Race 1: CFM TECHNOLOGY STAKES (2130 MBL)

ROLLON SEYMOUR – (Shane Butterworth) commenced slowly.
WATERLOO BAY – (Justin Warwick) failed to run on over the concluding stages
US SUCCESS – (Ryan Warwick) after being obliged to race wider on the track in the front straight to receive the bell, failed to run on over the concluding stages.
ARMBRO BRAVE – (Kade Howson) was inconvenienced shortly after the start.
OH WHAT A CLASSIC – (Colin Brown) failed to run on over the concluding stages.
WALTON BOY – (Aaron Skalecki) broke racing out of the back straight on the first occasion and again racing into the front straight on the first occasion. Shortly afterwards the offside hopple shortening cord became entangled in the hopple causing the horse to break gait for a short distance. Walton Boy will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

Race 2: CFM CHANNEL 12 STAKES (2536 MBL)

BRINDA BELLA LOMBO – (Kim Prentice) commenced slowly, raced erratically throughout and failed to run on over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Trainer Mr Noel Keiley advised the mare would be immediately retired.
BANK THE MONEY – (Edward Knight) hung outwards at various stages whilst leading. When questioned on his reason for rating up racing out of the back straight on the second last occasion by removing the deafeners and urging the gelding, driver explained that he had been concerned by AMBERS GIFT (Aaron Skalecki) issuing a three wide challenge at that point and wanted to clearly indicate that he intended to retain the lead. In noting his comments, Stewards advised him that he was expected to show greater judgement in similar circumstances.
OXFORD DEBATE – (Chris Lewis) locked sulky wheels for a short distance racing in the back straight on the final occasion.
TOALLAGOODKNIGHT – (Mark Reed) was inconvenienced at the start.
AMBERS GIFT – (Aaron Skalecki) locked sulky wheels for a short distance racing in the back straight on the final occasion.

Race 3: CFM PACER OF THE YEAR STAKES (2130 MBL)

MACROSSAN – (Gary Hall Jnr) was severely checked racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.
SOVEREIGN FELLA – (Beau Tindale) failed to run on over the concluding stages.
MY HOLY WHITBY – (Adam Nafranec) after being eased wider on the track racing towards the front straight on the final occasion, hung inwards, made contact with a sulky and broke gait. The horse will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.
LITTLE FELLA – (Chris Lewis) was severely checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion, losing considerable ground.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for LITTLE FELLA (Chris Lewis) being severely checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion. It was established that as MACROSSAN (Gary Hall Jnr) crossed from

wider on the track the nearside reinburr became caught in the driving ring causing the gelding to lose momentum at that point with LITTLE FELLA contacting the nearside sulky wheel and breaking gait. Under the circumstances Stewards took no action over the matter other than to advise trainer Ms Kristy Padberg to modify the reinburr.

Race 4: COOL CLEAR WATER FHRC LEADING DRIVER STAKES (2130 MBL)

FRANCO NOVELLA – (Callan Suvaljko) was claimed from this event.

MONEY MASTER – (Mark Reed) was held up until obtaining an inside run over the closing stages.

MAGIC LOCH – (Steven Jelf) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

Race 5: COOL CLEAR WATER COMPANY STAKES (2130 MBL)

KOTARE FLAME – (Clinton Hall) tightened in restricted room racing off the back straight on the final occasion.

NO BLUE MANNA – (Ryan Warwick) tightened, contacted a sulky and raced roughly racing off the back straight on the final occasion.

HILTON ADONIS – (Justin Warwick) hung inwards racing off the back straight on the final occasion.

Race 6: 2006 FHRC NEW SEASON PACE (2130 MBL)

General

The Starter was obliged to abort the first attempt at a score up when TAIHAPE TICKLER (Chris Lewis) required a gear adjustment.

AM I TOUGH – (Hayden Charles) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

General

Stewards delayed the All Clear after Justin Warwick driver of the fourth placed ELECTRACITED requested a viewing of the films to ascertain whether he had grounds for a protest against the third placed IANALBERT (Callan Suvaljko) for carrying him up the track in the run to the finish. After viewing the films, driver Justin Warwick elected not to proceed with the matter.

Race 7: COOL CLEAR WATER FOUNTAINS STAKES (2536 MBL)

ROUSTABOUT – (Kim Prentice) was tightened racing out of the front straight after receiving the bell.

DOCTOR EVIL – (Shane Butterworth) was checked racing out of the front straight on the first occasion, when the pace in the one wide line eased.

KOBIASHI MARU – (John Jelf) was severely checked racing out of the front straight on the first occasion when the pace in the one wide line eased.

JAKE THE MUS – (Justin Prentice) when questioned on the apparent improved performance following its unplaced run at Gloucester Park last Friday, trainer Kim Prentice explained that the gelding had been unsuited by the circumstances of last week's race, when asked to work forward in reasonably quick sectionals. The gelding had benefited from that run and had worked well through the week. In addition the gelding had been racing in easier company this evening.

ALBERT LONGLEGS – (Brad Stampalia) contacted a sulky and raced roughly racing out of the front straight on the first occasion when the pace in the one wide line eased.

THE FINAL WORD – (Callan Suvaljko) was inconvenienced racing out of the front straight on the first occasion when the pace in the one wide line eased.

General

When questioned on his driving tactics, in particular his reason for not commencing a forward move racing in the back straight to receive the bell driver explained that he had been instructed to save the mare for a final sprint to ensure that it continued its run to the finish. He had sought permission to vary his tactics if the circumstances of the race permitted but was advised to adhere to his instructions. Trainer Noel Keiley confirmed the instructions issued however advised that in hindsight the mare might have been better suited improving its position from the 1400m given the pace at that stage. He advised that in future the mare might be better driven to utilise the circumstances of the race.

Race 8: CHAFF CITY FHRC LEADING TRAINER PACE (2102 SS)

BALTHAZAR – (Murray Hansen) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw.

OUR SAFELY STAR – (Colin Brown) galloped briefly at the start.

DOCTEL RAGER – (Mark Reed) raced roughly after the start.

CHELSEA VILLAGE – (Grant Williams) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw.

TRUCKERS WARRIOR – (Gary Hall Jnr) which began badly, was excluded from the Standing Start draw.

MACHINE GUN – (Ryan Warwick) raced roughly after the start.

SPORTSMANS ECHO – (Lindsay Baker) was checked shortly after the start.

CROUCHO MARX – (Craig Goldfinch) was severely checked shortly after the start.

BROKEN HILL BILLY – (Shane Young) was severely checked shortly after the start.

Race 9: CHAFF CITY PACE (2503 SS)

THE ADMIRALS BYRD – (Wayne Price) galloped out.

GIVONI – (Grant Williams) when questioned on his driving tactics, in particular his reasons for rating up racing in the back straight on the final occasion, driver explained that he had been conscious of LADY DE BEAU (Chris Lewis) making ground in the three wide line. It had been his intention to make it difficult for that mare to make ground, however in hindsight he conceded that he may have over rated slightly in that quarter.

EASTWOOD STAR – (Glen Richards) galloped out.

RYLEE JO – (Clinton Kimes) which commenced slowly, will remain excluded from the Standing Start draw.

BONSHAR – (Aldo Cortopassi) raced with the nearside sulky tyre deflated for the final 1900m.

TILLY WINS – (Shane Young) which galloped out, will remain excluded from the Standing Start draw.

LADY DE BEAU – (Chris Lewis) commenced slowly.

Race 10: CHAFF CITY CHOICE OF CHAMPIONS STAKES (1730 MBL)

U RIPPA – (Ryan Warwick) which began badly, was excluded from the mobile barrier draw.

SAFE IMPACT – (Chris Lewis) which hung inwards shortly after the start making contact with a sulky wheel and breaking gait. The gelding, which trailed the field by a considerable margin was excluded from the mobile barrier draw.
