### **Stipendiary Stewards Report**

#### **Race 1: TOYOTA PARTS MANAGERS PATHWAY SERIES STAKES (2130 MBL)**

LOMBO PROFILE – (Adam Mellisop) was severely checked, dislodging its driver, racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.

CHICO VERANO – (Chris Lewis) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

SLICK JOE – (Terry Trewenack) was severely checked racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.

#### **General**

Stewards inquired into the reason for SLICK JOE (Terry Trewenack) and LOMBO PROFILE (Adam Mellisop) being severely checked racing towards the front straight on the final occasion. It was established that RYLEE JO (Vance Stampalia) had shifted outwards from the one wide line at that point tightening the ground of SLICK JOE, which was restrained making contact with the near side sulky wheel of LOMBO PROFILE resulting in driver Adam Mellisop being dislodged. Vance Stampalia was found guilty to a charge of causing crossing issued under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(a) and his reinsperson's licence was suspended for sixteen days to take effect following his driving engagements at Gloucester Park on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> February 2007. In assessing penalty, Stewards gave consideration to Mr Stampalia's good driving record.

#### **Race 2: TOYOTA SERVICE MANAGERS PATHWAY SERIES STAKES (2130 MBL)**

LORD WASHINGTON – (Jason Huston) raced roughly racing out of the back straight on the first occasion. Was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

CASSIE ROX – (Stephen Reed) made contact with the mobile barrier just prior to release point.

ECHOES – (Colin Brown) made contact with the mobile barrier just prior to release point.

#### **Race 3: TOYOTA FINANCIAL SERVICES STAKES (1730 MBL)**

TROUBLESCENE – (Jarrad Humphries) failed to run on over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Trainer advised that the mare would be sent for an immediate spell.

CANTAFEND – (Colin Brown) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

TIGERS BEST – (Brad Stampalia) was held up until the concluding stages.

UMERE LAD – (Jason Huston) raced roughly at the start.

GIFTED OPERATOR – (Beau Tindale) had difficulty obtaining clear running to the finish.

NEXT TIGER – (Michael Tenardi) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

#### **Race 4: TOYOTA WA DISTRIBUTOR STAKES (1730 MBL)**

ONA REINBOW – (Morgan Woodley) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

IMAGREEKTOO – (Michael Tenardi) the offside sulky tyre deflated at the 400m mark.

#### **Race 5: TOYOTA EXTRA CARE CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2503 SS)**

MEMO – (Morgan Woodley) was held up until obtaining a late run.

JIMMY KELLY – (Callan Suvaljko) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

OTTWAY – (Ryan Bell) which delayed the start by being fractious, was excluded from the Standing Start draw.

WIZARD OF SCAR – (Ian Davie) delayed the start.

ARMBRO BRAVE – (Kade Howson) which reared at the start and began badly, will remain Right Out of the Draw.

MR ACEMAN – (Mark Reed) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

SHELLSTAR – (Colin Brown) was held up until obtaining a late inside run.

MORGANATOR – (Chris Lewis) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw.

**Race 6: TOYOTA DEALER NETWORK STAKES (2130 MBL)**

OUR CHRISTIE LEE – (Ryan Warwick) hung inwards racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

THE FINAL WORD – (Chris Lewis) broke racing out of the back straight on the first occasion. A post race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be sore in both fore legs. THE FINAL WORD will not be permitted to race or trial until such time as a Veterinary Certificate of Soundness is produced. In addition it will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

ALL RAPT UP – (Bruno Morrone) was checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.

**Race 7: TOYOTA GENUINE ACCESSORIES CLAIMING CHAMPIONSHIP FINAL (2130 MBL)**

DUFFLECOAT FLYER – (Mark Reed) failed to run on over the final 450m.

IONTHEBALL – (Gary Hall Jnr) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

FINEGANS WAKE – (Colin Brown) after gaining a position in the one wide line racing into the front straight on the first occasion was obliged to race wider on the track before being restrained to the rear racing towards the back straight on the first occasion.

**General**

Stewards inquired into the reason for FINEGANS WAKE (Colin Brown) being obliged to race wider in the front straight on the first occasion. After taking evidence from drivers Colin Brown (FINEGANS WAKE) and Aiden Warwick (J DS BEAU). It was established that Colin Brown had restrained inwards from the three wide line marginally ahead of Aiden Warwick shifting outwards from the marker pegs. As a result both drivers jostled for position for some period before Colin Brown relinquished the position. Stewards took no action over the matter other than to remind Aiden Warwick of his obligations as in their opinion Colin Brown had the majority of the position prior to him shifting outwards.

**Race 8: TOYOTA CUSTOMER SERVICES DISCRETIONARY HANDICAP (2503 SS)**

AM I TOUGH – (Hayden Charles) was slow out then broke shortly after the start.

CLASS MATE – (Errol Ashcroft) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw. Had difficulty obtaining a clear run over the late stages.

CLIONA LUCKY – (Aiden Warwick) performed poorly to finish some distance from the remainder of the field. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. The gelding will not be permitted to race in the metropolitan area until regaining country form.

LEFT PRIDE – (Mark Reed) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw, unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

**Race 9: TOYOTA GENUINE PARTS, SERVICE & ACCESSORIES 4YO & 5YO CHAMPIONSHIP (2130 MBL)**

RICHARD HENRY – (Colin Brown) a post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

DION MORRIS – (Terry Ferguson) raced roughly after the start, a warning was issued.

VILLAGE HERO – (Justin Prentice) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

LUCKY PUNCH – (Kade Howson) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

**Race 10: TOYOTA YARIS STAKES (1730 MBL)**

ROSEMOUNT – (Colin Brown) was tightened racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

DARK AS SUEDE – (Warren Robinson) severely checked racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

BRIGHT SIDE – (Steven Jelf) driver dislodged racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

ELITE ARMBRO – (Kim Prentice) severely checked racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

**General**

Stewards inquired into the reason for DARK AS SUEDE (Warren Robinson) being severely checked and driver Steven Jelf (BRIGHT SIDE) being dislodged from the sulky racing out of the front straight on the first occasion. Driver Steven Jelf reserved his plea to a charge of causing interference issued under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(a) and the inquiry was adjourned to a time and date to be fixed due to horses having to vacate the track because of the fireworks display.

### **GENERAL**

Stewards inquired into the reason for Trainer Steve Burton failing to attend a Stewards Inquiry following the running of the meeting at Gloucester Park on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2007. Trainer Burton pleaded guilty to a charge issued under the provisions of Rule 187(1) for failing to attend an inquiry when directed by the Stewards and was fined \$200.
