We are satisfied that Mr Weidenbach is guilty of a breach of rule 163(1)(a)(iii) because he permitted his drive, Shelley Star, to shift in when insufficiently clear of Master Tulhurst resulting in that horse losing its position.

In this case, we consider that the degree of interference was low and that an appropriate penalty is a two week suspension.
