Race 1: HANKOOK TYRES KEY DEALER STAKES (2143 MBL)

DISCO INVASION – (Raymond Jones) severely checked racing off the back straight on the first occasion.
NUTS ABOUT SOKY – (Trevor Wright) contacted a sulky and raced roughly racing towards the front straight on the first occasion and then raced roughly approaching the home turn on the final occasion.
SHARMAN – (Colin Brown) severely checked racing off the back straight first occasion.
TRUE GENTLEMEN – (Kim Young) severely checked racing off the back straight first occasion.
KINKI VILLAGE – (Errol Ashcroft) underwent a veterinary examination prior to the race when that gelding slipped and fell in the parade ring causing slight lacerations to the hear fore knee, however was passed fit to start.
SATU SON – (Beau Tindale) severely checked racing off the back straight first occasion.
TOUR KING – (Fred Kersley) post race specimens were taken, trainer Greg Harper.
VILLAGE HERO – (Callan Suvaljko) severely checked racing off the back straight on the first occasion.
ALABAMA JOE – (Chris Lewis) severely checked racing off the back straight on the first occasion.
EL GUERROUJ – (Aldo Cortopassi) severely checked racing off the back straight on the first occasion.
IMDANGEROUS – (Clinton Kimes) severely checked racing off the back straight on the first occasion. Trainer fined \$100 under Rule 273(6)(b) for wearing unapproved gear.

General

Stewards inquired into the reasons for DISCO INVASION (Raymond Jones), SHARMAN (Colin Brown), TRUE GENTLEMEN (Kim Young), SATU SON (Beau Tindale), VILLAGE HERO Callan Suvaljko), ALABAMA JOE (Chris Lewis), EL GUERROUJ (Aldo Cortopassi) and IMDANGEROUS (Clinton Kimes) being severely checked racing off the back straight on the first occasion. Interviewed drivers Raymond Jones (DISCO INVASION), Trevor Wright (NUTS ABOUT SOKY) and Errol Ashcroft (KINKI VILLAGE). Trevor Wright driver of (NUTS ABOUT SOKY) pleaded guilty to a charge of Causing Interference under the provision of Rule 163(1)(a) and his licence was suspended for a period of twenty five days. In considering penalties Stewards took into account Trevor Wright's exemplary driving record and his guilty plea.

Race 2: HANKOOK K406 FUEL SAVER TYRE STAKES (2143 MBL)

GET SERIOUS – (Vance Stampalia) raced roughly shortly after the start.
KING CAREY – (Michael Tenardi) held up failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.
WILL TO LIVE – (Gary Hall Jnr) claimed following the event.
TOP OF THE LINE – (Hayden Charles) gave ground over the concluding stages, claimed following the event.
THE DIE IS CAST – (Colin Reeves) pos trace specimens were taken, trainer Colin Joss.
FRANCO NOVELLA – (Callan Suvaljko) claimed following the event.
VOICE OF FREEDOM – (Colin Brown) gave ground over the concluding stages.

General

Stewards questioned Michael Tenardi (KING CAREY) regarding his driving tactics and in particular the reasons for taking a trail in the early stages when the gelding normally shows speed to lead in his races. Michael Tenardi advised that on this occasion as the horse does not wear shortening pins failed to muster speed as is his normal practice and advised that he will apply shortening pins in an effort to gain greater

speed. Stewards also questioned Mr Tenardi as to his reasons why once beaten for the speed he then shifted closest to the rubber uprights on the back of KENDALL CASTLE which led the field rather than stay in the one wide line and progress forward at a later time. Michael Tenardi advised that he considered it was to his advantage once beaten for speed to take the position behind the leader KENDALL CASTLE expecting that horse to take him into the race enabling him to gain a late run. After considering the evidence put by Michael Tenardi Stewards noted his comments, however advised him that a greater judgement was expected in future and a repartition of such tactics may result in action being taken against his licence.

Race 3: HANKOOK COUNTRY DEALERS PACE (2503 SS)

SWAPS – (Vance Stampalia) post race specimens were taken, trainer Tonia Stampalia.

WESTICE – (Colin Brown) began slowly from the Standing Start.

AMARYLLIS SPIRIT – (Morgan Woodley) held up and failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

CLASS MATE – (Errol Ashcroft) galloped briefly at the start, held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

IL CASINO – (Justin Prentice) began slowly from the Standing Start.

ISRALIES SON – (Ryan Bell) broke gait shortly after the start and galloped for some distance and will be excluded from the Standing Start barrier draw.

WALLY WIZARD – (Brad Stampalia) held up and failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

Race 4: VENTUS PERFORMANCE TYRE STAKES (2143 MBL)

MON POPPIES – (Colin Brown) held up and experienced difficulties in the home straight in gaining clear running.

THE REAL DEAL – (Mark Reed) held up and failed to gain clear running in the home straight approaching the finish.

JUST BELLA – (Hayden Charles) began badly and will be excluded from the mobile barrier draw.

CRYSTAL JOURNEY – (Chris Lewis) the score up was aborted on the first occasion when the earplugs released prematurely.

ELECTRACITED – (Justin Warwick) trainer fined \$100 under Rule 273(6)(b) for wearing unapproved gear.

Race 5: COUNTRY DISTRICT TROTTING COUNCILS STAKES (1742 MBL)

MEGAINTEREST – (Ray Retzlaff) out of position at the start, driver reprimanded under the provisions of Rule 162(1)(j) for failing to maintain his position in the score up.

OSCAR DERBY – (Darren Kerr) shied and broke gait racing out of the front straight on the first occasion. No action was taken under the circumstances when it was established that the gelding was impeded by a rubber upright that was dislodged and laying on the track.

ALL IN TECK – (Kim Young) forced wider and lost his racing position approaching the front straight to receive the bell, restrained to a position and then held up in the home straight and failed to gain clear running.

General

Stewards inquired into the reasons for ALL IN TECK being forced wider racing towards the front straight to receive the bell. After taking evidence from Kody Charles (BANK THE MONEY) and Kim Young (ALL IN TECK) Kody Charles pleaded guilty to a charge under the provision of Rule 163(1)(b) for forcing another runner wider. Stewards suspended Kody Charles licence for a period of fourteen days. In considering penalties Stewards took into account Kody Charles good driving record and his guilty plea, however that suspension will attach from midnight 10th March 2006 up to and including the 24th March 2006.

Race 6: 2006 HANKOOK TYRES COUNTRY PACING DERBY FINAL (2548 MBL)

JENAMI MAGIC – (Kirk Bourne) broke in the score up and caused a false start. When the start was effected raced roughly in the latter stages of the score up and failed to muster speed. Connections were advised that the filly must complete four satisfactory trial or race starts before re-inclusion in the draw. Hung inwards under pressure and contacted marker pegs on the home turn.

DILINGERS REIGN – (Kim Prentice) post race specimens were taken, trainer Noel Keiley.

BACK IN THE BLACK- (Chris Beckett) pulled hard for the majority of the event.

CEE JAY WINKLE – (Kade Howson) which raced at the lead of the one wide line gave ground over the concluding stages.

DEVASTATING – (Colin Reeves) was checked at the start.

General

Stewards delayed the All Clear when Kirk Bourne (JENAMI MAGIC) wished to view the film of the home turn with a view to lodging a protest alleging interference. After viewing those videos, did not proceed.

Race 7: WEST AUSTRALIAN COUNTRY TROTTING ASSOCIATION STAKES (2143 MBL)

JACCKA MEADOW – (Wesley Andrews) gave ground over the concluding stages and returned with a flat tyre. Underwent a veterinary examination following the race, which revealed nothing amiss. Connections were advised that the gelding would be placed on its last chance to race competitively.

PATCHES – (Gary Hall Jnr) post race specimens were taken, trainer Gary Hall Snr.

JAILBIRD – (Kim Prentice) checked from the 600m to the 400m when being carried back through the field by tiring runners.

Race 8: MCINERNEY FORD FIESTA COMPETITION PACE (2503 SS)

JACK FORCE – (Clinton Hall) galloped briefly at the start and then obtained a late inside run.

THE JOBS ON – (Ryan Bell) began badly from the Standing Start, placed on its last chance in the barrier draw.

BRIGHT AS – (Steven Jelf) which led the field throughout shifted outwards in the home straight approaching the finish. Post race specimens were taken, trainer Bernard James.

ROCKY BROWN – (Natalie Duffy) began badly, placed on its last chance in the barrier draw.

JUSTALITTLEFELLA – (Justin Warwick) held up and failed to gain clear running in the home straight approaching the finish.

PLANINA – (Brad Stampalia) began badly from the Standing Start, placed on its last chance in the barrier draw.

Race 9: HANKOOK SILICA TYRE STAKES (1742 MBL)

JOIE DE VIVRE – (Clinton Hall) which led the field throughout, shifted outwards under pressure in the home straight approaching the finish. Driver accidentally dropped his whip shortly after the start and was reminded of his obligations when allowing that gelding to shift outwards approaching the finish.

Race 10: HANKOOK DYNAPRO ALL TERRAIN TYRE STAKES (2548 MBL)

PERFECT ORDER – (Colin Brown) held up until passing the 100m before gaining clear running to the finish.

CRANKY JACK – (Morgan Woodley) post race specimens were taken, trainer Callan Suvaljko.

KARL – (Ryan Bell) broke gait free of interference racing towards the back straight on the first occasion. Connections were advised that the gelding would not be permitted to race for six days and must complete one satisfactory trial.

TOALLAGOODKNIGHT – (Mark Reed) returned with the near side knee boot displaced.

CROUCH ON PREY – (Wes Andrews) held up, failed to gain clear running in the home straight approaching the finish.

KOBIASHI MARU – (John Jelf) held up, failed to gain clear running in the home straight approaching the finish.

General

Stewards delayed the All Clear when Clinton Kimes (Motor Holmes) wished to view the film of the closing stages with a view to lodging a protest alleging interference. After viewing those videos, did not proceed.

GENERAL

Adjourned Inquiry Gloucester Park Tuesday 21st February 2006

Stewards concluded their inquiry into the reason SATAN (Justin Warwick) was checked in the home straight on the final occasion. After taking evidence from Mr Warwick and Mr McGuire (ALL IN TECK). Mr McGuire has his driving licence suspended for a period of twenty two days under Rule 163(1)(a) for Causing Interference to SATAN. Stewards directed that the suspension would be served concurrently with Mr McGuire's other suspension he incurred on the 21st February 2006.
