BETTING DISPUTES — FLAT

"PLACE TOTE" DIVIDENDS will be paid on the basis 1, 2, 3 when eight or more starters are left in the race and 1, 2 when there are five and not more than seven starters.

Extracts from Regulations under Lottery and Gaming Acts

CONTROL OF QUEUES.

7. (1) Persons approaching any window of a Totalizator shall form up in a queue in single file extending away from such window.

(2) When any such queue has been formed, no person shall approach the window to which such queue leads except as a member of such queue.

8. No person shall—

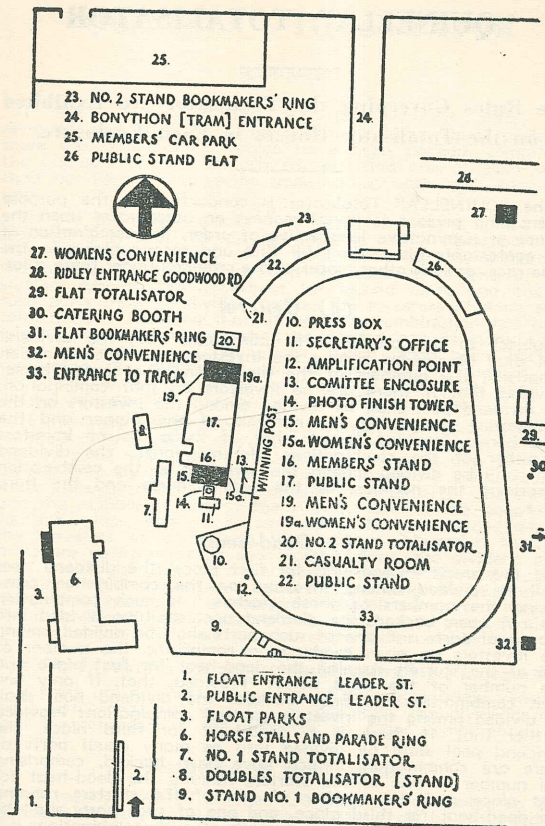
- (a) push into any such queue, or join the same except at the rear end thereof;
- (b) take precedence of any person who from his position has a prior right in any queue;
- (c) stand or walk between any queues so formed, or within four yards of either side of the outside queues;
- (d) pass money or a ticket to any person in any queue.

9. Every person shall at all times observe and comply with any reasonable direction by any member of the Police Force as to:—

- (a) the manner of approaching to or departing from any totalizator;
- (b) the conduct of such person in the vicinity of any totalizator.

PENALTIES.

10. Any person who contravenes any provision of regulation 7, 8, or 9 hereof, whether by omission or commission, shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding £10 for every breach of such provision.



"QUINELLA" TOTALISATOR

The Rules Governing the Totalisator are Exhibited on the Totalisator Houses in Each Enclosure

The "QUINELLA" Totalisator is conducted for the purpose of enabling persons to invest moneys on horse races upon the chance of nominating, irrespective of order, the combination of two contestants which shall fill first and second places in the same race, or such other places as are provided under these rules.

(a) General

Subject to the provisions of paragraph (b), the dividend pool shall be divided among the investors on the combination comprising the numbers of the winner and the second horse; Provided that if there are no investors on that combination, the dividend pool shall be divided among the investors on the combination comprising the numbers of the winner and the third horse: Provided further that, if there are no investors on either of the combinations aforementioned, the dividend pool shall be divided among the investors on the combination comprising the numbers of the second horse and the third horse.

(b) Dead-heats

If two starters dead-heat for first place, the dividend pool shall be divided among investors on the combination comprising the numbers of those starters. If such combination has not been backed, the dividend pool shall be divided into two equal parts and one of such parts shall be divided among the investors on each combination comprising the number of one of the starters running the dead-heat for first place and the number of the third horse: Provided, that, if only one such combination has been backed, the dividend pool shall be divided among the investors on that combination: Provided further that, if there is a dead-heat for third place, the dividend pool shall be divided into as many equal parts as there are combinations, which have been backed, comprising the number of one of the starters running the dead-heat for first place and the number of one of the starters running the dead-heat for third place, and one of such parts shall be divided among the investors on each of such combinations.

"QUINELLA" TOTALISATOR

(Continued)

If three or more starters dead-heat for first place, the dividend pool shall be divided into as many equal parts as there are combinations, which have been backed, comprising the numbers of two of such starters, and one of such parts shall be divided among the investors on each such combination.

If two or more starters dead-heat for second place the dividend pool shall be divided into as many equal parts as there are combinations, which have been backed, comprising the number of the winner and the number of one of the starters running the dead-heat for second place and one of such parts shall be divided among the investors of each such combination: Provided that, if no such combination has been backed, the dividend pool shall be divided into as many equal parts as there are combinations, which have been backed, comprising the number of two of the starters running the dead-heat for second place, and one of such parts shall be divided among the investors on such combination.

If there are no investors on the combination comprising the numbers of the winner and the second horse and two or more starters dead-heat for third place, the dividend pool shall be divided into as many equal parts as there are combinations, which have been backed, comprising the number of the winner and the number of one of the starters running the dead-heat for third place, and one of such parts shall be divided among the investors of each such combination: Provided that, if there are no investors on such combinations, the dividend pool shall be divided into as many equal parts as there are combinations which have been backed, comprising the number of the second horse and the number of one of the starters running the dead-heat for third place, and one of such parts shall be divided among the investors of each such combinations.

(c) No Investors on Any Combination of Placegetters

If there are no investors on any of the combinations referred to in paragraphs (a) and (b) of this Rule, the dividend pool shall be refunded to the investors on other combinations of starters.

Refunds on Non-Starters

The money invested on the "QUINELLA" Totalisator on any combination which includes a non-starter shall be refunded in full upon production and delivery of the ticket.

At the request of the Police Department the following by-law under the Adelaide Showgrounds Act (1929) is published for the information of patrons.

CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR.

- (1) No person shall at any time on the Showgrounds, without the written consent of the Council, consume any liquor whatsoever except in such booths, luncheon or refreshment rooms, stalls or other places as set apart by the Council for the consumption of liquor.
- (2) Where any consent is given in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (1) of this by-law, the Council may impose any terms or conditions it thinks fit and if any person consume liquor otherwise than in accordance with such terms and conditions or any of them, he shall be guilty of an offence.
- (3) In this by-law "liquor" shall have the same meaning as assigned to it in Section 4 of the Licensing Act, 1922-1945.

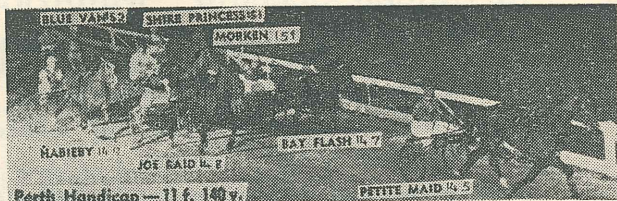

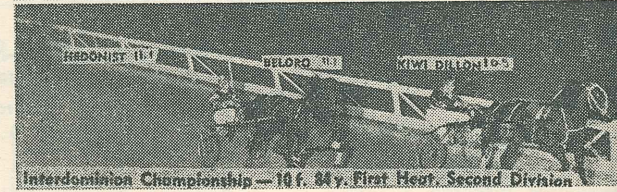
