### Stipendiary Stewards Report

#### **Race 1: SONY BRAVIA LCD FLAT SCREEN TELEVISION 2YO STAKES (2130 MBL)**

MY STRIKING JET – (Chris Lewis) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.  
JAY FACTOR – (Justin Prentice) hung inwards as the start was effected and when being corrected by its driver broke gait, will be excluded from the mobile barrier draw.  
KIWI ORANGE – (David Young) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

#### **Race 2: SONY GRAND WEGA LCD TELEVISION PACE (2503 SS)**

IAM CLIVE – (Morgan Woodley) began badly, will be placed on its last chance in the barrier draw.  
SHEZA STAR – (Aldo Cortopassi) underwent a veterinary examination prior to the race when the horse was found to be scratching in its action, however warmed out during the preliminary and was passed fit to run. Galloped briefly from the Standing Start.  
THE JOBS ON – (Gary Hall Jnr) broke gait after the start, will be excluded from the Standing Start barrier draw.  
CASHMERE SMOOTH – (Brad Stampalia) galloped briefly at the start then shortly after inconvenienced.  
SMOOTH ADVANCE – (Matthew Scott) which led the field throughout, shifted outwards under pressure approaching the finish.  
COOGEE BELLE – (Chris Lewis) held up before gaining an inside run in the closing stages.

#### **Race 3: SONY VAIO LAPTOP COMPUTER STAKES (2130 MBL)**

The Starter was obliged to turn the field away on the first occasion when the earplug released prematurely on TAIHAPE TICKLER, as a result this race commenced three passed the advertised starting time.  
GLOBAL FORCE – (Justin Prentice) driver questioned regarding his driving tactics. In particular when after restraining to the rear of the field why he did not consider commencing a three wide forward move once the field had settled. Mr Prentice advised that it was the instruction of trainer Bryan Cousins to drive the horse from a trailing position from its wide barrier this evening having considered that the horses drawn inside would have far greater speed, which would place him at a disadvantage if he were caught wider during the early stages. Once the field had settled and DE GALDEARNO (Ryan Bell) shifted to a three wide position and went forward felt there was no other option but to stay in a trailing position and wait for a final sprint. After considering the explanations, Stewards took the matter no further.

#### **Race 4: SONY NETWORK WALKMAN PACE (2503 SS)**

TAR SEELED – (Hayden Charles) began badly from the Standing Start, placed on its last chance in the barrier draw.  
AKAY FORTY SEVEN – (Morgan Woodley) driver reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.  
IAMALLCLASS – (Stephen Reed) delayed the start and then began badly, placed on its last chance in the barrier draw. Held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.  
RYLEE JO – (Clinton Kimes) held up and inconvenienced, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.  
FORWARD POCKET – (Brad Stampalia) galloped away, however no action was taken when it appeared that the gelding was in the process of passing a motion.

VIKING RULER – (Brian Ferguson) which commenced a three wide forward move from the 1200m, failed to run on over the concluding stages.  
VIEW TO A KILL – (Gary Hall Jnr) after commencing a three wide forward move from the 1200m, was forced wider over the final lap.

**Race 5: SONY CYBER-SHOT DIGITAL CAMERA JUNIOR DRIVER STAKES (1730 MBL)**

SCENIC SAGA – (Clinton Kimes) tightened and contacted marker pegs racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

DISCO FLYER – (Hayden Charles) tightened racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

NORTH SEA ADMIRAL – (Trent Wheeler) checked racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

BLACK MANA – (Aaron Skalecki) broke gait racing out of the front straight on the first occasion. No action was taken when it was established the gelding had shied from marker pegs which were previously contacted and became unbalanced.

**General**

Stewards inquired into the reasons for DISCO FLYER (Hayden Charles), NORTH SEA ADMIRAL (Trent Wheeler) being tightened and checked respectively racing out of the front straight. Morgan Woodley driver (CANNON FORCE) pleaded guilty to a charge of causing crossing under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(a) when attempting to take a position forward of those runners when not sufficiently clear. Morgan Woodley's licence was suspended for a period of nineteen days. Stewards in considering penalty, took into account Morgan Woodley's driving record and his guilty plea. That suspension will attach from midnight Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> July up to and including the 6<sup>th</sup> August 2006.

**Race 6: 2006 SONYCENTRAL GOLD BRACELET (1730 MBL)**

VANCELOT LADY – (Ryan Bell) gave ground over the concluding stages.

CRY OF THE POOR – (Colin Baker) gave ground over the concluding stages.

**Race 7: SONY PLASMA FLAT PANEL TELEVISION PACE (2503 SS)**

Braeside seel ster – (Gary Hall Jnr) began badly from the Standing Start, placed on its last chance in the barrier draw.

**Race 8: SONY MEMORY STICK STAKES (2536 MBL)**

BONSHAR – (Hayden Charles) gave ground over the concluding stages.

PRIVATE NUMBER – (Nicolaas Van Der Snoek) gave ground over the concluding stages.

MATTY JACCKA – (Mark Reed) broke gait free of interference approaching the finish. A veterinary examination following the race revealed nothing amiss. Connections were advised that the mare would be stood down for a period of six days and must complete one satisfactory trial.

WEONA SHOWDOWN – (Aaron Skalecki) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

**Race 9: SONY XPLOD CAR STEREO CLAIMING STAKES (2130 MBL)**

JUSTLIKEJOSH – (Rardi Barber) gave ground over the concluding stages. Underwent a veterinary examination following the race, which revealed nothing amiss.

WILL TO LIVE – (Colin Brown) which showed signs of soreness in the warm down lap, underwent a veterinary examination which revealed lameness to the near fore leg and will be stood down pending a Veterinary Certificate of Soundness.

**Race 10: SONY DVD HANDYCAM TROT (2503 SS)**

DASH OF LIGHT – (John Jelf) began badly from the Standing Start, placed on its last chance in the barrier draw, trailed the field throughout.

WISE BAY – (Colin Brown) checked after the start. Paced as a result, driver obliged to take the gelding off stride before regaining its correct gait. Placed on its last chance to race truly, trailed the field throughout.

NACOOKEE – (Aaron Skalecki) severely checked racing towards the back straight on the first occasion. Broke gait free of interference racing towards the home turn on the final occasion. Placed on its last chance to race truly.
