Race 1: FHRC NEW MEMBERS STAKES (1730 MBL)

ARAGORN – (Kade Howson) hung inwards, contacted marker pegs at various stages. Driver reminded of his obligations.

STAR ALLIANCE – (Chris Lewis) which led the field over the middle and later stages, shifted outwards under pressure approaching the finish.

MANWARRA DREAMAKA – (Colin Brown) had a tendency to over race throughout. Gave ground over the concluding stages. When questioned on the performance trainer Jarrad Humphries was also disappointed with the performance and advised that the horse races best closest to the rubber uprights rather than working wide early, as it has a tendency to get onto its knees placing the gelding at a disadvantage. Further advised the Stewards that he will monitor the horse in the coming days and if anything arises will advise Stewards accordingly. A veterinary examination following the race revealed nothing amiss.

IACocca – (Ryan Warwick) severely checked racing into the back straight on the first occasion. As a result broke the head check and was retired from the event.

CANNON FORCE – (Callan Suvaljko) held up until gaining an inside run passing the 100m.

ULRICH – (Gary Hall Jnr) broke gait free of interference racing into the back straight on the first occasion. That gelding will not be permitted to race for six days and must complete one satisfactory trial.

Race 2: FHRC MEMBERS JACKPOT STAKES (2536 MBL)

CASUAL FLING – (Beau Tindale) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

MIRA – (Kody Charles) locked wheels for a short distance in the home straight approaching the finish.

MATT IN BLACK – (Nathan Turvey) hung inwards racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

FLOYD BROMAC – (Andrew De Campo) locked wheels for a short distance in the home straight approaching the finish.

NEXT TIGER – (Michael Tenardi) had a tendency to over race whilst in a trailing position.

Race 3: FHRC JOIN THE CLUB STAKES (2130 MBL)

SEELSTER CUT – (Nicolaas Van Der Snoek) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

MR ACEMAN – (Mark Reed) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

FORWARD POCKET – (Brad Stampalia) held up before gaining clear running in the closing stages.

BLACK AS KNIGHT – (Craig Goldfinch) gave ground over the concluding stages.

BREAKING WAVES – (Gary Hall Jnr) gave ground over the concluding stages.

JOIE DE VIVRE – (Kade Howson) underwent a veterinary examination upon arrival on course when it was reported that the gelding had suffered a stable mishap with a laceration to the near fore heel. Was further examined by the veterinary surgeon following its preliminary and was passed fit to start.

DIAMOND PAUL – Kim Young) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

General

This race commenced three minutes passed the advertised starting time when the Starter was obliged to turn the field away due to the offside rein of MR ACEMAN being caught under the shaft.

Stewards reprimanded Kade Howson (JOIE DE VIVRE) for jostling under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(a) when attempting to shift BREAKING WAVES wider on the track in the front straight to receive the bell.

Race 4: FHRC MEMBERS PACKAGE STAKES (1730 MBL)

FALCONOVA – (Mark Reed) which raced three wide throughout, gave ground over the concluding stages.
GIVONI – (Grant Williams) returned with the front centre carrying strap detached from the 500m placing that mare at a disadvantage.

Race 5: FHRC LIFE MEMBERS STAKES (1730 MBL)

AM I TOUGH – (Hayden Charles) raced roughly under pressure racing towards the front straight on the final occasion, then broke gait upon straightening. The gelding will not be permitted to race for a period of six days and must complete one satisfactory trial. Driver reprimanded under the provisions of Rule 162(1)www for allowing that gelding to shift outwards approaching the finish.

CULLENS COVER – (Callan Suvaljko) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

ROBBIE BRYDON – (Grant Williams) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

ALL RAPT UP – (James Schrader) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.
Inconvenienced in the closing stages.

ITS NO FAKE – (Ryan Warwick) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

Race 6: FHRC MEMBERS SPRINT (1730 MBL)

Nothing to report.

Race 7: FHRC MEMBERS TROPHY FUND PACE (2503 SS)

OK WINDERMERE – (Morgan Woodley) raced roughly shortly after the start.

SPORTSMANS ECHO – (Lindsay Baker) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

FREDDY RAMA – (David Young) began badly, will continue to be excluded from the Standing Start barrier draw. Gave ground over the concluding stages.

PADDY O'BRIEN – (Kade Howson) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

JAKE THE MUS – (Kim Prentice) began badly from the Standing Start, will continue to be excluded from the barrier draw. Held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

LENNON – (Gary Hall Jnr) driver questioned regarding his driving tactics in particular why he didn't make a forward move in the early or middle stages of the race. Particularly as the first quarter was run at a moderate speed. Gary Hall Jnr advised the Stewards that he considered as both OK WINDERMERE and JAKE THE MUS were racing ahead of him at that time, had he moved to a three wide position and worked forward, either of those runners would have gone ahead of him and left him in a three wide position throughout as both OK WINDERMERE and JAKE THE MUS appear to race best when leading the one wide line, particularly OK WINDERMERE who's best performances are when racing at the lead of the one wide line, and with the speed of the race thereafter being solid throughout, he felt it in his best interests to save for one late run which in the past has been suitable to the racing habits of LENNON. After considering the explanations of Gary Hall Jnr, Stewards took no action other than to note the comments and advised Gary Hall Jnr to drive LENNON in a consistent manner.

Race 8: FHRC COMMITTEE PACE (2102 SS)

TURKISH – (Callan Suvaljko) galloped briefly from the Standing Start.

BANK THE MONEY – (Edward Knight) jumped sideways at the start, commenced slowly from the Standing Start. A warning will be placed against its racing record.

MISSISSIPPI DELTA – (Kim Prentice) began badly from the Standing Start, will be excluded from the barrier draw, held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

GRUBBY SHANNON – (Justin Warwick) galloped briefly from the Standing Start. Held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

BALTHAZAR – (Jason Vella) began badly from the Standing Start, will be excluded from the barrier draw.

OXFORD DEBATE – (Chris Lewis) raced roughly after the start.

OUR SAFELY STAR – (Colin Brown) severely checked after the start.

SURPRISE MAKER – (Brad Stampalia) checked after the start.

CHELSEA VILLAGE – (Ryan Warwick) broke gait after the start, will continue to be excluded from the Standing Start barrier draw.

Race 9: FHRC MEMBERS OUTINGS STAKES (2536 MBL)

BIRDCAGE – (Mark Reed) raced roughly racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

HAND DONT COUNT – (Kevin Keys) had a tendency to over race whilst leading the field. Driver became unbalanced and dropped his foot out of the sulky rest upon straightening.
 LETS GET CRACKEN – (Shannon Suvaljko) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.
 ARTS REIGN – (Kody Charles) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

Race 10: FHRC COUNTRY MEMBERS TROTTERS STAKES (2130 MBL)

KEEPER OF DREAMS – (Beau Tindale) began badly, will be excluded from the mobile barrier draw, trailed the field thereafter.

OPULENCE – (Nigel Johns) shifted outwards under pressure approaching the finish. Driver reprimanded under the provisions of Rule 162(1)www for allowing that horse to shift out.

MACLADDIE – (Kim Young) inconvenienced in the home straight approaching the finish.
