GLOBE DERBY PARK — SATURDAY, 31st JANUARY, 1976

Race 1 Free Hall Four-Years-Old Handicap

LELTA (D. Lambert) and SHINY GLENFERN (J. Hryhorec) both missed the start checking COTTAGE HOMES (W. Cormack) and OPERA PRIDE (M. Evans). FIVE O'CLOCK (T. Lucas) missed the start and will remain out of the barrier draw.

GRECIAN HONEY (R. Cox) raced with a flat tyre for almost the entire journey.

Race 2 Cardigan Bay Stakes

GAY PLAZA (R. Hill) sustained a flat tyre with one lap to travel when it shifted outward and dropped back, then being contacted from behind by FAIR AACHEN (V. Knight). Driver R. Hill (GAY PLAZA) was advised to show more control in future or a suspension would result.

A delay to the start was caused when SLEEPY NIGHT (J. Walters) snapped a front halter loop during the preliminary.

K. Bennett (DEEP SECRET) was suspended from driving at licensed trotting meetings until after midnight on 3rd February, 1976, for not allowing his horse to properly fill its barrier position at the start.

Race 3 Australian Natives' Association Cup

KING OF HEARTS (F. Jurgens) was slowly away, ASH ADIOS (D. Thomas) missed the start checking DAPPER ADIOS (L. Webster) which had also missed the start.

Race 4 COLES B.O.T.R.A. Pace

F. Zammit (MASTER STAR) — the holder of a Victorian country Driving Licence only and therefore ineligible to drive at Globe Derby Park — was fined \$10.00 for a late driving change.

GULNARE LASS (K. Bennett) missed the start checking RUSTY MONEY (L. Webster) and ULTIMATE (R. Glasgow). HIGH HONEY (R. Matters) missed the start checking SARTORIUS (M. Evans). SCUFF (P. Fuller) missed the start, SUMMER TRADITION (A. J. Clarke) broke shortly after the start.

GULNARE LASS (K. Bennett) broke in running and was pulled up, the trainer when questioned stated the horse had recently been shod and he felt an error in the shoeing was the cause. GULNARE LASS was barred from racing until after midnight on 14th February, to enable a cure to be effected.

Race 5 Sinsmetal Pace

HIGH ADIOS (M. Rodda) and DIAGO (R. Glasgow) missed the start — KINGS MEAD (J. Lesuer) was badly checked as a result of DIAGO jumping sideways.

K. Pike (JUST TOO GOOD) was fined \$5 for driving the last straight with a leg out of the stirrup.

J. Lesuer (KINGS MEAD) touched a wheel when searching for a run in the home straight and was warned to exercise all care.

Sunday, 15th February, commencing at 7 p.m. a country and western barbecue and dance will be held at the Angle Vale Winery arranged by S.A. Ladies Committee BOTRA. Tickets will be \$6 all inclusive. On Friday, 20th February, at 7.30 p.m., a dinner dance will be held at the Joe Oberdan Convention Centre and the cost is \$20 a double all inclusive. Tickets for these functions will be available to all at the secretary's office and must be purchased in advance.
