting Tax) Act 1946 requires a bookmaker to charge to or collect from the backer, and a backer to pay to a bookmaker at the time of making any cash bet in which the amount wagered is equal to or in excess of £5, betting tax in accordance with the following scale:—
