Stipendiary Stewards Report

Race 1: SKY CHANNEL 2YO STAKES (1730 MBL)

BANGLA ROAD – (Callan Suvaljko) which performed poorly giving ground over the final 600m, underwent a post race veterinary examination, which revealed no abnormalities. Will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

POCKET MONSTER – (Ryan Bell) broke racing out of the back straight on the final occasion. Will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

BAILEY DYLAN – (Chris Lewis) had a tendency to race greenly throughout.

TRUCKERS JONNYUMA – (Gary Hall Jnr) broke shortly after the start, was excluded from the mobile barrier draw.

Race 2: CADUCEUS CLUB MEMBERS STAKES (2536 MBL)

HOLLYWOOD STRIDE – (Callan Suvaljko) obtained a late inside run.

MANSON – (Morgan Woodley) after leading the event, gave ground quickly over the final 500m. Driver explained that although the horse had a tendency to over race, he had been comfortable with the sectionals being run and could offer no explanation for the performance. Trainer advised that she had been extremely disappointed with the performance and now it was her intention to cease training the horse.

BABY BLUES – (Aiden Warwick) momentarily tightened racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

CHICO VERANO – (Colin Brown) hung inwards momentarily racing out of the front straight on the first occasion. Shifted up the track under pressure in the run to the finish.

MISTER GANDOLFINI – (Mario Condipodero) severely checked racing into the back straight on the first occasion.

BLACKANSWEET – (Shannon Suvaljko) inconvenienced racing into the back straight on the first occasion. Held up for a short distance racing towards the front straight on the final occasion, made contact with a sulky and raced roughly.

WALTON BOY – (Mark Reed) severely checked racing towards the back straight on the first occasion.

SORRENTO TUESDAY – (Craig Saligari) severely checked racing towards the back straight on the first occasion.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for SORRENTO TUESDAY (Craig Saligari) being severely checked racing towards the back straight on the first occasion. It was established that BABY BLUES (Aiden Warwick) was taken inwards when not sufficiently clear of SORRENTO TUESDAY with that gelding being contacted and breaking gait. Aiden Warwick was found guilty to a charge of causing interference issued under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(a) and had his reinsperson's licence suspended for a period of twenty days up to and including the 29th March 2007.

Race 3: AUTUMN HARNES EXTRAVAGANZA CLAIMING STAKES (2130 MBL)

FINEGANS WAKE – (Colin Brown) failed to run on over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Trainer advised that in her opinion the gelding had been slow to recover and due to the disappointing performance would be sent for an immediate spell.

DUFFLECOAT FLYER – (Stephen Reed) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

Race 4: CADUCEUS CLUB POSITIVE FOR PACING STAKES (1730 MBL)

OXFORD DEBATE – (Stephen Reed) began badly, was excluded from the mobile barrier draw. Unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

MAI TAI – (Vance Stampalia) shifted up the track under pressure in the run to the finish.

LOMBO PROFILE – (Adam Mellisop) hung outwards in the latter stages of the score up. Unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

Race 5: CADUCEUS CLUB OWNERS STAKES (2130 MBL)

MATT IN BLACK – (Wesley Andrews) broke racing out of the back straight on the first occasion. Will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial. Failed to run on over the concluding stages.

VANLO YORKER – (Mark Reed) which was taken three wide in the middle stages, failed to run on over the concluding stages.

SHES ROYALTY – (Beau Tindale) was obliged to race wider on the track racing in the back straight to receive the bell before being eased to obtain a trailing position in the three wide line.

BULLION BILL – (Adam Mellisop) was out of position at release point. Driver reprimanded under the provisions of Rule 162(1)(j).

AM I TOUGH – (Hayden Charles) was out of position at release point. Driver reprimanded under the provisions of Rule 162(1)(j). Shortly after the start when attempting to gain a position in the one wide line, became unbalanced and broke gait. Under the circumstances, no action was taken.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for SHES ROYALTY (Beau Tindale) being obliged to race wider on the track racing in the back straight to receive the bell. Adam Mellisop (BULLION BILL) pleaded guilty to a charge of making a runner cover more ground than necessary issued under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(b) and had his reinsperson's licence suspended for a period of nineteen days. The suspension was deferred to enable Mr Mellisop to fulfil his driving engagements at Gloucester Park on Friday 16th March 2007.

Race 6: 2007 MEDIA GUILD CUP (2503 SS)

DEMORALIZER – (Mark Reed) began badly, placed on its last chance in the Standing Start draw. Failed to run on over the concluding stages.

ALL IN TECK – (Kim Young) began badly, placed on its last chance in the Standing Start draw.

OUR GOLDEN FINALE – (Shane Young) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

FINAL QUEST – (Morgan Woodley) galloped out. Unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

OK WINDERMERE – (Stephen Reed) checked shortly after the start.

COSMIC FLIGHT – (Callan Suvaljko) began badly, placed on its last chance in the Standing Start draw.

LEFT PRIDE – (Kevin Keys) began badly, checked shortly after the start and then broke shortly afterwards. Will remain excluded from the Standing Start draw. Failed to run on over the concluding stages.

Race 7: 2007 CADUCEUS CLUB CLASSIC (2130 MBL)

ASTROLABE STORM – (David Pellaw) accidentally contacted a sulky and blundered racing out of the back straight to receive the bell.

LINDAS ONLY – (Colin Reeves) jostled for a short distance in the front straight to receive the bell before being obliged to race wider on the track.

FIVE TIN LIDS – (Shannon Suvaljko) was inconvenienced in the front straight to receive the bell.

MISTER MONA LISA – (Chris Lewis) jostled for a short distance in the front straight to receive the bell before easing wider on the track.

DUSTY ROSE – (Nigel Johns) inconvenienced in the front straight to receive the bell.

MISS SHANLEY – (Justin Prentice) checked in the front straight to receive the bell.

Race 8: BE ACTIVE TRIP TO GOLD COAST STAKES (2130 MBL)

SHELLSTAR – (Kim Prentice) failed to run on over the final 400m.

TAIHAPE TICKLER – (Stephen Reed) performed poorly. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. The gelding will not be permitted to race for fourteen days and until such time as it completes two satisfactory trials.

TEALSBY KARITA – (Gary Hall Jnr) was slightly out of position at release point.

Race 9: CADUCEUS CLUB COME AND JOIN US HANDICAP (2503 SS)

JACCKA LAIRD – (Gary Hall Jnr) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

JIMMY KELLY – (Callan Suvaljko) delayed the start by being fractious and then began badly. Placed on its last chance in the Standing Start draw.

EXPLOSIVE ATOM – (Aaron Beckett) broke shortly after the start, placed on its last chance in the Standing Start draw.

KURT RUSTLER – (Colin Brown) delayed the start by being fractious and then began badly. Placed on its last chance in the Standing Start draw.

RICKY RAINBOW – (Donald Harper) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

FORDVIEW TIME OUT – (Chris Lewis) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

Race 10: CHANNEL NINE MARES STAKES (1730 MBL)

RED HOT DATE – (Aiden Warwick) had a tendency to hang outwards whilst leading and shifted up the track slightly in the run to the finish. A warning was issued.

SPIRIT OF NAVAJO – (Justin Warwick) obtained an inside run to the finish.

General

Stewards delayed the All Clear to examine the circumstances of SPIRIT OF NAVAJO (Justin Warwick) obtaining a run inside RED HOT DATE (Aiden Warwick) over the concluding stages. After examining the head on patrol films of each straight and interviewing both drivers, Stewards took no action over the matter other than to place a warning on the race manners of RED HOT DATE as in their opinion its tendency to hang outwards throughout had been the reason that SPIRIT OF NAVAJO had been able to obtain an inside run.
