Race 1: GANNON'S CLAIMING CHAMPIONSHIPS QUALIFYING HEAT 1 (2130 MBL)

Permission was given for a shadow roll to be fitted to the gear of IONTHEBALL, which had a tendency to jump shadows in its preliminary.

FRIVOLOUS FELLA – (Joe Suvaljko) broke racing out of the back straight on the first occasion, will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

PAYNIN – (Chris Lewis) was severely checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.

MONEY MASTER – (Morgan Woodley) broke racing out of the back straight on the first occasion and was checked shortly afterwards. Bled in running before being retired from the event. Will not be permitted to race for three months and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

MON SHEKHAN – (Ryan Warwick) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

DOCTEL RAGER – (Mark Reed) was inconvenienced racing out of the back straight on the first occasion then failed to run on over the concluding stages.

SQUATNOVA – (Jason Vella) was checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.

FINEGANS WAKE – (Colin Brown) raced roughly shortly after the start, placed on its last chance in the draw.

Race 2: CHANNEL NINE CLAIMING CHAMPIONSHIPS QUALIFYING HEAT 2 (2130 MBL)

VANLO YORKER – (Mark Reed) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

THE DIE IS CAST – (Vance Stampalia) was inconvenienced behind a tiring runner in the back straight on the final occasion.

Race 3: BE ACTIVE CLAIMING CHAMPIONSHIPS QUALIFYING HEAT 3 (2130 MBL)

Racing into the front straight on the first occasion FORTY TWO GRAND (Gary Hall Jnr) which was racing fiercely, made contact with the sulky of GIFTED OPERATOR (Mark Reed) and became entangled in that cart. As both horses remained on the track, the race was stopped with the remainder of the field racing in the back straight on the first occasion.

Race 3 was order to be re-run with all start times being amended.

FORTY TWO GRAND was withdrawn on veterinary advise at 7.20pm after receiving an injury to the near fore leg when becoming entangled in the sulky of GIFTED OPERATOR. All bets made on FORTY TWO GRAND were refunded and deductions from winning bets were made in accordance with RWAA Rule of Wagering 56.

THE LAST PADRON – (Craig Goldfinch) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

MASSARUA – (Kim Prentice) was unable to obtain clear running from prior to entering the home straight. Raced roughly on straightening then broke for a short distance in the front straight. Driver explained that he had initially attempted to ease the gelding wider on the track, however had to desist that movement and move quickly back to the marker pegs and as result the gelding became unbalanced. Under the circumstances, no action was taken.

Race 4: TOYOTA GENUINE PARTS, SERVICE & ACCESSORIES STAKES (1730 MBL)

JACCKA TANA – (Mark Reed) raced roughly racing towards the back straight on the first occasion and then hung inwards racing from the 400m and raced roughly. Driver advised that the gelding had been slightly disappointing and it was now the stables' intention to attempt to correct the gelding's racing manners by gear alterations. The gelding was placed in its last chance to race truly.

RUNAM ALONG – (Kim Prentice) raced fiercely when racing at the lead of the one wide line in the early and middle stages.

BOBBY HANK – (Justin Warwick) hung inwards in the early and middle stages of the score up.

Race 5: 2007 2YO FILLIES WESTERN CROWN FINAL (1730 MBL)

ROYAL AMORE – (Mark Reed) was checked and broke gait racing in the back straight on the first occasion when the pace in the one wide line eased. Severely checked racing in the front straight to receive the bell.

SAVE ON ME – (Beau Tindale) broke in the middle stages of the score up and was slightly out of position at release point. Driver advised that the filly had resented the fitting of a new rein burr. Under the circumstances it was placed on its last chance in the draw. Raced greenly in the front straight to receive the bell.

APACHE SUNRISE – (Ryan Warwick) was severely checked shortly after the start. Racing towards the front straight to receive the bell after being taken into the three wide line, hung inwards momentarily locking wheels with another runner and broke gait. Severely checked racing into the front straight on the final occasion.

BUCKING BEAUTY – (Chris Lewis) hung inwards shortly after the start. Was checked in the back straight on the first occasion when the pace in the one wide line eased. Locked wheels with another runner racing towards the front straight to receive the bell. Hung outwards racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.

BORN TO PARTY – (Terry Ferguson) which began badly, was excluded from the mobile barrier draw. Checked in the front straight to receive the bell.

MISS PLACED – (Shane Young) raced greenly over the final 500m.

KIN OF QUEENS – (Callan Suvaljko) raced greenly in the front straight to receive the bell.

General

Shane Young (MISS PLACED) was reminded of his obligations for having eased the pace racing in the back straight on the first occasion placing other runners at a disadvantage.

Race 6: 2007 2YO COLTS AND GELDINGS WESTERN CROWN FINAL (1730 MBL)

APPLADAY – (Callan Suvaljko) dropped the near side shin and tendon boot racing in the back straight on the final occasion.

Race 7: 2007 GOVERNOR'S CUP (2130 MBL)

The Starter was obliged to turn the field away at the first attempt at the score up when the offside rein on SPEED MONSTER became caught on the sulky shaft.

Race 8: SCHWEPPE'S HANDICAP (2503 SS)

STAR OF AVONLEA – (Vance Stampalia) galloped out.

LEFT A COOKIE – (Mark Reed) was checked at the start when the barrier strand failed to clear the track.

MACHINE GUN – (Justin Prentice) was checked racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

DION MORRIS – (Ryan Warwick) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw. Severely checked racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

MATT IN BLACK – (Wesley Andrews) was checked racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

General

Prior to the All Clear being given, Stewards examined the official films of the start to determine whether LEFT A COOKIE had been denied the opportunity of a fair start. It was established that the front barrier strand had failed to clear LEFT A COOKIE, under the circumstances it was declared a non-starter.

Stewards inquired into the reason for DION MORRIS being severely checked racing out of the back straight on the final occasion. Mark Reed (LEFT A COOKIE) pleaded guilty to a charge of causing interference issued under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(a) and had his reinsperson's licence suspended for a period of sixteen days. In determining penalty, Stewards were mindful of Mr Reed's guilty plea and his excellent driving record. Stewards ruled that the suspension would take effect following his driving engagement in Victoria on Sunday 11th February 2007.

Race 9: TOYOTA YARIS CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2102 SS)

OTTWAY – (Ryan Bell) reared at the start. Was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

LOMBO APOLLO – (Des Stockman) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw.

IDEAL LAVROS – (Ryan Warwick) galloped out and then was checked shortly after the start. Held up in the early stages before gaining a late inside run.

MR ACEMAN – (Mark Reed) galloped briefly at the start.

FORWARD POCKET – (Brad Stampalia) which jumped sideways at the start beginning badly, was excluded from the Standing Start draw for four satisfactory race or trial starts.

Race 10: VEOLIA ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES STAKES (2536 MBL)

MON POPPIES – (Colin Brown) a post race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have returned lame in the near fore. MON POPPIES will not be permitted to race or trial until a Veterinary Certificate of Soundness is produced.

BEAUDIENE VICOLO – (Wesley Andrews) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

MY BARNEY RUBBLE – (Morgan Woodley) was held up until obtaining a late inside run.

SORRENTO TUESDAY – (Craig Saligari) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.
