Stipendiary Stewards Report

Race 1: MILWAUKEE STAKES (1730 MBL)

ALBERT EINSTEIN – (Chloe Tindale) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.
IWANAMAKIT – (Scott Eyre) which began badly, was excluded from the mobile draw for four (4) race or trial starts as it had offended in a similar manner previously.
SILENT FIVE – (Andrew De Campo) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.
OK SMOOTHIE – (Beau Tindale) was severely checked shortly after the start losing considerable ground.
THE LAST PADRON – (Hayden Charles) was inconvenienced shortly after the start.

Race 2: BE ACTIVE MARES STAKES (1730 MBL)

ROLL ON DISCO – (Kim Young) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish. When questioned on his driving tactics in the early stages driver explained that it had been his intention to lead the event, however he had been unable to cross the horse to its inside which had shown more gate speed than he had anticipated. Under the circumstances, as ROLL ON DISCO races best close to the marker pegs, he elected to ease to obtain a position on its back. His comments were noted.
BACK IN THE BLACK – (Justin Prentice) which broke shortly after the start, was excluded from the mobile barrier draw. A post race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off hind. BACK IN THE BLACK will not be permitted to race or trial until a Veterinary Certificate of Soundness is produced. Trainer Jason Fry was fined \$200 under the provisions of Rule 30(2) for having failed to advise the Stewards that the mare had sustained an injury to the off hind bumper on Wednesday 1st November 2006.
LADY DE BEAU – (Chris Lewis) was inconvenienced racing towards the back straight on the first occasion.
TANYAS JAG – (Colin Brown) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.
RYLEE JO – (Clinton Kimes) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

Race 3: MAKITA CLAIMING STAKES (2130 MBL)

DIGGER OF FORTUNE – (Justin Prentice) hung inwards and raced inside a marker peg racing towards the front straight on the first occasion before being restrained.
DREAM SOFTLY – (Tony Pullicino) commenced slowly.

Race 4: TOYOTA GENUINE PARTS, SERVICE & ACCESSORIES STAKES (1730 MBL)

SMOOTH ADVANCE – (Beau Tindale) was held up until obtaining a late inside run.
PIGGY – (Richard Polak) hung outwards and broke gait racing into the back straight on the first occasion. Will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.
WEONA SHOWDOWN – (Mark Reed) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.
CAMS LEGEND – (Ryan Warwick) was checked racing into the back straight on the first occasion.
MATT IN BLACK – (Grant Williams) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.
KENDALL CASTLE – (Justin Prentice) was severely checked racing into the back straight on the first occasion, then unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

BLACK AS KNIGHT – (Craig Goldfinch) was severely checked racing into the back straight on the first occasion.

Race 5: PUNT & PUTT COMPETITION MOUNT EDEN SPRINT CONSOLATION (1730 MBL)

ALL RAPT UP – (Ryan Warwick) was held up until obtaining a late inside run.

PADDY O'BRIEN – (Kade Howson) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

MASSARUA – (Kim Prentice) which began badly, was excluded from the mobile barrier draw.

PATCHES – (Gary Hall Jnr) a post race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have sustained a slight wound to the off fore foot.

VANLO YORKER – (Mark Reed) after pulling hard in the early stages, choked down in the back straight on the final occasion before being retired from the event. Will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

Race 6: 2006 ALLTOOLS MOUNT EDEN SPRINT (1730 MBL)

Due to a computer malfunction in the early stages of the score up, the Starter elected to start this race manually.

Race 7: RYOBI HANDICAP (2503 SS)

ONADVENTURE – (Morgan Woodley) galloped briefly at the start.

TURKISH – (Shannon Suvaljko) galloped out.

ARABARAMA – (Mark Reed) began badly, due to the delay in starting this race, no action was taken.

JOIE DE VIVRE – (Gary Hall Jnr) which delayed the start for some time, was placed on its last chance in the draw.

CULLENS COVER – (Colin Brown) galloped out.

JUSTABITJOLLY – (Justin Warwick) galloped out.

Race 8: METABO STAKES (2130 MBL)

MANSON – (Colin Reeves) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

MIGHTY ASLAN – (Justin Warwick) was momentarily tightened racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

COGSARBURNING – (Shane Butterworth) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

EXPLOSIVE ATOM – (Shannon Suvaljko) raced roughly out of the back straight on the final occasion.

BAYETE NKOSI – (Andrew De Campo) was momentarily tightened racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

Race 9: XXXX GOLD HANDICAP (2503 SS)

IAMALLCLASS – (Gary Hall Jnr) although winning the race, the driver was disadvantaged by a faulty sulky seat, having to drop a leg in the front straight to retain balance.

ARMBRO QUICKSILVER – (Morgan Woodley) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw.

LEADING STAR – (Vance Stampalia) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

LOMBO STORM – (Beau Tindale) commenced slowly.

WATERLOO BAY – (Justin Warwick) was held up until obtaining a run inside the 100m.

GRUBBY SHANNON – (Shannon Suvaljko) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

Race 10: BOSCH STAKES (1730 MBL)

JUST FOXIN – (Kim Young) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

PERIPHERIQUE – (Michael Tenardi) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

GENERAL

Stewards inquired into the conduct of driver Scott Eyre following the abandonment of the final three races due to the condition of the track at the Golden Mile Trotting Club Meeting held on the 28th October 2006. After considering evidence tendered by Mr Eyre and Steward in charge of the Golden Mile Meeting, Wayne Sullivan, Mr Eyre was found guilty to a charge of speaking and behaving in an improper manner issued under the provisions of Rule 247 and he was fined \$500. Acting under the provisions of Rule 256(5)(a) Stewards ordered that \$250 of this penalty be suspended for twelve (12) months on the proviso that Mr Eyre did not re-offend under this or a similar rule in that time.
