Race 1: GANNON'S TROPHIES & PRESENTATION RUGS CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2102 SS)

NORTH SEA ADMIRAL – (Morgan Woodley) galloped briefly at the start. Was unable to improve its position from the 500m to the 200m when held up by a runner giving ground.
MYSTYS GIRL – (Mark Reed) after leading the event, was unable to maintain its position over the final 500m.
RENOUNCE – (Nigel Johns) raced roughly after the start.
WIMPLE DIMPLE – (Ryan Warwick) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw.

Race 2: PETER & VALERIE GANNON STAKES (2130 MBL)

BOBBY HANK – (Clinton Kimes) shifted out slightly under pressure in the run to the finish.
CLIONA LUCKY – (Richard Polak) had difficulty obtaining clear running to the finish.

Race 3: MORE 'F' IN FUN CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2102 SS)

STAR ALLIANCE – (Brad Stampalia) galloped out.
THEEYES TELLNOLIES – (Morgan Woodley) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw.
PERIPHERIQUE – (Michael Tenardi) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw. The gelding was retired from the event after breaking the loin hopple carrying strap. The gear was inspected and found to be of good quality.
ROYAL APPLAUSE – (Daniel Voak) after gaining the lead of the one wide line, failed to run on over the concluding stages.
MEMO – (Gary Hall Jnr) the gelding carried a flattened offside sulky tyre for the majority of the event.
LEACRAIG – (Michael Sangalli) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw.
THE DIE IS CAST – (Vance Stampalia) galloped briefly at the start.

Race 4: GANNON'S PACING COLOURS STAKES (2536 MBL)

MARTIN CASH – (Gary Hall Jnr) shifted outwards slightly under pressure in the run to the finish.
ARMBRO KEN – (Donald Harper) after racing at the lead of the one wide line, failed to run on over the concluding stages.

Race 5: GANNON'S ALL ABOUT HORSES HANDICAP (2503 SS)

DURANDAL – (David Young) galloped out.
WALLY WIZARD – (Brad Stampalia) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw.
MISTER BOCELLI – (Colin Brown) commenced slowly.
MONEY MASTER – (Mark Reed) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.
STANLEY MOORE – (Aldo Cortopassi) over raced for a short distance racing into the back straight on the final occasion.

Race 6: SMALES JEWELLERS INVITATIONAL LADIES RACE (2130 MBL)

COLORADO CODE – (Vanessa Perkins) the driver accidentally dropped her whip racing out of the front straight on the first occasion. Pulled hard for the major part of the event.

JESSICA CLARE – (Danielle Hill) hung inwards in the score up and was severely checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion when the pace in the one wide line eased.
DISCO FLYER – (Melissa Dawson) was held up until the late stages.
LADY DE BEAU – (Natalie Rasmussen) was inconvenienced when the pace in the one wide eased racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.
OSCAR LOMBO – (Chloe Tindale) was inconvenienced racing out of the back straight on the first occasion when the pace in the one wide line eased.

Race 7: 2006 GANNON'S WA OAKS (2536 MBL)

SPIRIT OF NAVAJO – (Ryan Warwick) hung inwards racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.
BACK IN THE BLACK – (Aaron Beckett) pulled hard in the middle stages and then was inconvenienced racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.
MON POPPY MIA – (Mark Reed) had a tendency to hang inwards for a major part of the event. After gaining the lead of the one wide line in the middle stages, gave ground quickly from the 400m.

Race 8: MENOPAUSE THE MUSICAL CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2503 SS)

SANA SANO – (Kim Prentice) was inconvenienced racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.
ULTIMATE SIN – (Morgan Woodley) galloped briefly at the start.
SHELLSTAR – (Aldo Cortopassi) was checked racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.
CLASS MASTER – (David Young) galloped out.
FREDDY RAMA – (Donald Harper) which began badly losing considerable ground, will remain excluded from the Standing Start draw.
AFTER THE RAIN – (Mark Reed) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw.
IONTHEBALL – (Gary Hall Jnr) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw.
DUFFLECOAT FLYER – (Colin Brown) was checked racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for DUFFLECOAT FLYER being checked racing out of the back straight on the final occasion. Tony Hynam (VILLAGE BONUS) pleaded guilty to a charge of causing interference issued under the provision of Rule 163(1)(a) and had his reinsperson's licence suspended for a period of twenty three days to take effect from midnight.

Race 9: LANCASTER PARK STAKES (2536 MBL)

General

Stewards delayed the All clear when Wesley Andrews (MON POPPIES) who had been placed fourth wished to view the replays of an incident racing out of the front straight on the first occasion. A subsequent objection lodged against the third placed J DS BEAU (Adam Nafranec) was dismissed.
J DS BEAU – (Adam Nafranec) the driver accidentally dropped his whip in running.
BRANDY STATION – (Clayton Elliott) was out of position at release point. The driver was reprimanded under the provisions of Rule 162(1)(h).

Race 10: GANNON FAMILY STAKES (2536 MBL)

NEXT TIGER – (Michael Tenardi) failed to run on over the concluding stages.
MATTY JACCKA – (Mark Reed) which broke in the score up was excluded from the mobile barrier draw. The driver was of the opinion that an earplug may have released prematurely based on the fact that he had noticed one earplug out in running, however Stewards were not satisfied that had been the case.

GENERAL

Stewards on Thursday 11th May 2006 concluded an inquiry adjourned from **Race 8 PETERS & BROWNES FILLIES AND MARES STAKES** at Gloucester Park on the 9th May 2006, into the reasons for ADDA INFLUENCE (Susan Roberts) being severely checked by being carried over the marker pegs into the safety lane losing its racing position.

After taking evidence from Susan Roberts and Brian Ferguson (SHES A CHRISTIAN), it was established ADDA INFLUENCE when being tightened racing out of the front straight and taken marginally inside the marker pegs was in the process of being corrected by its driver when its momentum carried ADDA INFLUENCE to the inside of the wheels of SHES A CHRISTIAN which had all but gained the position behind the leader.

After viewing the videos of the incident, considering the evidence of both drivers and the Stewards observations Stewards did not taken action against any driver on this occasion, however reminded both drivers of their obligations in similar circumstances.
