

#### Version STEWARDS REPORT

HAROLD PARK-Friday, 9th February, 1973

GENERAL.

Trainer K. Robinson was questioned at length concerning not only his nomination of a driver for Heath at the Kembla Grange meeting on 30th January, but also whether he had acted responsibly in the circumstances by finally nominating a comparitively inexperienced and unknown driver when the horse had been previously driven by himself. The inquiry was adjourned to a date to be fixed.

GRADUATION STAKES (113/4 f.)—In the race home Royal Pacework (O. W. Glendenning) drifted out slightly under pressure. A warning was issued. Waitawhile Boy (D. King) accidently sustained a punctured tyre during the race.

THREE-YEAR-OLD FILLIES STAKES (113 f.)-Scotch Mirth (N. B. Hargraves), which had been drawn on the outside of the front mark, was very fractious at the barrier and delayed the start. A warning was issued, and the horse will continue to be included in the outside draw. In the final lap, Apsley Miss (C. R. Allan) hung out off the rails when leading. A warning was issued. As the field straightened for the run home M. Hartney (Linda Ferris) moved his horse wider on the track when insufficiently clear of Candy Kisses (N. Sparkes). This caused the offside wheel of Linda Ferris to contact the near hind leg of Candy Kisses. As a result Candy Kisses became unbalanced and fell. M. Hartney was charged under Rule 261 and his driving licence was suspended for four weeks. The Club's Veterinary Surgeon reported that Candy Kisses had sustained abrasions to the near nostril and to the chest, but was apparently otherwise unharmed.

WELCOME STAKES  $(9\frac{1}{2} f.)$ —Don Hal got down in the float on the way to the course. The Club's

Veterinary Surgeon inspected the horse and declared that in his opinion it was fit to race. In the run up to the start Don Hal (H. Hol), which was drawn on the outside of the front row, did not fill it's barrier position. Although Don Hal was giving its driver some difficulty, H. Hol was severely reprimanded for failing to make more effort to urge his horse forward into its position. Also, a warning was issued in respect of Don Hal. Light Jen (S. Ward), after occupying a favourable trailing position in a one-wide position for the majority of the race, failed to run on as well as expected. S. Ward stated that the horse hung badly and raced roughly on each bend, and in his opinion was unsuited by the left hand racing. In view of these factors, the horse was barred from left-hand racing until S. Ward can demonstrate that the horse was likely to race truly under these conditions. The Club's Veterinary Surgeon reported that Light Jen showed evidence of having struck itself inside the near fore pastern. Galligarin (C. J. Caffyn) galloped twice in running without interference. The Club's Veterinary Surgeon reported that the horse had sustained hopple chafe to both forearms. A warning was issued in respect of Galligarin for breaking in running.

FIRST PACERS' MOBILE FREE-FOR-ALL (9½ f.)—After trainer K. Robinson reported that Valencia Bay had not travelled well to the course, the horse was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon, who declared that in his opinion Valencia Bay was fit to race. The start was delayed when Princess Light (A. Young) damaged a kneeboot in its preliminary, necessitating a replacement. In the home straight coming to the bell, Alecane (J. E. Binskin) missed its gait for a few strides, and lost a little ground. After the race the horse showed signs of having struck itself. A warning was issued. After entering the home straight early in the race Welcome Advice (A. G. Harpley) faltered for a few strides, when it attempted to savage Sahtina

on the neck. As a result, Sahtina was slightly inconvenienced. A warning was issued in respect of Welcome Advice, and the Stewards accepted A. G. Harpley's assurance that this was the first occasion on which his horse had shown this tendency.

N.S.W. YOUTHFUL STAKES—FINAL (1 m.)
—At the start Flying Heel was slow to move, and
Amber Craig, which was drawn directly behind
was checked and galloped for a few strides. Also
Prince Alti, which was drawn on the second line,
was severely checked when Tomsk (K. Newman)
and Gem Duval (M. Govers), which were on the
front line, galloped off the mark. Further, Speedy
Craig (W. Picken, Junr.) galloped and lost ground.
Gypsy King (l. King) broke in running. As a result,
a hopple-carrying strap became detached. This
incident caused Speedy Craig to be checked.

SECOND PACERS' MOBILE FREE-FOR-ALL  $(9\frac{1}{2}$  f.)—At one stage of the run-up to the start Just So (G. Turnbull) progressed a short distance past the inside extremity of the barrier. An inquiry that was opened into the incident was adjourned. In the run home a tyre of War Stamp (V. W. Frost) blew out.

TROTTERS' FREE-FOR-ALL (13 f. & 98 yds.)—After Notissa did not race up to expectations, trainer-driver J. Johnston was given permission to again race the horse in half-hopples.

WATSON'S BAY HANDICAP (11\frac{3}{4} f.)—Leaving the back straight in the middle stages Deep Volo (B. J. Forrester) hung out slightly when racing on the inside of Bret Armagh (K. Wills). As a result the off hind leg of Deep Volo contacted the wheel of Bret Armagh. The official film confirmed the Stewards observations that Deep Volo and not its driver was at fault. A warning was issued in respect of Deep Volo. At the start Bret Armagh (K. Wills) hesitated and galloped. A warning was issued.

# BETTING WITH BOOKMAKERS

Betting with Bookmakers on this course is governed by the Rules of Betting of the New South Wales Trotting Club, and the conduct of betting is governed by the Betting Regulations of the New South Wales Trotting Club.

The following information, which has been extracted from the Betting Rules and Regulations, relates to bets made on the course on the day of the race, and is published to assist patrons. Further or fuller information may be sought from the Betting Supervisors on the course:—

A horse is a starter when it has been called to the barrier by the Starter, provided that it has not been declared a non-starter before All-Clear is declared.

Betting on photo-finishes is prohibited.

Betting one-two (as distinct from Quinella betting) is prohibited.

Bets are void if the race is postponed to another day or is ordered to be re-run on another day.

Dead-heats.—If two or more horses dead-heat for first place, the investor for a win on any horse that has so dead-heated is entitled to be paid the sum of the stakes (i.e., the amount written on the betting ticket) divided by the number of horses dead-heating.

Doubles Betting.—When first-leg horse is withdrawn, the bet is off and the stake returned.

When first-leg horse runs and is beaten, the bet is lost.

When first-leg horse wins and second-leg horse is not a starter, the investor is paid at the first-leg horse's starting price odds declared by the Stewards.

When one horse wins and the other horse deadheats, the investor is entitled to half the sum of the stakes (i.e., half the amount written on the betting ticket).

When both horses dead-heat, the investor is entitled to one-quarter of the sum of the stakes (i.e., one-fourth of the amount written on the betting ticket).

Place Betting.—If there were eight or more horses in the race when the wager was laid, place bets must be paid by the bookmaker on the horses placed first, second and third at the time All-Clear is declared.

If there were five, six or seven horses in the race when the wager was laid, place bets must be paid by the bookmaker on the horses placed first and second at the time All-Clear is declared.

Each-Way Betting.—If there were eight or more horses in the race when the bet was made, place bets must be paid on the first, second and third horses at one-fourth of the odds for the win bet. If there were five, six or seven horses in the race when the bet was made, place bets must be paid on the first and second horses at one-third of the odds for the win bet.

Limited Bets.—In the Paddock enclosure at Harold Park Paceway, a bookmaker, if required by an investor, must lay the odds on offer to an investor's stake of \$40, but is not compellable to lose more than \$600 on any one wager.

The limits in the Leger enclosure at Harold Park Paceway are \$20 and \$300, respectively.

For each-way betting the limits are: Paddock, \$40 each-way and \$800; Leger, \$20 each-way and \$400.


For doubles betting the limits are: Paddock, \$10 and \$800; Leger, \$4 and \$400.

Bookmakers on this course are very strictly controlled by the Club, and are required to conform

to many requirements imposed upon them by several Acts of Parliament and by the Rules and Regulations of this Club. Among other things, they are required to be courteous; to commence betting upon the sounding of a signal five minutes after All-Clear has been notified for the previous race; to display odds for every runner in a race; to settle bets immediately upon the presentation of winning tickets; to write legibly on their betting tickets.

Betting Tickets.—The betting ticket that is given to you by a bookmaker is your documentary evidence of the bet you have made. You are urged to make sure, before leaving the bookmaker, that he has written on the betting ticket sufficient letters to identify the horse on which you have invested and in addition, the sum of the stakes. You are entitled to require a bookmaker to rewrite a ticket which you believe to be illegible or not to represent the bet you claim to have made.

Further, patrons are urged to safeguard their betting tickets, for if they are lost or mislaid it is most difficult for patrons to prove their bets. Naturally, the Club will do everything it can to assist patrons who find themselves in difficulty, but it must be realised that the Club has no obligations in this regard. A satisfactory settlement of these matters is sometimes reached if the investor can remember the bookmaker with whom he bet, the exact details of the wager, and the approximate time when the wager was made. The investor may further assist his claims if he reports to the Betting Supervisor immediately he discovers that he has lost his ticket.
