RACE 1: BE ACTIVE 2YO STAKES (1730 MBL)

CONRAD BLACK – (Colin Brown) failed to run on over the concluding stages.
BAILEY DYLAN – (Beau Tindale) failed to run on over the concluding stages.
IONIAN JEWEL – (Justin Prentice) broke in the latter stages of the score up losing considerable ground. Excluded from the mobile barrier draw.
PARDIN ME – (Ryan Warwick) approval was given for the offside lugging pole to be removed after the colt resented it during its preliminary. Hung outwards racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.
HILO DIVA – (Stephen Reed) broke gait racing towards the back straight on the first occasion losing considerable ground. Will not be permitted to race for fourteen days and until the completion of two satisfactory trials.

RACE 2: NICOLE PETTIGREW STAKES (2130 MBL)

DAYS OF GRACE – (Justin Warwick) held up until obtaining an inside run over the final 80m.
SAFE DECISION – (Colin Brown) hung inwards racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.
PATRICK ARMAGH – (James Schrader) had a tendency to over race whilst leading.
GLEES JASPER – (Chris Lewis) when questioned on the improved performance, trainer explained that the gelding was best driven in a forward position and in future would be driven that way where circumstances permitted.
RYLEE JO – (Vance Stampalia) failed to run on over the concluding stages.
TRICKY INTEREST – (Gary Hall Jnr) placed in restricted room, locked sulky wheels and broke gait losing considerable ground racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.
THE MIDNIGHT ROCKET – (Ryan Warwick) hung inwards racing out of the back straight on the first occasion, then placed in restricted room for some distance, locking sulky wheels with another runner. Unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

RACE 3: DBC TENDER RIDGE HANDICAP (2503 SS)

CRYSTAL JOURNEY – (Kade Howson) commenced slowly. Unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.
SHELLSTAR – (Stephen Reed) galloped out.
VINTAGE TRAPPER – (Giles Inwood) galloped out. Held up until obtaining an inside run passing the 100m.
CLASS MATE – (Errol Ashcroft) shifted outwards under pressure in the run to the finish.
ONAVENTURE – (Callan Suvaljko) inconvenienced at the start. Unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.
LEACRAIG – (Michael Sangalli) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

RACE 4: COREY MILLS MEMORIAL STAKES (2536 MBL)

TWICE THE PLEASURE – (Grant Williams) pulled hard at various stages. Held up until obtaining a clear run passing the 100m.
MADISON CENTRAL – (Terry Ferguson) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

WENEEDA EARL – (Chris Lewis) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.
BIRDCAGE – (Stephen Reed) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.
COLONIAL BLAZE – (Brad Stampalia) failed to run on over the concluding stages. When questioned on the performance, driver was of the opinion that the rig had been disappointing, although had not been suited by the circumstances of the race and had been unable to sprint wider on the track over the concluding stages. Trainer advised that COLONIAL BLAZE had pulled up big in condition and it was her intention to race it again next week.

RACE 5; ELECTRICAL GROUP TRAINING STAKES (1730 MBL)

TRUCKERS JONNYREB – (Donald Harper) severely checked losing considerable ground racing towards the back straight on the first occasion.
JESSICA JASPER – (Justin Warwick) the near side sulky tyre was contacted by another runner and deflated racing towards the back straight on the first occasion. Shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.
HOWZAT DUKE – (Peter Tilbrook) checked racing towards the back straight on the first occasion.
ART JUNIOR – (Vance Stampalia) checked racing towards the back straight on the first occasion.
MARLEDO – (Kim Prentice) checked racing towards the back straight on the first occasion.
TRUNKEY TORMENTOR – (Stephen Reed) severely checked racing towards the back straight on the first occasion.
MIKE WAZOWSKI – (Grant Williams) severely checked racing towards the back straight on the first occasion.
QUICK DRAW MCCAWE – (Colin Brown) checked racing towards the back straight on the first occasion.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for TRUCKERS JONNYREB (Donald Harper) being severely checked racing towards the back straight on the first occasion. Justin Warwick (JESSICA JASPER) was found guilty to a charge of causing interference issued under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(a) for having shifted in when not sufficiently clear of TRUCKERS JONNYREB. His reinsperson's licence was suspended for a period of twenty-eight days to take effect following his driving engagements on Monday 4th June 2007. In assessing penalty Stewards took into account his good driving record.

RACE 6; VEOLIA ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES STAKES (1730 MBL)

General

The Starter was obliged to abort the first attempt at a to the score up when MOTOR HOLMES (Aaron Skalecki) refused to turn. MOTOR HOLMES was placed on its last chance in the draw.
MORGANATOR – (Justin Prentice) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.
DEMORALIZER – (Beau Tindale) returned with a slight abrasion to the near hind.
JACCKA TAINE – (Adam Mellsop) raced roughly when being eased in the back straight on the first occasion. Raced roughly under pressure racing towards the front straight on the final occasion, placed on its last chance to race truly.
DION MORRIS – (Terry Ferguson) failed to run on over the concluding stages after being obliged to race wider on the track.
GOLD CHANCE – (Callan Suvaljko) returned having cast the off fore plate.

RACE 7; 2007 BREAR & DOONAN 3YO FILLIES STATE SIRE SERIES FINAL (2130 MBL)

MAGICAL DRIVE – (Colin Brown) after leading for the majority of the event compounded badly over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Trainer/driver was of the opinion that the filly may have choked down. MAGICAL DRIVE will not be permitted to race for six days and until the completion of one satisfactory trial.
GUILDER – (Graham Devenny) hung inwards racing out of the back straight on the final occasion. Gave ground over the concluding stages.
AMONGST ROYALTY – (Chris Lewis) slow in the score up despite the efforts of its driver. A warning was issued.
MISS NARLA – (Beau Tindale) severely checked racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.
HILO GILLIAN – (Stephen Reed) checked racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for MISS NARLA (Beau Tindale) being severely checked racing out of the back straight on the final occasion. It was established that GUILDER (Graham Devenny) which had been obliged to race wider on the track racing in the back straight on the final occasion, hung inwards despite the

efforts of its driver, severely checking MISS NARLA, which in turn checked HILO GILLIAN (Stephen Reed). A warning was placed on the race manners of GUILDER. Graham Devenny was advised that in similar circumstances he was expected to give runners to his inside more racing room.

RACE 8; PAUL ANDREWS MLA CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2102 MBL)

MEGAINTEREST – (Ray Retzlaff) began badly, excluded from the Standing Start draw.

ALBERTS FANTASY – (Chris Lewis) after commencing a forward move approaching the 600m, was unable to make ground when carried wider around the final turn. In the driver's opinion, however, it had peaked on its run shortly after straightening. At its previous start when being carried into the race with cover, the gelding had been able to sprint home well. Driver further explained that he had considered making an earlier move, however, had been mindful of the fact that two runs ago the gelding had been unable to sustain the effort when driven forward from the 1200m.

BLACK LINE – (Vance Stampalia) broke shortly after the start, excluded from the Standing Start draw.

RACE 9; CHANNEL NINE HANDICAP (2503 SS)

General

The start of this race was delay approximately twelve minutes when the off fore plate on TIRANO PALEFACE – (Jarrad Humphries) sprung during its preliminary and had to be refitted.

LASTPANGOINPARIS – (Terry Trewenack) galloped out.

MOTORING SAM – (Chris Lewis) began badly.

LEADING STAR – (Morgan Woodley) hung outwards racing in the back straight on the final occasion. A warning was issued.

GLENVALE – (Brad Stampalia) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

NITRO NINA – (Stephen Reed) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

RACE 10; SKY CHANNEL CLAIMING STAKES (2130 MBL)

FINEGANS WAKE – (Stephen Reed) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

THE DIE IS CAST – (Vance Stampalia) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.
