RACE 1: SONY BRAVIA LCD TELEVISION STAKES (2130 MBL)

COURAGEOUS GUEST – (Chris Lewis) raced roughly racing out of the back straight on the final occasion and failed to run on over the concluding stages.

LUNAR LYNX – (Morgan Woodley) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

THE IRISH BANKER – (Aiden Warwick) hung inwards racing in the back straight on the final occasion.

CHOOKS REWARD – (Colin Brown) momentarily tightened at the winning post with a lap to travel.

RACE 2: SONY CYBER-SHOT DIGITAL CAMERA PATHWAY SERIES STAKES (2130 MBL)

LORD WASHINGTON – (Mark Reed) tightened inside the line of several marker pegs racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.

PARKYS DILEMMA – (Robert Cassian) hung inwards despite the driver's efforts, racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.

ART JUNIOR – (Vance Stampalia) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish and over the concluding stages, the near side sulky wheel raced slightly inside several marker pegs. Driver fined \$200 under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(c).

HOWZAT DUKE – (Cameron Fitzpatrick) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

LASTPANGOINPARIS – (Terry Trewenack) driver reprimanded under the provisions of Rule 170(1) for dropping his right foot from the sulky rest in the run to the finish.

RACE 3: GANNON'S WA OAKS PRELUDE 2 (2130 MBL)

AMONGST ROYALTY – (Chris Lewis) when questioned on his reason for whilst racing at the lead of the one wide line, applying pressure to the leader racing in the front straight to receive the bell, driver explained that the filly had commenced to over race from the 1200m and in his opinion felt likely to choke down if he had continued to restrain. He therefore elected to apply pressure to the leader in an effort to gain the lead of the event, however, his attempt was unsuccessful, but he was then able to rate the filly back from the lead.

DUSTY ROSE – (Ryan Warwick) momentarily tightened, racing out of the back straight on the first occasion and raced roughly. Locked wheels racing into the front straight on the final occasion.

MAC A LOT – (Brad Stampalia) locked wheels racing into the front straight on the final occasion.

CHARLOTTE CHURCH – (Grant Williams) when questioned on the performance, the driver explained the filly had pulled up slightly big in condition. Under the circumstances he was granted special permission to enable the filly to trial at Byford on Sunday 13th May 2007.

CLINTS SISTER – (Aaron Skalecki) broke shortly after the start. As the filly had offended in a similar manner previously, it was excluded from the mobile barrier draw until such time as it had completed four satisfactory race or trial starts.

RICH BABE – (Mark Reed) checked shortly after the start.

RACE 4: SONY PS3 ENTERTAINMENT CONSOLE STAKES (2130 MBL)

TAIHAPE TICKLER – (Colin Brown) raced at the lead of the one wide line, before giving ground over the concluding stages.

FINEGANS WAKE – (Mark Reed) gave ground over the concluding stages.

IAM CLIVE – (Morgan Woodley) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

FLOYD BROMAC – (Andrew De Campo) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

RACE 5: SONY MP3 WALKMAN STAKES (2536 MBL)

BIRDCAGE – (Wesley Andrews) held up until obtaining a late inside run.

DEVASTATING – (Mark Reed) shifted out slightly under pressure in the run to the finish.

CHAZSALICO – (Terry Purnell) had a tendency to over race at various stages.

SNEAKYN ON OVER – (Chris Lewis) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

General

On return to the All Clear Steward, Aiden Warwick, the driver of the fifth placed SPIRIT OF NAVAJO requested a viewing of the official films prior to deciding whether to lodge a protest against the third placed BIRDCAGE (Wesley Andrews) gaining an unfair advantage by racing inside the line of the marker pegs over the concluding stages. After viewing the official films Mr Warwick elected not to proceed with the matter.

RACE 6: 2007 SONYCENTRAL CHAMPAGNE CLASSIC (2130 MBL)

SCHINZIG BULLER – (Ryan Bell) driver reprimanded for causing crossing under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(a) for having tightened another runner when shifting inwards in the back straight on the second occasion.

AUSSIE EYES – (Colin Reeves) tightened racing in the back straight on the second occasion. Raced greenly when giving ground in the back straight on the final occasion.

ARGENT TREASURE – (Chris Lewis) raced greenly in the back straight on the second occasion.

JACCKA LONDONRY – (Mark Reed) hung outwards after the start.

RACE 7: SONY NETWORK WALKMAN PACE (2503 SS)

LOMBO BUON NATALE – (Morgan Woodley) began badly and was placed on its last chance in the Standing Start draw.

MOMENT IN TIME – (Kim Prentice) began badly and was excluded from the draw in future Standing Starts.

WHIZ BANG OPERA – (Brad Stampalia) gave ground over the concluding stages.

PATCHES – (Vance Stampalia) pulled hard for the major part of the event.

TRICKY VIC – (Colin Brown) galloped out.

ALL IN TECK – (Grant Williams) galloped out.

MUSTANG FIGHTER (Mark Reed) began badly and was placed on its last chance in the draw. Gave ground over the concluding stages.

EARL OF LOCKSLEY – (Callan Suvaljko) raced roughly after the start.

RACE 8: SONY DVD HOME THEATRE STAKES (2130 MBL)

WENEEDA EARL – (Jon Gavin) raced at the lead of the one wide line before giving ground over the final 900m to finish a considerable distance from the remainder of the field. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Trainer/driver explained that in his opinion the horse had been unsuited by his efforts to take advantage of the good barrier draw and in future it was his intention to have it driven conservatively in the early stages. WENEEDA EARL will not be permitted to race for six days, and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

SCRAM JET – (Justin Prentice) had difficulty obtaining a clear run to the finish.

RACE 9: SONY VAIO NOTEBOOK COMPUTER PACE (2102 SS)

ROLL ON DISCO – (Kim Young) broke shortly after the start losing considerable ground, was excluded from the Standing Start draw.

WIZARD OF SCAR – (Ian Davie) began badly. As the gelding had offended in a similar manner previously it was excluded from the Standing Start draw until it had completed four satisfactory race or trial starts. Hampered behind tiring runners from the 600m to the 250m.

CASSIE ROX – (Kevin Keys) gave ground over the concluding stages.

BIG DOUG – (Mark Reed) gave ground over the concluding stages.

RACE 10: SONY ALPHA DIGITAL SLR CAMERA STAKES (1730 MBL)

SMOOTH VIEW – (Craig Saligari) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish
JUPITERS DARLING – (Justin Prentice) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish
BAYETE NKOSI – (Andrew De Campo) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish
SCENIC SAGA – (Brad Stampalia) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish
