Race 1: GIMME YOGO HANDICAP (2503 MBL)

ONAVENTURE – (Callan Suvaljko) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

IAM CLIVE – (Ryan Bell) galloped out.

SMOOTH ADVANCE – (Matthew Scott) held up until obtaining a clear run passing the 100m.

Race 2: 2006 SKY CHANNEL WA DERBY – PRELUDE 3 (2143 MBL)

EASY FIT – (Wesley Andrews) commenced slowly, a warning was placed on its barrier manners. Performed poorly, was placed on its last chance to race competitively.

BILLS LEGACY – (Chris Lewis) which performed poorly, was placed on its last chance to race competitively. Trainer Debra Lewis advised the gelding would now be spelled.

LOUDSPEAKER – (Graeme Hammond) raced roughly racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.

JACCKA TANA – (Mark Reed) hung outwards shortly after the start and racing into the back straight on the final occasion.

KINKI VILLAGE – (Errol Ashcroft) gave ground over the concluding stages.

Race 3: BROWNES YOGHURT HANDICAP (2503 SS)

ULTIMATE CONSUMER – (David Young) was inconvenienced shortly after the start.

SURPRISE MAKER – (Brad Stampalia) galloped briefly at the start.

AMARYLLIS SPIRIT – (Morgan Woodley) galloped out.

JAYDEE BARTON – (Stephen Miller) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the Standing Start draw.

CASHMERE SMOOTH – (Chris Lewis) jumped sideways at the start.

THE LAST PADRON – (Callan Suvaljko) severely checked at the start.

SWAPS – (Vance Stampalia) which began badly, will remain excluded from the Standing Start draw. After gaining the lead of the one wide line in the middle stages, failed to run on.

Race 4: 2006 SKY CHANNEL WA DERBY – PRELUDE 4 (2143 MBL)

BANK VAULT – (Kim Young) was help up until near the 100m.

DEBT PROPELLED – (Vance Stampalia) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

TOUR KING – (Fred Kersley) raced roughly racing out of the back straight on the first occasion. Failed to run on over the concluding stages.

COLE YOUNGER – (Andrew De Campo) obtained an inside run to the finish.

PARKYS DILEMMA – (Robert Cassian) shifted outwards badly in the run to the finish. Trainer Mr Robert Cassian was advised to endeavour to correct the problem.

Race 5: BROWNES CHILL – LICENCED TO CHILL STAKES (1742 MBL)

MOTOR HOLMES – (Aaron Skalecki) which shifted up the track slightly in the run to the finish, locked wheels approaching the winning post.

OHOKA JAZ – (Kim Prentice) was held up and when attempting to make ground to the inside of MOTOR HOLMES in restricted room, locked wheels approaching the winning post.

General

After viewing the films of the run to the finish to determine whether or not he had been impeded for room over the concluding stages, driver Kim Prentice elected not to proceed with the matter, therefore All Clear was given.

Race 6: GET GOING GET FRESH GET BROWNES CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS SERIES HEAT 1 (2143 MBL)

JACCKA FROST – (Ryan Bell) gave ground and was retired from the event racing into the front straight to receive the bell. A post race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be suffering from atrial fibrillation. Trainer Mr J Gavin was advised the JACCKA FROST would not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completed a satisfactory trial.

CYCLONE ALBERT – (Mark Reed) which led, gave ground over the concluding stages.

ENDANGERED – (Justin Warwick) which began badly was excluded from the mobile barrier draw. When racing at the lead of the one wide line, pulled hard for a major part of the event.

MASTER BEAUDALE – (Kim Young) contacted a sulky wheel and broke racing towards the back straight on the final occasion.

HILLVIEW STORM – (Kade Howson) which broke racing out of the back straight on the first occasion will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

ALS REIGN – (Grant Williams) shifted inwards quickly racing out of the back straight on the final occasion when the removable deafeners were released.

PATMA DIDO – (Clinton Hall) was severely checked when carried back by JACCKA FROST racing out of the back straight to receive the bell. Contacted a marker peg when attempting to take a run in restricted room racing towards the back straight on the final occasion.

BERGERAC – (Gary Hall Jnr) was checked racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for MASTER BEAUDALE (Kim Young) and PATMA DIDO (Clinton Hall) breaking gait racing into the back straight on the final occasion. It was established that MASTER BEAUDALE had been following FIVEBYFIVE, which shifted up the track slightly at that stage. Clinton Hall then attempted to make ground to the inside of MASTER BEAUDALE where there was insufficient room to do so. As a result Kim Young was obliged to move outwards slightly from his line and made contact with the sulky wheel of AKAY FORTY SEVEN and broke gait. PATMA DIDO also broke gait in the incident. In noting the circumstances Stewards took no action other than to reprimand Clinton Hall for carelessness in attempting to take a run where there was insufficient room to do so.

Stewards inquired into the reason for BERGERAC (Gary Hall Jnr) being checked racing out of the back straight on the final occasion. Grant Williams (ALS REIGN) explained that the gelding had shifted inwards quickly when he had released the removable deafeners checking BERGERAC. He was severely reprimanded for failing to make sufficient effort to correct his drive when it was shifting ground.

Race 7: 2006 PETERS & BROWNES EASTER CUP (2907 SS)

WALTON FLYER – (Grant Williams) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw.

CRAB STICK – (Justin Warwick) galloped out.

STANLEY MOORE – (Aldo Cortopassi) raced roughly after the start.

PATCHES – (Gary Hall Jnr) which broke shortly after the start, was placed on its last chance in the draw.

Race 8: YOURS, MINE & OURS CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS SERIES – HEAT 2 (2143 MBL)

SHIPPS COLOURS – (Callan Suvaljko) gave ground over the concluding stages.

IRON CLAD LOMBO – (Gary Hall Jnr) gave ground over the concluding stages.

WEONA SHOWDOWN – (Grant Williams) gave ground over the concluding stages.

Race 9: PETERS TRUMPET – IT'S OUR FAVOURITE STAKES (2143 MBL)

HONAN – (Jarrod Humphries) was held up until obtaining a run passing the 100m.

WELL CONNECTED – (Brad Hallows) was checked racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.

LEVITYS RAINBOW – (Clinton Hall) was inconvenienced racing towards the front straight on the final occasion, with the near side sulky tyre being deflated shortly after.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for WELL CONNECTED (Brad Hallows) being checked racing towards the front straight on the final occasion. It was established that LEVITYS RAINBOW was racing in restricted room between KOBASHI MARU (John Jelf) and WAKE NED DEVINE (Kade Howson) and was momentarily inconvenienced and shifted inwards tightening WELL CONNECTED. Stewards took no action over the matter

other than to advise Clinton Hall that in similar circumstances he was to make a greater effort to maintain his line.

Race 10: CONNOISSEUR YOGHURT HANDICAP (2907 SS)

YORK STAR – (Ryan Bell) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw.

NOBLE CHEVALIER – (Andrew De Campo) which broke shortly after the start, was excluded from the Standing Start draw.

RUMOR HAZIT – (Gregory Schofield) which began badly, was excluded from the Standing Start draw. Commenced to over race in the front straight on the first occasion and was taken forward in the three wide line, however was unable to gain the lead of the one wide line and was restrained to the rear. Continued to over race from thereon.
