### Stipendiary Stewards Report

#### **Race 1: MCINERNEY FORD TERRITORY PATHWAY SERIES STAKES (2130 MBL)**

CITY PRINCE – (John Jelf) which raced roughly at the start and broke gait shortly afterwards, was excluded from the mobile barrier draw.

DEBT PROPELLED – (Ryan Warwick) which broke racing out of the back straight on the first occasion, will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial. Failed to run on over the concluding stages.

OK LOCH – (Jon Gavin) severely checked racing towards the front straight on the first occasion.

COLONIAL BLAZE – (Mark Reed) broke gait racing out of the back straight on the first occasion when being checked to avoid a galloping runner, under the circumstances no action was taken.

#### **Race 2: MCINERNEY FORD XR FALCON PACE (2102 SS)**

SNEAKYN ON OVER – (Shannon Suvaljko) which began badly, was excluded from the Standing Start draw.

J DS BEAU – (Morgan Woodley) galloped out then was severely checked shortly after the start.

PATS DILEMMA – (James Schrader) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw.

LEFT A COOKIE – (Mark Reed) was checked at the start.

EXPLOSIVE ATOM – (Callan Suvaljko) which jumped sideways at the start, beginning badly, was excluded from the Standing Start draw. Was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

OUR SAFELY STAR – (Colin Brown) was held up until inside the final 100m.

GIVONI – (Ryan Warwick) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

VINTAGE CONCERTO – (Gary Hall Jnr) was severely checked shortly after the start.

#### **Race 3: MCINERNEY FORD FAIRMONT STAKES (2536 MBL)**

FALCONOVA – (Kevin Bailey) which appeared uncomfortable in its pre-race preliminary was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and was passed fit to start. Obtained an inside run to the finish.

FLUENT STYLE – (Gregory Schofield) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

FORDVIEW TIME OUT – (Chris Lewis) was obliged to race wider on the track racing out of the back straight to receive the bell.

TOALLAGOODKNIGHT – (Mark Reed) completed the event with the near side knee boot down.

BANK THE MONEY – (Edward Knight) pulled hard for a major part of the event. Was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

MADISON CENTRAL – (Ryan Warwick) was checked racing out of the front straight on the first occasion and racing in the front straight on the final occasion.

#### **General**

Stewards inquired into the reason for MADISON CENTRAL (Ryan Warwick) being checked racing out of the front straight on the first occasion. Shane Butterworth (ROLLON SEYMOUR) was found guilty to a charge of causing crossing (Rule 163(1)(a)) and had his reinsperson's licence suspended for sixteen days to take effect following his driving engagements at Williams on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> December 2006.

Stewards inquired into the reason for FORDVIEW TIME OUT (Chris Lewis) being obliged to race wider on the track racing out of the back straight to receive the bell. It was established that SOSA (Matthew Scott) had commenced an outward move prior to being covered by FORDVIEW TIME OUT.

At the conclusion of an inquiry into the reason for MADISON CENTRAL being checked racing in the front straight on the final occasion, Edward Knight (BANK THE MONEY) pleaded guilty to a charge of causing interference (Rule 163(1)(a)) and had his reinsperson's licence suspended for ten days. In determining penalty, Stewards took his guilty plea and excellent record into account.

**Race 4: MCINERNEY FORD FOCUS STAKES (1730 MBL)**

JACCKA FROST – (Jon Gavin) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

GREATSOUTHERNSTAR – (Mark Reed) after leading the event, failed to run on over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Driver Mark Reed was of the opinion the gelding may have suffered a soft palate displacement. Trainer Kristy Padberg was of the opinion that the gelding had been unsuited by the early pressure applied. It was her intention to have blood tests taken. She would advise Stewards of any findings.

**Race 5: MCINERNEY FORD XR6 PACE (2503 SS)**

VICTORY DUKE – (Kody Charles) pulled hard for a major part of the event.

DREAM SOFTLY – (Morgan Woodley) which stood flat-footed at the start, was placed on its last chance in the draw.

BONSHAR – (Aldo Cortopassi) which galloped out and was checked shortly after the start, gave ground over the concluding stages. Placed on its last chance to race competitively.

REST HOLME – (Mark Reed) which began badly, was excluded from the Standing Start draw.

FORWARD POCKET – (Brad Stampalia) which began badly, will remain excluded from the Standing Start draw.

**Race 6: MCINERNEY FORD TERRITORY TURBO STAKES (2130 MBL)**

NATS NIFTY – (Callan Suvaljko) gave ground over the final 400m of the event to finish some distance from the remainder of the field.

OHOKA ACE – (Chris Lewis) which raced below expectations underwent a post race veterinary examination, which revealed no abnormalities. When questioned on the performance, driver advised that in his opinion the gelding had raced below previous performances and may not have been suited by the three week break between runs. Stewards will question trainer Andrew De Campo over the performance.

**Race 7: 2006 MCINERNEY FORD 4YO CLASSIC (2130 MBL)**

CAPRICORN COMANDER – (Chris Lewis) which choked down racing in the back straight on completion of a lap, will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

ALBERTS FANTASY – (Aaron Beckett) performed poorly to finish a considerable distance from the remainder of the field. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Driver Aaron Beckett was of the opinion the gelding had completed the event with its tongue over the bit. Trainer Jason Fry will be questioned regarding the performance.

NOMORE FORUSIR – (Colin Brown) was severely checked racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

MY BOY ROY – (Grant Williams) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

**General**

Stewards inquired into the reason for NOMORE FORUSIR (Colin Brown) being severely checked racing out of the back straight on the final occasion. It was established that racing down the back straight on the final occasion as runners had shied up the track slightly from the fallen CAPRICORN COMANDER, MY BOY ROY (Grant Williams) commenced to make ground to the inside of NOMORE FORUSIR. Racing out of the back straight due to general tightening, NOMORE FORUSIR was placed in restricted room and broke gait with MY BOY ROY obliged to race inside several marker peps. Under the circumstances, no action was taken.

**Race 8: MCINERNEY FORD FIESTA PACE (2503 SS)**

OXFORD DEBATE – (Morgan Woodley) galloped out. Held up for a clear run until inside the 100m.

WAY OF LIFE – (Justin Prentice) galloped out.

SEELSTER CUT – (Mark Reed) galloped out.

BREAKING WAVES – (Donald Harper) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

VANLO YORKER – (Michael Tenardi) which began badly, will remain excluded from the Standing Start draw.

### **General**

Morgan Woodley driver of the second placed OXFORD DEBATE viewed the official patrol films prior to deciding if a protest against the winner WAY OF LIFE (Justin Prentice) alleging interference in the run to the finish was justified. He elected not to proceed with the matter.

### **Race 9: MCINERNEY FORD COURIER STAKES (1730 MBL)**

YIPPY YI YALBERT – (Scott Hamilton) was checked racing into the front straight on the final occasion.

LOMBO WARRANTY – (Mark Reed) returned having dropped the near side knee boot and with a laceration to that knee.

BLACKANSWEET – (Shannon Suvaljko) was tightened racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.

AMBERS GIFT – (Donald Harper) broke racing towards the front straight on the final occasion. It was established that under hard driving the gelding had been allowed to shift in tightening another runner and when being corrected by its driver, broke gait. Under the circumstances, no action was taken, however the driver was advised that he was expected to demonstrate far greater control in similar circumstances.

MISTA TIGGA – (Colin Brown) was checked racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.

### **Race 10: MCINERNEY FORD XR8 STAKES (1730 MBL)**

ELECTRAFIER – (Morgan Woodley) which began badly, was excluded from the mobile barrier draw for four race or trial starts. Inconvenienced behind a tiring runner racing in the back straight on the final occasion.

EL ROSA – (Callan Suvaljko) performed poorly losing considerable ground over the final stages to finish some distance from the remainder of the field. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Trainer Callan Suvaljko was advised that the mare would not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

## **GENERAL**

### **Race 2 MILWAUKEE STAKES (2536m mobile) at Gloucester Park on Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> November 2006**

Trainer Greg Bond reported that veterinary tests carried out following the disappointing performance of FINA GEMIMA had revealed the mare to be suffering from a slight lung infection, which had responded to treatment.
