Race 1: CHAFF CITY SUPREME STEAM CUT STAKES (1730 MBL)

IWANAMAKIT – (Steven Jelf) began badly losing considerable ground. It was subsequently established that the tail tie had become detached just prior to the gelding breaking. Under the circumstances no action was taken.

JUST BELLA – (Jarrad Humphries) was momentarily tightened racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

IRON CLAD LOMBO – (Cruci Grixti) raced roughly after the start.

ROCKSTAR – (Joe Suvaljko) was checked at the start.

Race 2: CHAFF CITY COMPLETE HORSE DIET STAKES (1730 MBL)

SCENIC SAGA – (Chris Lewis) the driver had the whip accidentally knocked from his hand in the run to the finish.

ANSE LE RAIE – (Mark Reed) was momentarily tightened racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

KINNEY PRINCE – (Jeffrey Wegner) which raced three wide in the early stages before gaining the lead of the one wide line, commenced to give ground from the 450m. A post race veterinary examination revealed nothing amiss.

THEEYES TELLNOLIES – (Morgan Woodley) was checked behind a tiring runner leaving the 400m.

Race 3: 2006 GANNON'S WA OAKS PRELUDE 2 (2130 MBL)

FLUENT STYLE – (Gregory Schofield) the driver momentarily dropped his right leg from the sulky rest in the run to the finish.

BACK IN THE BLACK – (Aaron Beckett) was slightly out of position at release point. The driver was reprimanded under the provisions of Rule 162(1)(h).

YESSAHH – (Justin Warwick) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

JUPITERS DARLING – (Gary Hall Jnr) was momentarily inconvenienced racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.

FISCAL PENNY – (Colin Brown) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

Race 4: CHAFF CITY MUESLI & MIXES DELIGHT 3YO STAKES (2130 MBL)

General

Stewards delayed the All Clear after driver Errol Ashcroft (KINKI VILLAGE) requested to view the films of the run to the finish, as in his opinion he may have been inconvenienced by the second placed PARKYS DILEMMA (Robert Cassian) shifting outwards. After viewing the films driver Ashcroft elected not to proceed with the matter.

ARMBRO ORDER – (Joe Suvaljko) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

ALABAMA JOE – (Ryan Warwick) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

EVEN DROP – (Jeffrey Wegner) gave ground over the concluding stages.

GOOD BOYS – (Gary Hall Jnr) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

PARKYS DILEMMA – (Robert Cassian) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish. The driver was fined \$200 under the provisions of Rule 168(1) for having failed to make an effort to correct the colt.

Race 5: CREW OF CHAFF CITY STAKES (1730 MBL)

FRANCO STRIKER – (Ryan Warwick) raced keenly in the latter stages of the score up. Broke gait racing out of the front straight on the first occasion. Driver Ryan Warwick explained that the offside hopple shortening release mechanism had broken at that point, however Stewards ruled that the gelding would not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes one satisfactory trial. After making up lost ground in the middle stages, failed to run on to the finish.

VILLAGE ACE – (Kim Prentice) was held up until obtaining an inside run over the final stages.

LENNON – (Gary Hall Jnr) shifted out slightly under pressure in the run to the finish.

COSMIC FLIGHT – (Justin Warwick) had difficulty obtaining clear running to the finish.

SPEEDO – (Mark Reed) which drew the inside of the back line was in the one wide line prior to release point. Driver explained that he had moved wider on the track for safety reasons and as in his opinion FRANCO STRIKER appeared likely to break at any point.

Race 6: 2006 CHAFF CITY CHAMPAGNE CLASSIC (2130 MBL)

CASSIE ROX – (Kevin Keys) shied on an object on the track shortly after the start and raced roughly for a short distance.

ADDA DOUBLE DIP – (Susan Roberts) when questioned on her driving tactics, in particular her reasons for failing to go forward to gain the lead of the one wide line, driver explained that it had been her intention with the increased distance of this evening's event to endeavour to obtain a trailing position. As these tactics were contrary to the tactics shown in its most recent starts, driver was found guilty to a charge of failing to notify the change of tactics under Rule 44(1) and was fined \$200.

BARJOBIL – (Ryan Warwick) after gaining the lead of the one wide line in the middle stages, over raced and hung inwards racing into the back straight on the final occasion before giving ground over the concluding stages.

Race 7: KILLAWARRA DUSK PACE (2503 SS)

ROCKY ROBINSON – (Justin Prentice) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

CASHMERE SMOOTH – (Brad Stampalia) obtained an inside run in the run to the finish.

MONEY MASTER – (Wesley Andrews) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the Standing Start draw.

SMOOTH ADVANCE – (Callan Suvaljko) galloped out.

TOTAL MOTIVATION – (Chris Lewis) galloped out.

JACCKA TAINE – (Ben Keiley) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the Standing Start draw. Raced three wide throughout.

Race 8: CHAFF CITY CHOICE OF CHAMPIONS STAKES (2130 MBL)

LEFT PRIDE – (Kevin Keys) was slightly out of position at release point, driver was reminded of his obligations.

TRIAL BY JURY – (Callan Suvaljko) when questioned on his driving tactics, in particular his reasons for failing to obtain a position in the one wide line racing out of the back straight to receive the bell and then again failing to follow up runners racing wider on the track racing out of the back straight on the final occasion, driver explained that racing towards the front straight to receive the bell he had attempted to move to the one wide line, however had to desist with the move as another runner had begun to cover his sulky. He had been unaware that the position in the one wide line had been fully available prior to that point, as in his opinion LEFT PRIDE which had commenced a three wide move had hung inwards racing out of the back straight to receive the bell. Racing in the back straight on the final occasion he elected to look for inside runs rather than track up runners wide on the track as TRIAL BY JURY had previously demonstrated when racing wider than the three wide line that it had difficulty in negotiating the turns. He further advised that the gelding in his opinion was not demonstrating the form that it had displayed earlier in the season. It was now his intention to space its runs, however in similar circumstances it would be driven in a similar manner. Driver was advised that he was expected to drive in a manner that would not leave his tactics open to question.

Race 9: CHAFF CITY ROSEMYA ADDITION PACE (2503 SS)

DIANALYN – (Aldo Cortopassi) which began badly, was excluded from the Standing Start draw. Inconvenienced racing in the front straight on the final occasion.

STAR ALLIANCE – (Brad Stampalia) galloped briefly at the start.

DALLAS FLIGHT – (Chris Lewis) galloped out.

SANA SANO – (Kim Prentice) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.
 GHOST DANCE – (Callan Suvaljko) failed to run on over the concluding stages.
 FOYS SURPRISE – (Tony Ciuppa) failed to run on over the concluding stages.
 ELECTRACITED – (Justin Warwick) jumped sideways at the start.

Race 10: CLIFF & BUNTING CUTTER CLAIMING STAKES (2536 MBL)

SOVEREIGN HEIR – (Richard Polak) was checked and raced roughly racing in the back straight on the final occasion.

JUSTALITTLEFELLA – (Justin Warwick) was held up until obtaining a late inside run.

THE DIE IS CAST – (Vance Stampalia) pulled hard for the major part of the event.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for SOVEREIGN HEIR (Richard Polak) being checked and racing roughly racing in the back straight on the final occasion. It was established that driver Polak had initially attempted to resist an outwards shift from Morgan Woodley (SUNSET SCOTT). When the resultant wheel to wheel pressure was released, the offside sulky wheel of SUNSET SCOTT shifted up the track quickly making contact with the leg of SOVEREIGN HEIR causing that gelding to race roughly. Under the circumstances, Stewards did not proceed with the matter other than to advise Morgan Woodley to exercise care when attempting to shift ground.
