The Club has planned a new season of exciting harness racing action and race night promotions at Gloucester Park, commencing with the September Spring meeting.

FHRC ANNUAL AWARDS

Fremantle Harness Racing Club honours its annual award winners for performances at the twelve FHRC prime Friday meetings held at Gloucester Park during the 2009-2010 past season –

- **WHOLE BODY VIBRATION \$2,000 FHRC PACER OF THE YEAR**

Fast Class pacer "**Has The Answers**" performed well recording 3 wins 4 placings (18 points) from only 9 starts at FHRC meetings to win from "**Palomine**" and "**In The Force**". The winner is owned Tony Svilicich, Sonia Murell and Les Coulson who will collect the \$1250 first prize.

- **CHAFF CITY \$2,000 LEADING TRAINER**

A number of top trainers were prominent during the season for this major metropolitan award and WA's leading trainer **Gary Hall (snr)** was successful with 16 winners over the season and receives the \$1250 first prize. Ross Olivieri had another solid season to finish in second with 14 winners (\$500). Greg Bond came home in third place with 12 winners trained over the twelve month period (\$250).

- **COOL CLEAR WATER \$2,000 FHRC LEADING DRIVER**

It was an exciting conclusion to the season with top drivers, **Chris Lewis**, Gary Hall (jnr), Colin Brown, and Shannon Suvaljko all prominent in this major metropolitan award. The winner of the Cool Clear Water Award and \$1250 prize money was Chris Lewis with 18 wins and 24 placings, from a former winner Gary Hall Jnr (18 wins 20 placings) and driver Colin Brown in third place (12 wins and 14 placings).
