STEWARDS' REPORT

SATURDAY, 11th MARCH, 1978

HAROLD PARK QUALIFYING STAKES: As the field turned into the back straight on the first occasion, "Commanding" (B. Gath) lost its position and dropped back to last. It was established that a chain reaction had occurred through the field as "Horizon" (J. Stariha) moved off the fence to sit outside the leader, "Burgundy Boy" (S. Wyer). Simultaneously, "Alice Anita" (A. Simons) was also making a forward move on the outside of "Horizon" (J. Stariha). At this point the pace slackened slightly in front, and "Euchre King" (L. Alderton) contacted the sulky wheel of "Commanding" (B. Gath) as it was dropping back. After taking evidence from the drivers concerned and viewing the films available, the Stewards informed J. Stariha that he was being given the benefit of the doubt in this incident.

As a result of an incident which occurred turning off the back straight on the first occasion, and which continued along the home straight towards the finish, J. Stariha "Horizon", which was racing on the inside of "Sheffield Thor" (G. Lang), was charged by the Stewards with jostling — (Rule 265). Stariha was found guilty, and his driver's licence was suspended for two weeks.

It was noted that "Burgundy Boy" (S. Wyer) shifted ground off the fence repeatedly throughout this race. Trainer-driver S. Wyer was informed that, before this horse is produced again in Victoria, the Stewards expect that he will take corrective measures regarding the racing habits of "Burgundy Boy", or the Stewards will take the necessary action.

VICTORIAN TROTTING WRITERS' ASSOCIATION STAKES: "Sengren Suru" was withdrawn by the Stewards at payment time.

INTER-DOMINION PACING CHAMPIONSHIP (First Qualifying Race of Third Series Qualifying Divisions): "Regal Light" (P. Jones) failed to occupy its position in the score-up through breaking, and will be drawn wide at its next mobile barrier start.

"Regal Light" (P. Jones) later broke without interference in running. P. Jones, when questioned by the Stewards as to the performance of this horse, informed them that he was at loss to understand it. It was not the true form of this horse, and he could not account for it in any way. At the request of the Stewards, the Board's Veterinary Surgeon, Dr. Gilbo, examined "Regal Light" and "Captain Harcourt" (T. H. Knowles) after this event, and reported that both horses were quite normal.

Turning off the back straight the first time, "Lincoln Star" (R. Conroy) broke. "Nixon Adios" (F. Kersley) also broke when being checked off "Lincoln Star" (R. Conroy), "Paleface Adios" (C. Pike) and "Sporting Son" (K. Clarke). It was established that, although "Sporting Son" and "Paleface Adios" had hung slightly, they did not in any way inconvenience "Lincoln Star", and a warning was issued to the connections of this horse for breaking.

Routine swab samples were taken from "Paleface Adios" (C. Pike) and "Nixon Adios" (F. Kersley), the first and second placegetters in the race.

INTER-DOMINION PACING CHAMPIONSHIP (Second Qualifying Race of Third Series Qualifying Divisions): It was noted that "Abidair" (K. Clarke) raced roughly on two occasions.

It was noted that "Royal Gaze" (K. Pocock) broke at the winning post. He, too, was inspected by the Board's Veterinary Surgeon, Dr. B. Gilbo, who reported that "Royal Gaze" was quite normal.

Routine swab samples were taken from "Dimante Hanover" (J. McDermott) and "Michael Frost" (J. Ilsley), first and second placegetters in the race.

INTER-DOMINION TROTTING CHAMPIONSHIP — Final: The Stewards questioned C. O'Dwyer "Albey Logan" concerning his driving tactics in this race. After listening to O'Dwyer's explanation that "Albey Logan" was only a sit and sprint horse, the Stewards informed O'Dwyer that his explanation had been noted.

B. Healy "Maori's Idol" was questioned by the Stewards as to whether or not he had mistaken the laps. Healy stated that he had certainly not mistaken the laps, and he had made his run approaching the bell, as has been his custom with this horse in most of his races.

The Stewards inquired into the reason for "El Cordobies" (K. Rawiller) breaking turning out of the home straight in the bell lap, and it was established that "Waipounamu" (P. Jones) had shifted from the one-out line in an attempt to move forward as "Maori's Idol" (B. Healy) was commencing a run. "Waipounamu" (P. Jones), unable to improve its position at that stage, moved back to the line of one-out horses and, as he did so, "El Cordobies" (K. Rawiller) broke. It was also established that "Waipounamu" had not inconvenienced "El Cordobies" in any way. Rawiller explained to the Stewards that "El Cordobies" had broken as he attempted to ease him and take a sit on "Waipounamu". A warning was issued to the connection of "El Cordobies" for breaking, and P.

TRIFECTA BETTING

There are two forms of TRIFECTA tickets available.

The first is a single TRIFECTA ticket at a cost of \$1 per unit.

In the other form if a person selects three horses on which he wishes to invest and decides to couple the six possible finishing combinations of these horses it is not necessary to take six individual tickets. He can take the six combinations on one ticket which is known as a BOX TRIFECTA at a cost of \$6.00 per ticket.

These tickets can only be obtained from the windows marked "BOX TRIFECTA ONLY" while single TRIFECTA tickets can be obtained from the windows marked "TRIFECTA, DOUBLE, QUINELLA".

BOX TRIFECTA windows do not sell Quinella or Double tickets.

STEWARD'S REPORT

Jones "Waipounamu" was informed that the Stewards will expect him to take more care in the manner in which he changes position in races in future. The first four placegetters were sent to be swabbed: "Derby Royale" (C. Powell), "Bold Apepa" (G. Robinson), "Maori's Idol" (B. Healy) and "Spartan Prince" (D. Townley).

INTER-DOMINION PACING CHAMPIONSHIPS (Third Qualifying Race of Third Series Qualifying Divisions): Prior to payment time, Dr. B. Gilbo, the Board's Veterinary Surgeon, inspected both "Pure Steel" and "Don't Retreat", and declared both horses fit to start.

Routine swab samples were taken from "Markovina" (B. Gath) and "Koala King" (K. Robinson), first and second placegetters in the race.

It was noted that "Pure Steel" (P. Coulson) appeared to have broken down on pulling up. The Stewards queried trainer-driver P. Coulson after the race. Coulson informed the Stewards that he had felt "Pure Steel" go before the finish, and he was doubtful at this stage whether the horse would be able to race again during the present series.

AUCKLAND STAKES: "Dunsinane" (J. LeSueur) broke at barrier rise, and will be drawn wide in mobile barrier events in future. The Stewards questioned J. McDermott "Thoron", K. Whelan "Andrew Glenfern" and S. Shinn "Manly Hanover" regarding an incident which occurred turning into the home straight on the last occasion, and in which "Thoron" and "Manly Hanover" both broke. After taking evidence from the drivers and viewing the films, it was established that "Andrew Glenfern" (K. Whelan) had crossed "Manly Hanover" (S. Shinn) sharply, contacting this horse, causing it to break. "Thoron" (J. McDermott), which was trailing "Manly Hanover", was unable to avoid this horse, and contacted the sulky of "Manly Hanover", and "Thoran" also broke. Whelan was charged under Rule 265 with careless driving. He was found guilty, and his driver's licence was suspended for four weeks.

After the last race, the Stewards questioned the trainer of "Maori's Idol", Mr. R. McD. Healy, and driver, B. Healey, as to their reason for placing "Maori's Idol" in a swabbing stall and padlocking the door without permission from the Stewards. As a result of this action, the Board's Veterinary Surgeon was prevented from swabbing one of the placegetters in the final qualifying division of the pacers' series. After taking evidence from Mr. Healy, Senior, and Mr. Healy, Junior, the inquiry was further adjourned until 6.30 p.m. on Saturday, 18th March.
