Stipendiary Stewards Report

Race 1: WILLIAM BARRETT & SONS BUNBURY STAKES (2143 MBL)

DILINGERS REIGN – (Chris Lewis) commenced slowly, checked racing into the front straight to receive the bell.

THE POWER WITHIN – (Les Coulson) pulled hard in the early and middle stages before choking down racing towards the front straight to receive the bell. Trainer Mr L Coulson was advised that the filly would not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completed a satisfactory trial. As blood had appeared at both nostrils the Stewards asked for an endoscopic examination to be carried out within 24 hours.

KINKI VILLAGE – (Errol Ashcroft) after racing at the lead of the one wide line, gave ground over the concluding stages.

OUT TO KILL – (Gary Hall Jnr) was checked racing into the front straight to receive the bell.

COSMIC DREAM – (Colin Brown) checked racing into the front straight to receive the bell.

SPIRIT OF NAVAJO – (Ryan Warwick) severely checked racing towards the front straight to receive the bell and then shied at the fallen runner in the run to the finish.

DEVASTATING – (Mark Reed) shied at the fallen runner racing in the front straight on the final occasion and then shifted inside the line of the marker pegs for a short distance.

General

THE POWER WITHIN choked down and fell in the outside section of the racing track surface in the front straight to receive the bell. Stewards activated the accident warning lights and hooters and the field was able to complete the race in safety

Race 2: WILLIAM BARRETT & SONS BUSSELTON STAKES (2143 MBL)

ARMBRO BRAVE – (Jason Woodworth) inconvenienced racing into the back straight on the final occasion.

MISTER MAYHEM – (Wayne Reid) hung inwards shortly after the start and was then unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

MON POPPIES – (Mark Reed) the pull-up blinkers failed to activate placing the driver at a considerable disadvantage and in his attempts to release the mechanism the mare shifted outwards in the back straight on the final occasion then hung inwards racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

SKIPPERS LEGACY – (Callan Suvaljko) which broke on two occasions in the final lap will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

DISCO ATOM – (Aldo Cortopassi) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

Race 3: WILLIAM BARRETT & SONS HARVEY PACE (2102 SS)

TYCHO BRAHE – (Justin Warwick) galloped out.

JESMOND ROAD – (Ryan Warwick) which broke after the start was placed on its last chance in the draw. Inconvenienced racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

LIQUOR LAD – (Clinton Hall) was checked at the start.

JONARK BOY – (Chris Lewis) galloped out then had a tendency to pull hard at various stages.

THE OLD CAMP – (Colin Brown) hung outwards and locked sulky wheels racing out of the back straight on the final occasion and checked shortly afterwards.

CRANKY JACK – (Callan Suvaljko) which began badly losing considerable ground, will remain excluded from the Standing Start draw.

KOTARE FLAME – (Gary Hall Jnr) obliged to race wider on the track racing in the front straight to receive the bell, locked sulky wheels racing out of the back straight on the final occasion and inconvenienced shortly afterwards.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for THE OLD CAMP (Colin Brown) being checked racing out of the back straight on the final occasion. It was established that IL CASINO (Kim Prentice) had eased wider on the track to improve its position at that point. THE OLD CAMP, which had been racing ungenerously was momentarily tightened, and raced roughly. Under the circumstances no action was taken.

Race 4: WILLIAM BARRETT & SONS BRIDGETOWN PACE (2503 SS)

BELLA LANE – (Natalie Duffy) when questioned on her reasons for not releasing the hopple shortening pins until racing towards the back straight on the final occasion, driver explained that the mare, in her opinion, had not been travelling comfortably for her to have released the pins prior to that point.

THE REAL DEAL – (Mark Reed) which began badly was excluded from the Standing Start draw.

SMART LOCH – (Chris Lewis) which began badly was placed on its last chance in the draw. Unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

ALBERTS GIRL – (Kate Kersley) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

TOP OF THE LINE – (Callan Suvaljko) was severely checked at the start.

General

Stewards delayed the All Clear to ascertain whether or not SMOOTH VIEW (Aaron Skalecki) had been afforded the opportunity of a fair start. After interviewing the driver, Starter and viewing the films on a number of occasions it was established that SMOOTH VIEW had reared prior to the start stepping out of both front hopple loops. SMOOTH VIEW was therefore declared a non-starter. SMOOTH VIEW was excluded from the Standing Start barrier draw.

Race 5: A OLD LIMO COMPANY STAKES (2143 MBL)

JAMES VICTOR – (Mark Reed) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

VOICE OF FREEDOM – (Colin Brown) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

BACKINA FALCON – (Terry Ferguson) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

SCOOTIN DELTA – (Justin Warwick) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

JAILBIRD – (Kim Prentice) underwent a veterinary examination on arrival on course when trainer advised that the gelding had coughed in the stable earlier in the day and was passed fit to start. Was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

Race 6: 2006 WILLIAM BARRETT & SONS FREMANTLE PACING CUP (2907 SS)

GLOBAL FORCE – (Fred Kersley) which began badly was excluded from the Standing Start draw.

MAHEER LORD – (Grant Williams) which broke shortly after the start was placed on its last chance in the draw.

OHOKA ACE – (Chris Lewis) galloped out.

FLASHING RED – (Joel Rees) was inconvenienced at the start

TRICKY VIC – (Mark Reed) was checked at the start.

NO BLUE MANNA – (Justin Warwick) was checked at the start.

Race 7: BROADWATER BEACH RESORT BUSSELTON STAKES (2548 MBL)

MR ACEMAN – (Darren Kerr) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

COOGEE BELLE – (Kate Kersley) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

NON COMMITAL – (Jon Gavin) shifted out slightly under pressure in the run to the finish.

FIRE THE GOLD BULLET – (Matthew Scott) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

Race 8: BARRETT FUNERALS.COM.AU STAKES (2143 MBL)

SWAPS – (Vance Stampalia) obtained an inside run to the finish.

OTTWAY – (Gary Hall Jnr) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

THE JOBS ON – (Ryan Bell) broke when racing in restricted room in the front straight to receive the bell. Under the circumstances no action was taken.

SERGEANT SANDS – (Stephen Miler) had difficulty obtaining clear running to the finish.

Race 9: J KEENAN & COMPANY COLLIE STAKES (1742 MBL)

SON OF CHARLOUS – (Harry Ashby) tightened and raced roughly racing towards the back straight on the first occasion, checked racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.

LOMBO BENEDETTO – (Ryan Warwick) which broke in the score up was excluded from the mobile barrier draw, hung inwards racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.

AMONGST ROYALTY – (Aldo Cortopassi) which broke racing towards the back straight on the first occasion will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial. Racing towards the front straight on the final occasion made contact with a sulky wheel and broke gait. Under the circumstances no action was taken.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for SON OF CHARLOUS being tightened and racing roughly racing towards the back straight on the first occasion. Driver Sam Torre (BARNETT ON LINE) pleaded guilty to a charge of Causing Crossing issued under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(a) and had his reinsperson's licence suspended for thirteen days to take effect from midnight 13th January 2006.

Stewards inquired into the reason for SON OF CHARLOUS being checked racing towards the front straight on the final occasion. It was established that CLASS AND AHALF (Errol Ashcroft) had been easing wider on the track to its inside at the same time as LOMBO BENEDETTO (Ryan Warwick) hung inwards from the three wide line placing SON OF CHARLOUS in restricted room. Under the circumstances no action was taken.

Race 10: SANDY GRAHAM TRIBUTE STAKES (2548 MBL)

THE AGITATOR – (Vance Stampalia) which began badly was excluded from the mobile barrier draw.

KATES MILLIONS – (John Filardo) momentarily tightened racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.

JACCKA FROST – (Jon Gavin) which withstood a sustained challenge for the lead in the early and middle stages gave ground over the concluding stages to finish some distance from the remainder of the field. A post race veterinary examination revealed nothing amiss. Driver Jon Gavin will be questioned regarding his driving tactics in the early and middle stages.

SUNSET SCOTT – (Richard Polak) after being taken forward in the early stages to lead the one wide line and issue a challenge for the lead, gave ground sharply from racing into the front straight to receive the bell before being retired from the event, leaving the back straight on the final occasion. Completed the event with the near side sulky tire deflated. A post race veterinary examination revealed nothing amiss. An inquiry into the driving tactics adopted in the early and middle stages was opened and adjourned, as driver did not attend the inquiry.

RIGHT AND LEFT – (Peter Tilbrook) had difficulty obtaining clear running to the finish.

THAT'S SPECIAL – (Jarrad Humphries) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.
