Race 1: MEMPHIS MELTDOWN 2YO STAKES (1730 MBL)

JUSTLIKECHOCOLATE – (Kim Prentice) began badly, will be excluded from the mobile barrier draw. Had a tendency to over race whilst in a trailing position. Underwent a veterinary examination following the race, which revealed no abnormalities. Driver explained when questioned regarding the performance that it was his opinion that the horse after beginning badly from the barrier draw had a tendency to over race throughout and race greenly which may have been a contributing factor to the performance. Stewards noted the comments.

WILKINS MYE ISRAEL – (Brian Kersley) was excluded from the mobile barrier draw from the meeting Thursday 5th April and will start from the outside of the front line.

CHRISTIAN CALAIS – (Mark Reed) raced roughly in the back straight on the final occasion when being shifted wider on the track by JUSTLIKECHOCOLATE at that point.

Race 2: CONNOISSEUR CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2102 SS)

STAR ALLIANCE – (Colin Brown) tightened racing into the front straight on the final occasion. Had a tendency to over race when racing at the lead of the one wide line.

SPORTSMANS IMAGE – (Martin Wilson) galloped away from the Standing Start.

REST HOLME – (Ryan Warwick) galloped away from the Standing Start.

RENOUNCE – (Nigel Johns) raced roughly at the start, severely checked racing into the home straight on the final occasion.

DEE CAMPESE – (Grant Williams) jumped sideways at the start and galloped away.

SMOOTH ADVANCE - (Matthew Scott) checked racing into the front straight on the final occasion.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for STAR ALLIANCE (Colin Brown) being tightened with a number of runners being checked racing into the front straight on the final occasion. Donald Harper (RICKY RAINBOW) was given the benefit of the doubt as to whether he was the solely responsible when shifting from behind the leader to gain clear running inside of STAR ALLIANCE at the same time as DEE CAMPESE (Grant Williams) was working forward to the outside of STAR ALLIANCE at the same time. Mr Harper made every effort to correct RICKY RAINBOW back to its correct line. Stewards deemed it a racing incident.

Race 3: PETERS CHOC WEDGE TROTTERS DISCRETIONARY HANDICAP (2907 SS)

NACOKEE – (Natalie Duffy) broke gait free of interference on several occasions and as this gelding is a repeat offender, will not be permitted to race for fourteen days and the completion of two satisfactory trials.

COUT THE LUTE – (Callan Suvaljko) after commencing a three wide forward move from the 1400m, failed to run on.

Race 4: PETERS BILLABONG STAKES (2536 MBL)

TWICE THE PLEASURE– (Grant Williams) trainer/driver questioned regarding the improved performance of the mare. Mr Williams advised the Stewards that in his opinion the performance wasn't so much of an improvement considering at its last start after working wide during the early stages, had a tendency to over race throughout which contributed to the performance and following that run had gear chances, one being the

removal of the hood which allowed the mare to settle in behind the leader with today's performance gaining a late run approaching the finish. Stewards noted the comments.

DOLLARMIDDY – (Ryan Warwick) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

REVONAH JACK - (Chris Lewis) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

Race 5: PETERS FROSTY FRUIT CLAIMING STAKES (2130 MBL)

A false start was declared on the first occasion when HONAN (Matthew Scott) broke in the middle stages of the score up and will be excluded from the barrier draw. Tightened racing off the back straight on the final occasion.

KENDALL CASTLE – (Morgan Woodley) tightened racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

THE DIE IS CAST – (Vance Stampalia) shifted outwards under pressure in the home straight approaching the finish.

LEFT A COOKIE – (Gary Hall Jnr) severely checked racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for a number of runners being tightened with LEFT A COOKIE (Gary Hall Jnr) being severely checked racing off the back straight. After interviewing Matthew Scott (HONAN), Morgan Woodley (KENDALL CASTLE), Gary Hall Jnr (LEFT A COOKIE) and Darren Schofield (MASSARUA), no action was taken against any particular driver on this occasion when it was established that MASSARUA which was racing widest on the track, hung inwards momentarily at that time placing LEFT A COOKIE in restricted room.

Race 6: 2007 PETERS TRUMPET EASTER CUP (2907 SS)

ALBERT CHIEF – (Gary Hall Jnr) began badly from the Standing Start, placed on its last chance in the Standing Start barrier draw. Held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

OHOKA ACE – (Chris Lewis) began badly from the Standing Start, placed on its last chance in the Standing Start barrier draw.

Race 7: GIANT SANDWICH STAKES (2130 MBL)

MOTORING ME – (Gary Hall Jnr) failed to muster speed at the start.

AM I TOUGH – (Kody Charles) obtained an inside run approaching the finish.

BULLION BILL – (Bob Mellsop) which led the field throughout, shifted outwards in the home straight under pressure.

FLOYD BROMAC – (Andrew De Campo) held up, until inside the final 80m before gaining clear running.

Race 8: PETERS FRUJU STAKES (2536 MBL)

NELSON STREET – (Gary Hall Jnr) tightened racing into the back straight on the first occasion.

FORDVIEW TIME OUT – (Colin Brown) held up before gaining clear running inside the final 100m.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for NELSON STREET (Gary Hall Jnr) being tightened racing towards the back straight on the first occasion. Morgan Woodley (TIGERS BEST) was reprimanded for causing crossing under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(a) when taking a position in the one out one back when not sufficiently clear of the legs of NELSON STREET at that time.

Race 9: PETERS FREEZA SLUSHY MARES STAKES (2130 MBL)

RED HOT DATE – (Adam Nafranec) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

CHILLI DAWN – (Ryan Warwick) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

DYNAMITE FREEDOM – (Colin Brown) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

TROUBLESCENE – (Chris Lewis) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.
