

Victorian Local Rules (VLR)

Effective 14 March 2016

VLR 267A (1) The Controlling Body or the Stewards may immediately or otherwise disqualify any person who is the subject of an exclusion order made by the Chief Commissioner of Police under Division 5 of Part 1 of the Racing Act 1958 for such time as the exclusion order remains in force. (effective 14 March 2016)

VLR 234A (1) A person shall not place, or have placed on their behalf, or have any other interest in, a bet on Victorian harness racing with a Non-Approved Wagering Service Provider. (effective 14 March 2016)

VLR 234A (2) For the purpose of sub-rule (1), Non-Approved Wagering Service Provider:

- a) means a wagering service provider as defined in Section 1.3 of the Gambling Regulation Act (GR Act) 2003 (Vic), which did not hold, at the time the relevant bet or interest was placed, approval from Harness Racing Victoria to publish, use or otherwise make available in the course of business, in Victoria or elsewhere, a race field (as defined in section 1.3 of the GR Act) in accordance with section 4.2.3C of the GR Act;
- b) does not include the wagering and betting licensee or the wagering and betting operator (as defined by the GR Act);
- c) does not include a bookmaker approved by Harness Racing Victoria. (effective 14 March 2016)

VLR 251A The following substances and/or their metabolites, artifacts and isomers are declared as banned substances when present in a urine sample (unless otherwise stated) at a concentration above the applicable cut-off level in persons carrying on or purporting to carry on an activity regulated by licence at any time or carrying on official duties at a race meeting:- (effective 14 March 2016, stands in place of introductory wording of AHRR 251A and relates to AHRR 250A)

- (a) Lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD) (0µg/L).
- (b) All barbiturates (0 μ g/L); All Cannabinoids substances in this group include, but are not restricted to, 11-Nor-delta-9-tetrahydrocannabinol-9-carboxylic acid (15 μ g/L): Synthetic cannabinoid analogues and/or their metabolites, such as JWH-018, JWH-073 and HU-210.

- (c) Alcohol (at a concentration in excess of 0.02% on a breath analyser).
- (d) All stimulants substances in this group include, but are not restricted to, Amphetamine (150µg/L): Methylamphetamine (150µg/L): Methylenedioxyamphetamine (MDA) (150µg/L): Methylenedioxyethylamphetamine (MDEA) (150µg/L): Metheledioxymethylamphetamine (MDMA) (150µg/L): Methylphenidate (0µg/L): Modafinil (0µg/L): Cocaine (100µg/L): Ephedrine (10,000µg/L).

Substances in this group excluded are: Levo-amphetamine: Levo-methylamphetamine: Phenylpropanolamine: Pseudoephedrine.

(e) All opiates and opioids – substances in this group include, but are not restricted to, Morphine (0 μ g/L, save as specified by Rule 252: Codeine (0 μ g/L, save as specified in Rule 252): Oxycodone (0 μ g/L): Fentanyl (0 μ g/L): Alfentanil (0 μ g/L): Pethidine (0 μ g/L): Methadone (0 μ g/L): Heroin (0 μ g/L): Monoacetylmorphine (0 μ g/L): Hydromorphone (0 μ g/L):Buprenorphine (0 μ g/L).

Substances in this group excluded are: Dihydrocodeine: Dextromethorphan: Pholcodine: Propoxyphene: Tramadol.

- (f) All dissociative anaesthetics and related substances substances in this group include, but are not restricted to: Ketamine (0 μ g/L): Phencyclidine (0 μ g/L): Tiletamine (0 μ g/L).
- (g) All benzodiazepines substances in this group include: but are not restricted to: Diazepam (200μg/L): Nordiazepam (200μg/L): Oxazepam (200μg/L): Temazepam (200μg/L): Alprazolam (100μg/L, as alpha-hydroxyalprazolam): Clonazepam (100μg/L, as 7-aminoclonazepam): Flunitrazepam (100μg/L, as 7-aminonitrazepam): Bromazepam (0μg/L): Clobazam (0μg/L): Flumazenil (0μg/L): Lorazepam (0μg/L): Midazolam (0μg/L): Triazolam (0μg/L): and substances with similar structure or pharmacological activity benzodiazepine receptor agonists (zalplon: zolpidem: zopiclone).
