Race 1: TOYOTA PARTS MANAGERS 3YO STAKES (1742 MBL)

ALBERTS FANTASY – (Mark Reed) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.
MICHAEL FINNIGAN – (Brad Stampalia) after racing at the lead of the one wide line, gave ground over the concluding stages.
MON POPPY MIA – (Callan Suvaljko) was inconvenienced racing into the back straight on the final occasion.
BILLS LEGACY – (Chris Lewis) was checked behind a tiring runner from the 400m to the 200m.

Race 2: MORE 'F' IN FUN STAKES (2143 MBL)

IRON GLOVES – (Brian Kersley) raced roughly in the latter stages of the score up, however was pacing prior to release. Unable to obtain clear running to the finish.
NAT TRICK – (Hayden Charles) had difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 50m.
SON OF A BEACH – (Martin Wilson) gave ground over the concluding stages.
JOHNSTAN MONEIL – (Chris Lewis) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.
OTTWAY – (Gary Hall Jnr) shifted out under pressure in the front straight on the final occasion.

Race 3: TOYOTA SERVICE MANAGERS DISCRETIONARY HANDICAP (2907 SS)

JACCKA TAINE – (Ryan Warwick) raced roughly racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.
JACCKA MEADOW – (Colin Brown) galloped out. After pulling hard for the majority of the event gave ground over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination revealed nothing amiss.
MARDIE ONE – (Kim Prentice) galloped out.
GET SERIOUS – (Vance Stampalia) gave ground over the concluding stages.
EASY MONEY – (Chris Lewis) galloped out.
NATS NIFTY – (Callan Suvaljko) began badly and will remain excluded from the Standing Start draw.

Race 4: TOYOTA FINANCIAL SERVICES CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2102 SS)

MIDNIGHT EYRE – (Gary Hall Jnr) which began badly was placed on its last chance in the draw. A post race veterinary examination revealed nothing amiss.
BODY ARMOUR – (Vance Stampalia) was inconvenienced at the start.
BRYCE CANYON – (Mark Reed) which began badly was excluded from the Standing Start draw. Had a tendency to hang outwards at various stages and broke racing in the back straight on the final occasion. Driver reported that the near side front centre carrying strap became detached in running. A post race veterinary examination revealed nothing amiss. Trainer Mike Reed was advised that the gelding would not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completed a satisfactory trial.
MAGICAL MAC – (Colin Brown) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.
THE OLD CAMP – (Chris Lewis) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.
LITE RED – (Morgan Woodley) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.
ROSIES CONCORDE – (Wayne Reid) which began badly was excluded from the Standing Start draw.
OUR GOLDEN FINALE – (Shane Young) which began badly was placed on its last chance in the draw. Unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

EARL OF LOCKSLEY – (Callan Suvaljko) which began badly was excluded from the Standing Start draw.

Race 5: TOYOTA WA DISTRIBUTORS STAKES (1742 MBL)

AM I TOUGH – (Hayden Charles) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish. Driver was advised to make greater effort to correct the horse in similar circumstances.

HERES HARRY – (James Schrader) was tightened racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

GIFTED OPERATOR – (Jason Woodworth) was tightened racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

JUNIOR JASPER – (Gary Hall Jnr) hung inwards racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

MR ACEMAN – (Darren Kerr) which raced three wide throughout gave ground over the concluding stages.

VIA LAS VEGAS – (Vance Stampalia) raced three wide throughout.

Race 6: 2006 TOYOTA GENUINE PARTS, SERVICE & ACCESSORIES 4YO & 5YO CHAMPIONSHIP (2143 MBL)

The Starter was obliged to turn the field away at the first attempt at the score up when a rein became caught under the sulky shaft of ASIAN PARADISE.

NON COMMITAL – (Jon Gavin) severely checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.

PRECIOUS DYLAN – (Grant Williams) tightened racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.

SERGEANT SANDS – (Stephen Miller) checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.

RICHARD HENRY – (Colin Brown) checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for PRECIOUS DYLAN being tightened and NON COMMITAL being severely checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion. Driver Ryan Warwick (VILLAGE ACE) was found guilty to a charge of Causing Interference issued under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(a) and had his reinsperson's licence suspended for twenty eight days to take effect following his driving engagement on Sunday 12th February 2006.

Race 7: TOYOTA GENUINE ACCESSORIES STAKES (1742 MBL)

AMAZING OFFER – (Vance Stampalia) gave ground over the concluding stages.

CRAB STICK – (Stephen Miller) raced roughly racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

JAILBIRD – (Justin Prentice) gave ground over the concluding stages.

Race 8: TOYOTA COROLLA STAKES (2143 MBL)

SWAPS – (Vance Stampalia) the near side front centre carrying strap became detached passing the 600m.

OSCAR DERBY – (Darren Kerr) broke gait racing out of the back straight on the first occasion and after galloping for a considerable distance was retired from the event. Trainer Darren Kerr was advised that the gelding would not be permitted to race for fourteen days and until such time as it completed two satisfactory trials.

MON POPPIES – (Colin Brown) gave ground over the concluding stages.

KINNEY PRINCE – (Jeffrey Wegner) gave ground over the concluding stages.

Race 9: TOYOTA DEALER NETWORK HANDICAP (2907 SS)

IAM CLIVE – (Kim Prentice) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

JACK FORCE – (Clinton Hall) obtained an inside run to the finish.

BLACKANSWEET – (Callan Suvaljko) which began badly was placed on its last chance in Standing Start events.

FOYS SURPRISE – (Gary Hall Jnr) was inconvenienced at the start.

ALKITTO – (Aaron Skalecki) jumped sideways at the start.

GOOD HEAVENS HOLMES – (Mark Reed) broke after the start.

AFTER THE RAIN – (Colin Brown) galloped briefly at the start.

Race 10: TOYOTA CUSTOMER SERVICE CLAIMING STAKES (1742 MBL)

NORTHERN DIRECTION – (Mark Reed) was inconvenienced behind a tiring runner from the 400m to the 200m.

VOICE OF FREEDOM – (Colin Brown) was tightened racing in the back straight on the final occasion.

JONARK BOY – (Justin Warwick) contacted a sulky and raced roughly racing in the back straight to receive the bell and then hung inwards racing in the back straight on the final occasion.
