#### **Race 1: SEAFEAST INTERNATIONAL/"LOMBO POCKET WATCH" CLAIMING STAKES (2130 MBL)**

HES A PLAYER – (Jason Vella) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

KEEPYAFEET – (Ryan Warwick) gave ground over the concluding stages.

#### **General**

CLINTONS CIGAR and FRANCO NOVELLA were claimed from this event.

#### **Race 2: BE ACTIVE STAKES (2130 MBL)**

BELLO SGVARDO – (Morgan Woodley) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

PALE ROSE – (Martin Wilson) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

FEELIN EXOTIC – (Colin Brown) broke racing towards the front straight on the first occasion before being retired from the event. It was subsequently established that the near fore hopple carrying strap had disconnected. Under the circumstances no action was taken against the race manners of FEELIN EXOTIC. Trainer Kevin Nolan was fined \$200 under the provisions of Rule 273(2) for having failed to tape the carrying straps after having been directed to do so at Pinjarra on 25<sup>th</sup> September 2006 after a similar occurrence had taken place.

DADS ZEPHYR – (Brad Stampalia) was checked racing towards the front straight on the first occasion and severely checked shortly thereafter.

#### **General**

Stewards inquired into the reason for DADS ZEPHYR (Brad Stampalia) being checked racing towards the front straight on the first occasion. Stephen Reed (ART REIGN) pleaded guilty to a charge of causing interference issued under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(a) and had his reinsperson's licence suspended for a period of thirteen days to take effect following his driving engagements on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2006.

#### **Race 3: RED PEPPERS STAKES (2130 MBL)**

BIRDCAGE – (Mark Reed) commenced slowly, then dropped the nearside knee boot in running.

SCRAM JET – (Callan Suvaljko) was tightened racing out of the back straight on the first occasion and inconvenienced racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

SMOOTH BABE – (Kevin Keys) hung inwards racing out of the back straight on the first occasion, a warning was issued.

ARAGORN – (Kade Howson) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

BEEN IN TROUBLE – (Tony Hynam) driver was reprimanded (for causing crossing) under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(a) for the manner in which he shifted ground outwards racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

MIGHTY ASLAN – (Justin Warwick) when questioned on his driving tactics over the concluding stages, in particular his reasons for failing to use the whip, driver explained that the gelding had previously shown a tendency to pull up once gaining the lead of the event and in those circumstances had resented the whip being used. He further explained that if the circumstances of the race were such that the gelding was able to make use of a late sprint to chase the leaders, it did respond to limited whip usage when first making its run. In noting his comments, Stewards were satisfied that he had demonstrated sufficient vigour with his reining up of the gelding.

BLACKANSWEET – (Shannon Suvaljko) which began badly, was excluded from the mobile barrier draw.  
PERIPHERIQUE – (Michael Tenardi) obtained an inside run over the concluding stages.  
GNANGARRA – (Colin Brown) was inconvenienced at the start.

**Race 4: “INNOCENT EYES” STAKES (2130 MBL)**

Nothing to report.

**Race 5: “AMONGST ROYALTY” STAKES (2130 MBL)**

FREDDY RAMA – (Hayden Charles) commenced slowly.  
PRIVATE NUMBER – (Nicolaas Van Der Snoek) shied at the whip of another driver and broke gait racing towards the front straight on the final occasion. Stewards took no action over the matter other than to advise the driver to ensure that when shifting ground there was sufficient room to do so.  
LETS GET CRACKEN – (Shannon Suvaljko) a post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.  
MATT IN BLACK – (Nathan Turvey) was unable to obtain clear running from the 400m to the 200m.

**Race 6: 2006 GARRARD’S HORSE & HOUND BOTRA CUP (2907 SS)**

ONAVENTURE – (Chris Lewis) was held up until obtaining an inside run over the final 100m.  
HER MAN MURRAY – (Kim Prentice) galloped out.  
FINAL QUEST – (Mark Reed) failed to run on over the concluding stages.  
EARL OF LOCKSLEY – (Callan Suvaljko) galloped out.  
NO BLUE MANNA – (Justin Warwick) galloped out.

**Race 7: 2006 DR PAT CRANLEY MEMORIAL SPRINT (1730 MBL)**

PEDAL TO THE METAL – (Ron Young) was held up until racing in the front straight on the final occasion.  
VILLAGE HERO – (Callan Suvaljko) was checked racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.  
BANK THE MONEY – (Edward Knight) hung inwards shortly after the start and then was tightened racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.  
WATERLOO BAY – (Justin Warwick) was held up until racing in the front straight on the final occasion.  
COMMANDER WHITBY – (Chris Lewis) was checked racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.  
ALBERT LONGLEGS – (Brad Stampalia) was inconvenienced racing out of the back straight to receive the bell when the pace in the three wide line eased.  
MANWARRA DREAMAKA – (Colin Brown) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.  
STAR ALLIANCE – (Hayden Charles) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

**General**

Stewards inquired into the reason for COMMANDER WHITBY (Chris Lewis), BANK THE MONEY (Edward Knight) and VILLAGE HERO (Callan Suvaljko) receiving interference racing out of the front straight on the first occasion. Ryan Bell pleaded guilty to a charge of causing interference issued under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(a) and had his reinsperson’s licence suspended for a period of twenty two days to take effect following his driving engagements on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2006.

**Race 8: “LOMBO POCKET WATCH” STAKES (1730 MBL)**

SQUATNOVA – (Justin Prentice) was severely checked racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.  
DIAMOND PAUL – (David Young) hung inwards and broke racing out of the front straight on the first occasion. Will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.  
ADAMS MATE – (Gary Hall Jnr) had some difficulty obtaining clear running to the finish.  
ATLANTA GEORGIA – (Chris Lewis) was checked racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.  
ALL IN TECK – (Ryan Bell) was severely checked racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.  
SON OF HILARION – (Michael Tenardi) was inconvenienced racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.  
ELECTRACITED – (Justin Warwick) was inconvenienced racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

**Race 9: FORCE EQUIPMENT/GRAHAM TAYLOR SULKY REPAIRS MARES HANDICAP (2503 SS)**

DEVILISH GIRL – (David Young) began badly.  
FALCONOVA – (Mark Reed) began badly.  
GIVONI – (Chris Lewis) was inconvenienced shortly after the start.  
BEST WEST – (Ross Keys) was inconvenienced at the start and then broke gait shortly afterwards.  
ELECTRAFIER – (Darren Schofield) was severely checked at the start.  
THE ADMIRALS BYRD – (Wayne Price) began badly, was severely checked racing into the front straight on the final occasion.  
SANA SANO – (Kim Prentice) was checked at the start.

CRYSTAL JOURNEY – (Jason Vella) was checked at the start.  
CASUAL FLING – (Gary Hall Jnr) began badly.

**General**

Stewards inquired into the reason for THE ADMIRALS BYRD (Wayne Price) being severely checked racing into the front straight on the final occasion. It was established that ELECTRAFIER (Darren Schofield) racing to its inside shifted up the track slightly at that point as CRYSTAL JOURNEY (Jason Vella) racing outside THE ADMIRALS BYRD shifted inwards slightly. Under the circumstances Stewards took no action other than to remind drivers of their obligations when shifting ground.

**Race 10: CENTRAL FRUIT SALES STAKES (1730 MBL)**

OTTWAY – (Kade Howson) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

LORD VERMAX – (Morgan Woodley) which began badly, was excluded from the mobile barrier draw. Broke under pressure in the run to the finish. Will not be permitted to race for fourteen days and until such time as it completes two satisfactory trials.

LEADING STAR – (Aldo Cortopassi) was inconvenienced shortly after the start.
