Race 1: FREMANTLE-COCKBURN GAZETTE COMMUNITY STAKES (2143 MBL)

EXCEEDINGTHELIMIT – (Colin Brown) was held up until approaching the 100m.
ISEE NUSSINK – (Brian Ferguson) was checked in the front straight in the run to the finish.
LASTPANGOINPARIS – (Aldo Cortopassi) was checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.
ABERCROMBIEDREAMER – (Callan Suvaljko) was tightened in the front straight to the finish.
PATMA DIDO – (Justin Prentice) was checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.
OSCAR LOMBO – (Colin March) was severely checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for OSCAR LOMBO (Colin March) being severely checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion. Colin Brown (EXCEEDINGTHELIMIT) pleaded guilty to a charge of causing crossing issued under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(a) and his reinsperson's licence was suspended for a period of 13 days.

Stewards inquired into the reason for ISEE NUSSINK (Brian Ferguson) being checked racing in the front straight on the final occasion. Driver Colin Brown (EXCEEDINGTHELIMIT) pleaded guilty to a charge of causing crossing issued under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(a) and his reinsperson's licence was suspended for a period of 11 days. Stewards ruled that both penalties would be served concurrently from midnight 7th April 2006. In assessing both penalties Stewards took into account Mr Brown's guilty pleas, his excellent driving record and his upcoming commitments.

Race 2: CANNING TIMES COMMUNITY STAKES (2143 MBL)

The first attempt at a score up was aborted when the removable deafeners JACKA FROST (Chris Lewis) released prematurely. As a result of this delay the race started several minutes after the advertised start time. LIQUOR LAD – (Clinton Hall) which struck the mobile gate and broke gait at release point was excluded from the mobile barrier draw.
TALKING TOMMY – (Nathan Turvey) raced roughly in the back straight on the final occasion.
PATS DILEMMA – (Gary Hall Jnr) returned with a minor laceration to the off fore.
MAGIC JET – (Steven Jelf) driver advised to set a more appropriate pace when leading.
JACCKA FROST – (Chris Lewis) was checked at the start.

Race 3: SOUTHERN GAZETTE COMMUNITY STAKES (2143 MBL)

VILLAGE ACE – (Kim Prentice) was held up from the 400m to the 200m.
MISTER BOCELLI – (Ryan Bell) the lugging pole became detached in the run.
SERGEANT SANDS – (Clinton Kimes) raced roughly in the front straight to receive the bell.

Race 4: WANNEROO TIMES COMMUNITY PACE (2503 SS)

ACE OF SPADES – (Clinton Kimes) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw.
SMOOTH ADVANCE – (Chris Lewis) was held up until obtaining a late inside run.

BROOKLYN ROAD – (Jarrad Humphries) pulled hard for the majority of the event, was held up until straightening then hung inwards under pressure in the run to the finish.
 MIDNIGHT EYRE – (Gary Hall Jnr) a post race veterinary examination revealed nothing amiss.

Race 5: COMMENT NEWS COMMUNITY MARES STAKES (1742 MBL)

DIANALYN – (Aldo Cortopassi) gave ground over the concluding stages.
 ELECTRACITED – (Justin Warwick) which broke in the score up missing the start by some distance, will remain excluded from the mobile barrier draw.

Race 6: 2006 COMMUNITY NEWSPAPERS WESTERN GATEWAY PACE (2548 MBL)

NOMORE FORUSIR – (Colin Brown) which broke shortly after the start, was excluded from the mobile barrier draw.
 DEVASTATING – (Chris Lewis) obtained a late inside run.
 ALBERTS FANTASY – (Mark Reed) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

Race 7: MELVILLE TIMES COMMUNITY PACE (2503 SS)

OK WINDERMERE – (Chris Lewis) when questioned on his driving tactics driver explained that when pressured in the middle stages whilst leading he had not considered relinquishing the lead as PATCHES, in his opinion had worked too hard in the early stages to gain the lead of the one wide line.
 SOVEREIGN HEIR – (Richard Polak) galloped out.
 PATCHES – (Gary Hall Jnr) driver questioned on his tactics, in particular his reasons for once gaining the lead of the one wide line applying pressure to the leader in the early stages of the last mile before failing to run on. He explained that the pre race instructions had been from his 30m handicap to gain the lead of the one wide line cheaply as possible, then apply even pressure to the leader. In noting his comments, Stewards advised him that in their opinion given the fact that he had overcome his 30m handicap during a quick lead time he had over rated in the middle stages.

Race 8: FREMANTLE FIRST STAKES (2143 MBL)

AM I TOUGH – (Hayden Charles) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.
 ON THE BEACH – (Richard Polak) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

Race 9: MCINERNEY FORD FIESTA COMPETITION PACE (2503 SS)

JACK FORCE – (Clinton Hall) which began badly, was excluded from the Standing Start draw.
 NORTH SEA ADMIRAL – (Mark Reed) galloped out.
 GHOST DANCE – (Chris Lewis) galloped out.
 KARL – (Jarrad Humphries) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the Standing Start draw.

Race 10: WEEKEND COURIER COMMUNITY STAKES (2548 MBL)

SUPERDAVE – (Colin Brown) gave ground over the concluding stages.
 IRON CLAD LOMBO – (Morgan Woodley) gave ground over the concluding stages.
 ARMBRO BRAVE – (Jason Woodworth) contacted a sulky and broke racing out of the back straight on the final occasion. Driver pleaded guilty to a charge of careless driving for attempting to take a run where there was insufficient room to do so (Rule 168(1)) and was fined \$100.
