Following intensive remedial works over the last 48 hours, Western Power has replaced the faulty Transformer that caused the power outage at Friday night's Gloucester Park meeting.

Both Gloucester Park and RWAA would like to thank industry participants for their patience and understanding specific to this unforeseen circumstance, which saw four races abandoned on Friday evening.
