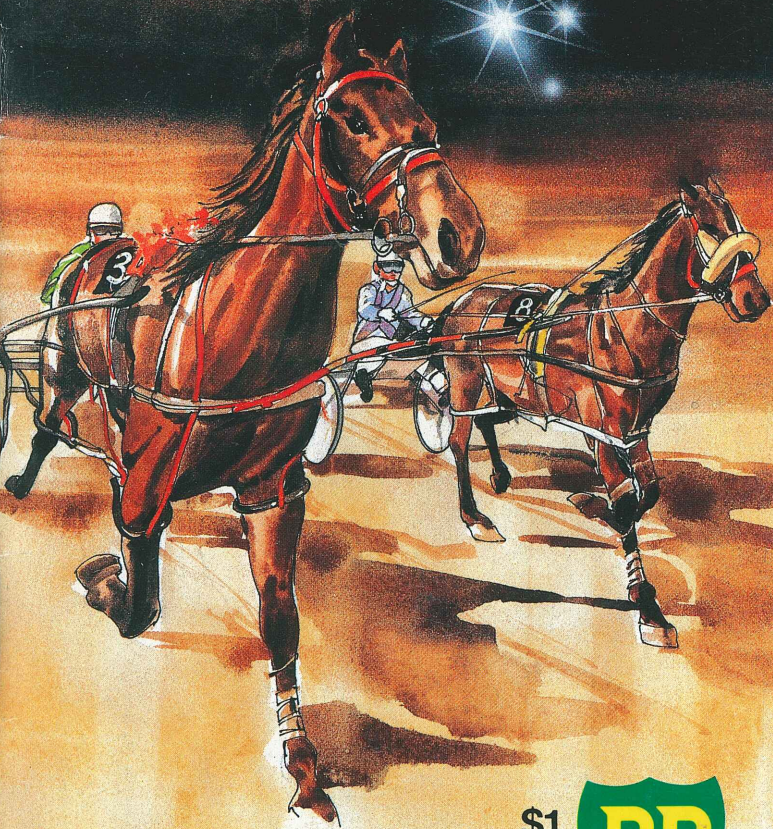

## STEWARDS' REPORT

### Race 1: WEST END DRAUGHT FOUR-YEAR-OLD STAKES

G. Farr (LITTLE HYPO) was fined \$25 for failing to maintain his allotted barrier position in the mobile score up. It was noted that LITTLE HYPO (G. Farr) paced roughly during the early stages of the score up.

L. Harding (WITH OR WITHOUT) reported to the Stewards that he was of the opinion that WITH OR WITHOUT may have pulled up slightly sore. A veterinary examination was ordered and this examination revealed no abnormalities.

### Race 2: S.A. '84 BP INTER DOMINION PACING CHAMPIONSHIPS (Div. 1)

G. Morgan (TUAPEKA STAR) was reprimanded for momentarily inconveniencing DISCO DANNY (R. Sugars) as he shifted to a position three wide in the front straight prior to receiving the bell. The Stewards accepted evidence from R. Sugars (DISCO DANNY) in respect that his pacer had contributed to the incident by being inclined to race erratically at that point of time.

ENTERPRISE (C. de Filippi) hung down the track despite the efforts of its reinsman as the field left the back straight on the first occasion, contacted and severely checked THE RATTLER (J. Hurley), which in turn inconvenienced both DISCO DANNY (R. Sugars) and TUAPEKA STAR (G. Morgan). Trainer P. D. Heffernan was advised to effect a cure for that pacer's race manners or action would be taken by the Stewards.

The following horses were pre-race tested and have been returned negative: OUT FOR GLORY, ENTERPRISE, NOT BEFORE TIME, THOR LOBELL, THE RATTLER, SOCIETY GUY, GAP ROAD.

### Race 3: S.A. '84 BP INTERDOMINION TROTTERS CHAMPIONSHIPS (Div. 1)

B. Gath (BIG JAKE) was reprimanded for occupying a half cart position with approximately 1800 metres to travel and momentarily obliging SADIE GALE (T. Demmler) to race wider on the track.

SADIE GALE (T. Demmler) and MINITRICK (J. Barrowcliff) both broke gait whilst free of interference during running and warnings were issued to the respective connections.

JENNY BEAR (I. Smith) broke gait whilst under pressure as the field turned into the front straight on the last occasion.

The following horses were pre-race tested and have been returned negative: SIR CASTLETON, SADIE GALE, BIG JAKE, JENNY BEAR, ARCNESS, COASTING TIME, JOANIE TOLIVER, DOWNSOUTH CLARE.

### Race 4: S.A. '84 BP INTER DOMINION PACING CHAMPIONSHIPS (Div. 2)

B. Hancock (BUNDADOON) was fined \$50 for careless driving under Rule 370(b) for shifting ground at the winning post on the first occasion and obliging V. Knight (DISTANT THUNDER) to check that pacer.

NEW DERWENT (G. Webster) was noticeably held up for a run over the concluding stages of the event.

AGONISTEZ was a late scratching at 10.35 a.m. on veterinary advice.

The following horses were pre-race tested and have been returned negative: GAMMALITE, MAI MAI, NEW DERWENT, SMITHDALE LAD, SMOOTH DAVE, DISTANT THUNDER.

### Race 5: WINFIELD S.A. PACING DERBY!

It was noted that J. O'Sullivan (QUITE FAMOUS) dropped his whip as the field raced into the front straight on the final occasion.

BLUE AND GOLD (J. Le Sueur) broke gait as the field approached the turn off the back straight on the first occasion. A warning was issued in respect of the race manners of that pacer.

TAR WAY (P. Holberton) was inclined to race fiercely and contacted the cart of SAUNDERS WAY (H. McDermott) as the field raced down the back straight prior to receiving the bell.

The following horses were pre-race tested and have been returned negative: ARMCHAIR RIDE, DODGE TIDE, SAUNDERS WAY, QUITE FAMOUS, ACTINARIA, BLUE AND GOLD, BUFFER LOW, ROBBER JOHN.

### Race 6: S.A. '84 BP INTER DOMINION PACING CHAMPIONSHIPS (Div. 3)

KING TOLIVER was caught wide from the mobile barrier and was obliged to be restrained to the tail of the field in order to obtain a position closer to the fence.

The following horses were pre-race tested and have been returned negative: BARARATA, BLACK IRISH, KALLAWARRA KING, KING TOLIVER, LOBELLENT, OUR MANA, WILLADIOS.

### Race 7: S.A. '84 INTER DOMINION TROTTERS CHAMPIONSHIPS (Div. 2)

An enquiry was opened into the driving tactics adopted by F. Hoban (BRAVADO VALE) on that trotter in tonight's event. The Stewards were particularly concerned as to why F. Hoban, after breaking on two occasions, continually endeavoured to make ground around the field. F. Hoban stated that in his opinion he had erred in his driving tactics tonight. He further tendered evidence that he had not supported BRAVADO VALE in tonight's event. The enquiry was then adjourned until 6.00 p.m. on Wednesday, 15th February, 1984.

An enquiry into the reason for BRAVADO VALE (F. Hoban) being checked as the field turned into the front straight on the last occasion was similarly adjourned to enable reinsman P. Jones (TUSSLE) to be present.

BIG GENERAL broke as the field raced to the turn out of the front straight on the first occasion and a warning was issued.

The following horses were pre race tested and have been returned negative: SCOTCH NOTCH, ANOTHER TOUCH, BRAVADO VALE, HONEY JOHN, TUSSLE, STUMBLIN IN.

### Race 8: ABC TV FOUR-YEARS-OLD STAKES

The reinsman's licence of T. Martin (TWO MINUTES) was suspended until 28th February, 1984 under Rule 370(b) for shifting ground as the field raced into the front straight prior to receiving the bell, and in doing so obliging DISRUPTOR (J. Hurley) to lose its racing position.

NEVADA PORT (B. Gath) was inclined to race erratically during running and turning into the front straight on the final occasion caused FRED KNIGHT (T. Kelly) to be checked. A warning was issued in respect of the race manners of that pacer.

ROBUSTA MAN (B. Ewen) was noticeably held up during the early and middle stages of the final lap.

The following horses were pre-race tested and have been returned negative: RED MALONEY, FRED KNIGHT.

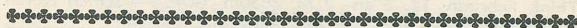

## POINTS SYSTEM

Points shall be awarded to each horse actually starting and finishing a race of a Qualifying Division on the basis that the winner will receive in points the equivalent of the maximum number of horses competing in each race of the Qualifying Divisions. The second horse in that race of the Qualifying Divisions will receive the next lowest number in points; the third horse will receive the next lower number with each horse finishing thereafter receiving in order one lower number in points than the preceding horse until the last horse finishing in a maximum field of 10 will receive one (1) point.

The WINNER of each race of a Qualifying Division will receive ONE (1) BONUS POINT to be added to the points already earned for that race.

Points WILL NOT be allocated for fastest time or for any other reason.

A horse which is scratched from a race of the Qualifying Divisions or a horse which does not complete the race, will not be allocated any points in that race.

In the event of a scratching or a horse not completing the course, points will be allocated as before with the winner and other horses finishing the race entitled to receive their maximum number of points as if a full field has competed and finished the course.

In the event of a DEAD-HEAT all points of the horses dead-heating shall be added together and divided equally.

THE TEN (10) HORSES WHICH GAIN THE GREATEST AGGREGATE OF POINTS IN THE QUALIFYING DIVISIONS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO START IN THE GRAND FINAL.

In the event of two or more horses scoring equally the maximum number of points entitling them to be eligible for the Grand Final then thereby producing a field exceeding the number designated, then the Grand Council shall decide in its discretion which of the horses with equal points shall start in the Grand Final.

## BOOKMAKERS RISK

To assist the success of the Carnival, most Bookmakers have offered to raise the minimum risk from \$400 to \$1000 when laying a bet, provided it is made five (5) minutes before the starting time of race. 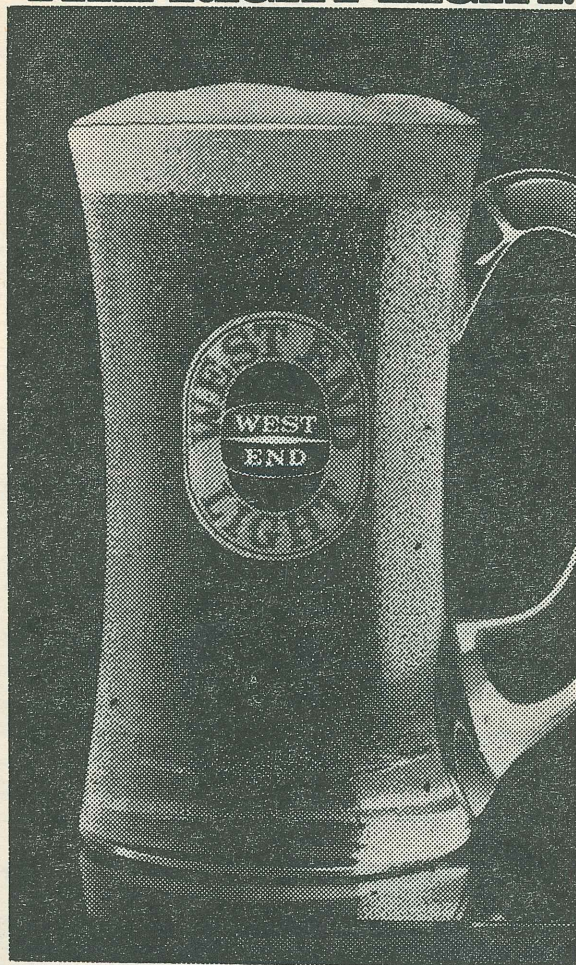

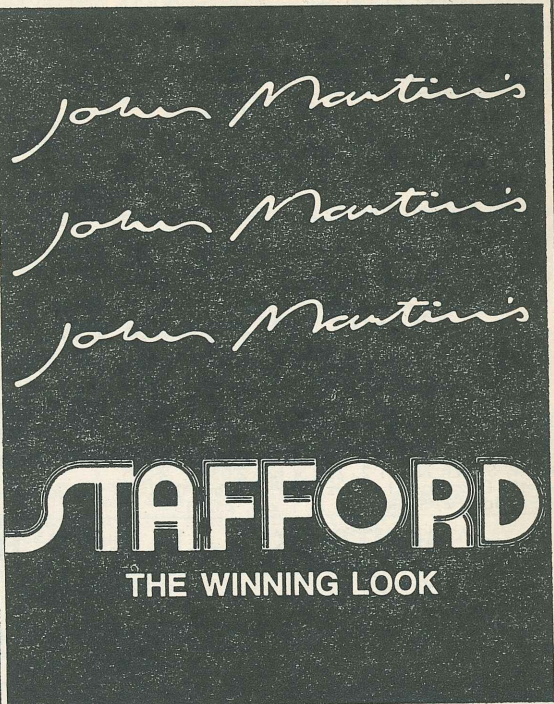
