Race 1: DBC TALK ABOUT TASTE STAKES (2130 MBL)

PATMA DIDO – (Justin Prentice) which began badly, will be excluded from the mobile barrier draw, trailed the field throughout.

ALKIRA JET – (Bernhard Planke) checked at the start, then after commencing a three wide forward move from the 1200m, failed to run on over the concluding stages, returned with a broke buxton breastplate also the trace was detached

DISCO FLYER – (Raymond Jones) after commencing a three wide forward move from the 1200m, failed to run on over the concluding stages.

PRIVATE NUMBER – (Mark Reed) held up before gaining an inside run passing the 100m.

WILKINS SARIAH – (Brad Stampalia) accidentally contacted a sulky and raced roughly racing off the back straight on the final occasion.

Race 2: DBC TIMBER HILL PORK CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2102 SS)

RAP TALK – (Colin Brown) which led throughout, shifted outwards in the home straight approaching the finish.

DALLAS FLIGHT – (Ryan Warwick) galloped away from the Standing Start, held up and failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

WATERLOO BAY – (Shane Butterworth) reared at the start and stood flatfooted, will be excluded from the Standing Start barrier draw, trailed the field throughout.

THE ARCH DEACON – (Darren Kerr) began badly from the Standing Start, will continue to be excluded from the barrier draw.

IAM CLIVE – (Morgan Woodley) held up until the passing the 100m before gaining an inside run.

XTRA RATIONS – (Callan Suvaljko) checked at the start, held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

SEELSTER CUT – (Mark Reed) checked at the start, held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

SMOOTH ADVANCE – (Matthew Scott) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

VIEW TO A KILL – (Clinton Hall) began badly from the Standing Start. No action will be taken in the circumstances when it was established that the barrier strand may have contacted the chest of that gelding upon release.

FORWARD POCKET – (Brad Stampalia) checked at the start.

Race 3: GREG MACKINTOSH STAKES (2130 MBL)

A false start was declared on the first occasion when DIAMOND PAUL broke gait in the score up causing interference to second line runners, excluded from the mobile barrier draw. Driver dropped his footrest from the sulky approaching the finish. It was established that the seat of the sulky on DIAMOND PAUL became loose during the race.

JAMES VICTOR – (Morgan Woodley) which led the field throughout, gave ground over the concluding stages.

MORGANATOR – (Donald Harper) held up in the early stages before gaining clear running passing the 100m

OSCAR LOMBO – (Ryan Warwick) inconvenienced racing towards the back straight on the first occasion when the speed of the one wide line eased.

General

Stewards questioned Morgan Woodley (JAMES VICTOR) in relation to his driving tactics in the early stages when leading and given an opportunity to gain a favourable position by EASY ON THE POCKET (Aaron Beckett) which had applied pressure for some distance, however resisted the challenge and retained the lead setting a very fast lead time. Mr Woodley explained that it was his instructions from trainer Mrs Vivienne Moran if able to gain the lead and hold it and not surrender, however felt the pressure applied by EASY ON THE POCKET and the early speed contributed to JAMES VICTOR over racing from that point onwards. He was not able to settle the gelding thereafter which would have contributed to the overall performance. Trainer Vivienne Moran when questioned by the Stewards confirmed the driving instructions given to Morgan Woodley and further advised that in the past when driven to lead the horse has always shown his best form notwithstanding the early speed. After considering the evidence put by Morgan Woodley and trainer Vivienne Moran, noted the comments, however advised Morgan Woodley to drive in a manner, which would not leave him open to question.

Race 4: DBC ORIGINAL FERGUSON VALLEY VEAL STAKES (2130 MBL)

Nothing to report.

Race 5: GMTC READY TO RACE PACER 3YO STAKES (2130 MBL)

PERFECT RHOIE – (Grant Williams) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.
EVEN DROP – (Callan Suvaljko) contacted a sulky, raced roughly in the front straight on the first occasion, inconvenienced in the back straight to receive the bell.
DISCO INVASION – (Raymond Jones) was retired in the back straight to receive the bell after sustaining a flat tyre entangling in the axils, no action was taken in the circumstances.

Race 6: 2006 DBC TENDER RIDGE BEEF 2YO COLTS & GELDINGS STATE SIRES SERIES FINAL (2130 MBL)

JACK CANTELL – (Nathan Turvey) inconvenienced at the start, then inconvenienced racing off the back straight on the first occasion.
JAY FACTOR – (Kim Prentice) hung inwards as the start was effected, then hung inwards racing off the back straight on the first occasion.
ADDA DOUBLE DIP – (Susan Roberts) began badly, will be excluded from the mobile barrier draw.

Race 7: 2006 GANNON'S WA WINTER CUP (2536 MBL)

IONTHEBALL – (Clinton Hall) over raced throughout when leading the field.
HILTON ADONIS – (Ryan Warwick) held up, failed to gain clear running until the closing stages.
LIGHTNING JAKE – (Shane Butterworth) failed to run on over the concluding stages after commencing a three wide forward move at the 1200m. Underwent a veterinary examination following the race, which revealed nothing amiss. Trainer Tracey Reed when questioned on the performance considered the consistently fast pace throughout the race may have contributed to the performance when being brought to a three wide line at the 1200m, was unable to sustain those speeds failing to run on. Stewards noted the comments.

Race 8: GANNON FAMILY STAKES (2130 MBL)

PARIS HEARTBEAT – (Steven Jelf) which raced at the lead throughout, shifted outwards in the home straight approaching the finish.
WILL TO LIVE – (Chris Lewis) held up before gaining clear running in the closing stages.

Race 9: GANNON'S PACING COLOURS MARES HANDICAP (2503 SS)

MOTU FLARE AND STYLE – (Ryan Warwick) began badly, will be excluded from the Standing Start barrier draw. Held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.
WHOSKINNAMI – (Mark Reed) galloped away from the Standing Start and returned with the nearside knee boot displaced.
ZESTY LOMBO – (Clinton Hall) checked at the start.
SMOOTH VIEW – (Callan Suvaljko) checked at the start.
EL ROSA – (Aaron Beckett) jumped sideways at the start and began badly. Will be placed on its last chance in Standing Start races.
ALBERTS GIRL – (Colin Brown) checked at the start.
BONSHAR – (Aldo Cortopassi) held up, unable to gain clear running approaching the finish.

ANGRYLITTLEBEAVER – (Aaron Skalecki) began badly from the Standing Start, placed on its last chance in the barrier draw.

TILLY WINS – (Shane Young) which began badly from the Standing Start, will continue to be excluded from the barrier draw.

Race 10: GANNON'S PRESENTATION RUGS & TROPHIES 2YO STAKES (2130 MBL)

FANCY A SAPPHIRE – (Aaron Skalecki) momentarily tightened and raced roughly in restricted room racing off the back straight on the first occasion.

BAYLISTIC BOY – (Chris Lewis) hung inwards momentarily racing off the back straight on the first occasion shifted outwards in the home straight approaching the finish.

LINDAS ONLY – (Colin Reeves) accidentally contacted a sulky and broke gait in the back straight on the final occasion, no action was taken in the circumstances. Obtained an inside run approaching the finish.

BEAUJO – (Mark Reed) hung inwards throughout whilst in a trailing position, contacting marker pegs, performed poorly to finish some distance at the rear. Connections were advised that the gelding would be placed on its last chance to race competitively.

THE RACONTEUR – (Tonia Stampalia) out of position at the start, will continue to be excluded from the mobile barrier draw. Gave ground over the concluding stages.
