#### **RACE 1: OZ WEST PACING STAKES (2130 MBL)**

FALCONOVA – (Nicolaas Van Der Snoek) raced roughly briefly racing towards the home turn when attempting to gain clear running.

#### **RACE 2: R H TROTTER FRUIT & VEGETABLE PACE (2503 SS)**

SMOOTH ADVANCE – (Matthew Scott) held up failed again clear running approaching the finish.  
ON THE AGENDA – (Clinton Hall) began badly from the Standing Start, placed on its last chance in the barrier draw.  
WILLOWLEAF STAR – (Mark Reed) jumped sideways at the start.  
IDEAL LAVROS – (Grant Williams) galloped away from the Standing Start.  
OXFORD DEBATE – (Morgan Woodley) galloped away from the Standing Start, and will remain excluded from the barrier draw.  
ARTFUL MOOVER – (Kim Prentice) began badly from the Standing Start, placed on its last chance in the barrier draw, experienced difficulty in the home straight gaining clear running.

#### **RACE 3: CHIKO PATHWAY SERIES STAKES (2130 MBL)**

Starter was obliged to turn the field away on the first occasion when the earplug on K JS ROCKET (Andrew De Campo) released prematurely. Consequently this race started three minutes past the advertised starting time.  
ROSEWORTHY LAD – (Gary Hall Jnr) had a tendency to over race whilst in a trailing position during the early stages. Hung outwards under pressure approaching the home straight on the final occasion.

#### **RACE 4: NEXUS FREIGHT STAKES (1730 MBL)**

BACKSEAT DREAMER – (Shannon Suvaljko) which led throughout, shifted outwards under pressure approaching the finish.  
LONGSHOREMAN – (Vance Stampalia) had a tendency to over race when racing in the three wide position throughout.

#### **General**

Stewards questioned Gary Hall Jnr (WALESA) regarding his driving tactics, in particular, if he gave consideration to commencing a forward move three wide in the front straight to receive the bell. Mr Hall explained that he did consider that move. However, he was of the opinion that Chris Lewis (GLEES JASPER) would have shifted at the same time leaving him in a three wide position and then would possibly be forced wider by other runners thereafter. The fast tempo of the race throughout was a deciding factor when taking an inside run from the 700m enabling him to save ground over the concluding stages. Stewards considering the explanation noted the comments and took the matter no further.

#### **RACE 5: BELL-VISTA FRUIT & VEGETABLE PACE (1730 MBL)**

ONAVENTURE – (Callan Suvaljko) raced roughly shortly after the start, held up failed again clear running approaching the finish.

JACCKA TAINE – (Kim Young) began badly from the Standing Start, placed on its last chance in the barrier draw, inconvenienced in the back straight on the first occasion. Trainer when queried regarding the improved performance explained prior to last week's first up performance, the horse was working in good order and accordingly was supported by the connections. However, failed to pace satisfactorily throughout, losing ground as a consequence made necessary gear changes by removing the go straight spreaders to ordinary spreaders enabling the gelding to pace smoothly as evidenced on tonight's performance. Stewards noted the comments.

TRICKY VIC – (Mark Reed) held up in the home straight before gaining clear running inside the final 70m.

ITS NO FAKE – (Ryan Warwick) inconvenienced in the back straight on the first occasion when the pace eased.

JAILBIRD – (Kim Prentice) began badly from the Standing Start, placed on its last chance in the barrier draw, held up and failed again clear running approaching the finish.

**RACE 6: RSM BIRD CAMERON PACE (2130 MBL)**

TRIAL BY JURY – (Callan Suvaljko) momentarily inconvenienced in restricted room in the home straight approaching the finish.

UNI BOUND – (Kade Howson) underwent a precautionary veterinary examination prior to the race upon return from a lengthy spell.

DEMORALIZER – (Beau Tindale) experienced difficulty in the home straight approaching the finish when attempting to gain clear running.

**RACE 7: HOMESTYLE SALAD MAKERS STAKES (2536 MBL)**

ARMBRO OF WAGIN – (Amy Spurr) locked wheels with another runner in the back straight on the first occasion, severely checked racing towards the home straight on the final occasion.

JACK CANTELL – (Nathan Turvey) held up, failed again clear running approaching the finish.

MY STRIKING JET – (Shannon Suvaljko) which led the field, shifted outwards under pressure approaching the finish.

BARJOHBIL – (Ryan Warwick) hung inwards in the back straight on the first occasion, locked wheels with another runner.

LUNAR LYNX – (Morgan Woodley) raced erratically racing towards the front straight on the final occasion, will be placed on its last chance to race truly.

CASSIE ROX – (Kevin Keys) held up for clear running before gaining a late inside run.

**General**

Stewards inquired into the reasons for ARMBRO OF WAGIN (Amy Spurr) being severely checked racing towards the front straight on the final occasion. Morgan Woodley (LUNAR LYNX) was given the benefit of the doubt as to whether he was solely responsible or whether that colt when racing erratically shifted outwards despite his efforts at the same time HALF A MILL (Brad Stampalia) shifted inwards marginally. Stewards took the matter no further.

**RACE 8: SEALANES PACE (2102 SS)**

THE TWO OF US – Ryan Warwick) which led the field throughout, shifted outwards under pressure approaching the finish.

MOTORING SAM – (Chris Lewis) galloped away from the Standing Start.

HOPE TO REIGN – (Clinton Hall) galloped away from the Standing Start.

LETS GET ON BOARD – (Kade Howson) checked at the start.

EXPLOSIVE ATOM – (Callan Suvaljko) galloped away from the Standing Start, will continue to be excluded from barrier draw.

BROOKLYN ROAD – (Brian Kersley) slow to begin from the Standing Start.

LOGAN MICK – (Brad Stampalia) galloped away from the Standing Start, had a tendency to over race whilst in a trailing position.

GREATSOUTHERNSTAR – (Vance Stampalia) jumped sideways at the start, galloped away.

**RACE 9: D'ORSOGNA STAKES (2130 MBL)**

Starter was obliged to turn the field away on the first occasion when the earplugs on TAIHAPE TICKLER released prematurely, consequently this race three minutes past the advertised starting time.

ALBERT RAINER – (Stephen Reed) obtained an inside run in the home straight approaching the finish.

SILENT FIVE – (Shannon Suvaljko) which led the field throughout, shifted outwards under pressure approaching the finish. Driver reprimanded under the provisions of Rule 168(1) for being careless

JAKE THE MUS – (Ryan Warwick) locked wheels in the back straight with another runner on the final occasion, shifted outwards under pressure approaching the finish. Driver reprimanded under the provision of Rule 168(1) for being careless.

JOHNSTAN MONEIL – (Chris Lewis) raced roughly in the latter stages of the score up, marginally out of position at the start, had a tendency to race roughly at various stages.

KENDALL CASTLE – (Morgan Woodley) locked wheels in the back straight on the final with another runner.

**RACE 10: BLIND SPOT FOR BLINDS (1730 MBL)**

TRUE VERDICT – (Chris Lewis) inconvenienced racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.

TYLO – (Ryan Warwick) accidentally contacted a sulky, broke gait racing out of the front straight on the first occasion. No action was taken in the circumstances. Inconvenienced racing towards the home straight on the final occasion.

BAYETE NKOSI – (Andrew De Campo) broke gait, free of interference racing towards the front straight to receive the bell, will not be permitted to race for a period of six days, and until the completion of one satisfactory trial. Checked and broke gait racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.

CALAFIA – (Darren Kerr) checked racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.

I LIKE IT – (Justin Prentice) checked racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.

**General**

Stewards inquiring into the reasons for TYLO being severely checked racing towards the front straight on the final occasion. Will adjourn the inquiry until Stewards are able to interview drivers Ryan Warwick, Chris Lewis and Morgan Woodley.
