Race 1: MORE 'F' IN FUN STAKES (2130 MBL)

ANOTHER NOTCH UP – (Aldo Cortopassi) which began badly was excluded from the mobile barrier draw then was inconvenienced racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.
CYCLONE ALBERT – (Chris Lewis) pulled hard for a major part of the event.

General

Stewards enquired into the reason for ANOTHER NOTCH UP (Aldo Cortopassi) being checked racing out of the front straight on the first occasion. It was established that as the gelding was progressing forward in the three wide line Kim Young (JUST FOXIN) attempted to move from the one wide line in advance of that runner however, JUST FOXIN did not immediately respond to the driver's efforts. As a consequence ANOTHER NOTCH UP was momentarily obliged to race wider on the track before gaining the position on JUST FOXIN's back. Under the circumstances Stewards took no action over the matter other than to remind driver Kim Young of his obligations in similar circumstances.

Race 2: PAUL ANDREWS MLA STAKES (2130 MBL)

LORINDA – (Matthew Scott) was checked approaching the 400m behind a tiring runner.
TAR SEELED – (Hayden Charles) raced roughly at various stages of the event and racing in the back straight on the final occasion jumped a marker peg that had been struck by another runner. Under the circumstances no action was taken. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.
JUST BELLA – (Jarrad Humphries) when questioned on the apparent improved performance the trainer/driver explained that in his opinion the mare had raced without luck at its previous start and prior to that had worked to hard. He also advised that the mare raced better when leading.
SCENIC SAGA – (Gary Hall Jnr) after racing at the lead of the one wide line gave ground over the final 500m.

Race 3: DALE AXWORTHY 2YO STAKES (2130 MBL)

CASSIE ROX – (Grant Williams) Stewards approved a late driving change on CASSIE ROX at 5.20pm when trainer Kevin Keys advised that a driving change had been notified to Racing Services but not processed.
ASTROLABE STORM – (David Pellew) raced roughly after the start, then hung outwards racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.
PARSONS LORE – (Garry Hampson) raced roughly when being eased racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.
BARJOHBIL – (Ryan Warwick) hung inwards racing out of the front straight on the first occasion as another runner hung outwards with the sulkies making contact resulting in BARJOHBIL becoming unbalanced and breaking for a short distance. Under the circumstances no action was taken.

Race 4: NICOLE PETTIGREW HANDICAP (2503 SS)

MAGNEATO – (Aldo Cortopassi) which began badly was placed on its last chance in the standing start draw.

DIAMOND PAUL – (Aaron Skalecki) which began badly was placed on its last chance in the standing start draw.

ALS REIGN – (Gary Hall Jnr) which began badly was placed on its last chance in the standing start draw.

VIKING RULER – (Brian Ferguson) after being obliged to race wider on the track over the final lap failed to run on over the concluding stages.

DAY IN MANHATTEN – (David Young) which began badly will remain excluded from the standing start draw.

Race 5: LANCASTER PARK STAKES (2130 MBL)

PRIVATE NUMBER – (Mark Reed) was held up until obtaining an inside run passing the 100m.

CHELSEA VILLAGE – (Grant Williams) shifted out slightly under pressure in the run to the finish.

THEEYES TELLNOLIES – (Craig Goldfinch) was slightly out of position at release point. The driver was reminded of his obligations and advised that any repetition may result in action being taken against his licence.

RUMOR HAZIT – (Gregory Schofield) was slightly out of position at release point. The driver was reminded of his obligations and advised any repetition may result in action being taken against his licence.

Race 6: 2006 BREAR & DOONAN STATE SIRES SERIES 3YO FILLIES FINAL (2130 MBL)

MON POPPY MIA – (Ryan Warwick) raced roughly at the start.

PARSONS CLOTHES – (Ian Davie) which hung inwards during the score up and as a result was a considerable distance out of position at release point was placed on its last chance in the mobile barrier draw. Trainer/driver Ian Davie reported that the filly would now be spelled.

GO ON TEMPT ME – (Aaron Beckett) shifted inwards slightly under pressure in the run to the finish locking wheels momentarily.

YESSAHH – (Gary Hall Jnr) was inconvenienced at the start and then shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish looking wheels momentarily.

General

A protest lodged by driver Aaron Beckett driver of GO ON TEMPT ME against the winner YESSAHH – (Gary Hall Jnr) alleging interference over the concluding stages was dismissed. It was established that there had been a shift from both runners close to the finish, therefore the interference could not be solely attributable to the racing manners of YESSAHH.

Race 7: COREY MILLS MEMORIAL STAKES (2130 MBL)

IL CASINO – (Kim Prentice) was late withdrawal on veterinary advice at 8.11pm prior to the commencement of betting when it was established that the gelding had bled from the near side nostril whilst undergoing its pre-race warm up prior to the running of Race 6. Trainer Mr Kim Prentice was advised that IL CASINO would not be permitted to race until a satisfactory endoscopic report was produced.

GIFTED OPERATOR – (Mark Reed) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish

Race 8: BE ACTIVE STAKES (2130 MBL)

This race started approximately 3 minutes after the advised start time due to track maintenance.

LEVITYS RAINBOW – (Mark McGuire) was held up in the early stages of the straight until gaining a late inside run.

PERFECT ORDER – (Colin Brown) was held up in the early stages of the straight until gaining a late inside run.

ANGRYLITTLEBEAVER – (Aaron Skalecki) was held up until passing the 100m.

FAKE EMBRACE – (Kim Prentice) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

CLUTCH CARGO – (Callan Suvaljko) hung inward during the middle and late stages of the score up however regained its position prior to release point.

ALL IN TECK – (Grant Williams) raced ungenerously for a major part of the event.

JACCKA FROST – (Chris Lewis) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

Race 9: ELECTRICIAL DISTRIBUTORS WA HANDICAP (2503 SS)

LIQUOR LAD – (Clinton Hall) which jumped sideways at the start and galloped for a considerable distance was excluded from the standing start draw.

ZALMAN – (Dennis Russell) the driver dropped his whip racing in the back straight on the second occasion.

FRANCO STRIKER – (Ryan Warwick) which galloped out then broke again shortly afterward will remain excluded from the standing start draw.

GOOD HEAVENS HOLMES – (Mark Reed) was checked at the start.

MACHINE GUN – (Jarrad Humphries) galloped out and then was checked shortly afterwards.

FREDDY RAMA – (John Filardo) which began badly will remain excluded from the standing start draw.
SMARTY ARTY – (Gary Hall Jnr) which delayed the start by refusing to come forward then commenced slowly will remain excluded from the standing start draw. Was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

Race 10: BREAR & DOONAN STAKES (2130 MBL)

PERIPHERIQUE – (Michael Tenardi) was unable to gain clear running to the finish.
IM NO SUCKER – (Hayden Charles) had difficulty obtaining clear running to the finish.
