Race 1: WEEKEND COURIER COMMUNITY STAKES (1730 MBL)

NEXT TIGER – (Michael Tenardi) obtained an inside run approaching the finish.
NOBLE CHEVALIER – (Kody Charles) raced roughly as the start was effected. Placed on its last chance in the barrier draw.
PERFECT GOLD LOMBO – (Justin Prentice) which led throughout, shifted outwards in the home straight approaching the finish.
OUR SIR PAT – (Craig Saligari) held up, before gaining clear running inside the final 100m.

Race 2: COMMENT NEWS COMMUNITY STAKES (1730 MBL)

RUNAM LONG – (Kody Charles) had a tendency to over race in the early stage when racing at the lead of the one wide line, continued forward in the middle stages to race at the lead and then failed to run on over the concluding stages.

Race 3: WANNEROO TIMES COMMUNITY PATHWAY SERIES STAKES (2130 MBL)

JOHNNY VETERAN – (Grant Williams) broke gait free of interference racing off the back straight on the first occasion, will not be permitted to race for a period of six days and until the completion of one satisfactory trial.
FREDDY FEELGOOD – (Bob Mellsop) severely checked racing off the back straight on the first occasion.
FRANCO STRIKER – (Ryan Warwick) began badly from the mobile barrier, excluded from the barrier draw. Broke gait racing towards the home straight on the final occasion.
CHICO VERANO – (Colin Brown) checked racing off the back straight on the first occasion.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for FRANCO STRIKER (Ryan Warwick) breaking gait racing towards the home straight on the final occasion. After questioning driver's Ryan Warwick (FRANCO STRIKER) and Andrew De Campo (BAYETE NKOSI) no action was taken against any driver on this occasion when it was established that as BAYETE NKOSI shifted wider on the track to the inside of FRANCO STRIKER, Mr Warwick attempted to release the pull up blinds and in so doing FRANCO STRIKER moved inwards slightly and its near hind leg contacted the sulky wheel of BAYETE NKOSI causing that horse to break gait.

Race 4: SOUTHERN GAZETTE COMMUNITY STAKES (2536 MBL)

DEMORALIZER – (Adam Mellsop) pulled hard during the early stages when racing at the lead of the one wide line before gaining cover in the middle stages. Gave ground over the concluding stages. A veterinary examination following the race revealed no abnormalities. Driver questioned regarding his driving tactics and in particular when given an opportunity to gain the favoured one out one back position racing towards the front straight on the first occasion when ALBERT CHIEF worked forward three wide to its outside. Driver advised that it was his instruction to go forward and be mindful that the gelding needs to be urged forward as he is not a generous racehorse, however on this occasion, Mr Mellsop advised that due to the added fitting of block blinkers on this occasion caused the horse to over race and in so doing it took a little longer than expected before being able to allow ALBERT CHIEF to cross gaining the position behind him. Also trainer

queried over the performance of the gelding when finishing some distance to the rear. Trainer advised that he had been easier in the horse's work during the week leading up to tonight's performance and may have been short of condition. However considering all things, Stewards advised Mr Svlicich that the gelding would not be permitted to race for a period of six days and until the completion of one satisfactory trial.

ALBERT CHIEF – (Gary Hall Jnr) had a tendency to over race during the early stages before working forward to lead the field.

Race 5: CANNING TIMES COMMUNITY PACE (2102 SS)

OUR SAEFETY STAR – (Colin Brown) galloped away from the Standing Start.

TURKISH – (Callan Suvaljko) galloped away from the Standing Start.

LEFT A COOKIE – (Grant Williams) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

SILENT FIVE – (Joe Suvaljko) inconvenienced shortly after the start.

SMOOTH ADVANCE – (Chris Lewis) checked after the start.

OXFORD DEBATE – (Gary Hall Jnr) began badly from the Standing Start, will continue to be excluded from the barrier draw.

SHELLSTAR – (Stephen Reed) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

IAM CLIVE – (Morgan Woodley) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

VANLO YORKER – (Mark Reed) galloped away from the Standing Start, will continue to be excluded from the barrier draw. Held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

Race 6: 2007 COMMUNITY NEWSPAPERS WESTERN GATEWAY PACE (2536 MBL)

BARJOHBIL – (Ryan Warwick) hung inwards under pressure from the 500m. Underwent a veterinary examination following the race, which revealed no abnormalities. Driver questioned regarding the disappointing performance. Ryan Warwick explained when driven from a favourable trailing position and when asked to sprint at peak speed, the colt had a tendency to hang inwards despite his efforts and although the horse was travelling well within himself, was unable to improve his position at that time. Trainer Barry Warwick agreed with the explanation of Ryan Warwick and has advised that he has tried different gear in an effort to alleviate the problem, however on this occasion, Stewards were not satisfied with the performance and as a result the colt will not be permitted to race for a period of six days and must complete one satisfactory trial.

KAY WHY SLICK – (Gregory Schofield) which performed poorly to finish some distance at the rear. Will be placed on its last chance to race competitively. Further connections were advised the nomination would be refused in the metropolitan area till such times as the gelding's performances improve with country racing.

Race 7: MELVILLE TIMES COMMUNITY STAKES (1730 MBL)

MOMENT IN TIME – (Kim Prentice) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

MOTORING ME – (Gary Hall Jnr) failed to muster speed at the start, raced roughly at various stages. Pulled up sore. Trainer advised that the gelding had bowed the hear side tendon and will be retired, however Stewards will stand the gelding down pending a Veterinary Certificate of Soundness.

ITS NO FAKE – (Morgan Woodley) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

TAIHAPE TICKLER – (Justin Prentice) which raced three wide throughout, failed to run on over the concluding stages.

PERFECT ORDER – (Colin Brown) held up until gaining clear running inside the final 100m.

Race 8: MCINERNEY FORD FIESTA COMPETITION STAKES (2130 MBL)

SIGNLINE – (Gary Hall Jnr) checked in the back straight when WAINGARO WELLSTACKED gave ground abruptly.

SPORTSMANS IMAGE – (Martin Wilson) slow throughout the score up despite the driver's efforts. Gave ground to finish some distance at the rear. Trainer advised when questioned regarding the performance that he felt the horse wasn't his normal self this evening and could not explain the run. Stewards advised that the nomination of the gelding will be refused in the metropolitan area until such times as the performances improve with country racing.

BALI GIRL – (Stephen Reed) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

Race 9: FREMANTLE-COCKBURN GAZETTE COMMUNITY PACE (2503 SS)

IL POSTINO – (Andrew De Campo) galloped away from the Standing Start.

TUANAKI – (Colin Brown) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

JACCKA LAIRD – (Gary Hall Jnr) galloped away from the Standing Start, will continue to be excluded from the barrier draw.

I LIKE IT – (Chris Lewis) galloped away from the Standing Start, will continue to be excluded from the barrier draw.

REST HOLME – (Ryan Warwick) galloped away from the Standing Start.

AMARYLLIS SPIRIT – (Morgan Woodley) galloped away from the Standing Start.

TOTAL MOTIVATION – (Mark Reed) was slow to begin.
