Race 1: KILLAWARRA DUSK CLAIMING STAKES (2548 MBL)

AMAZING OFFER – (Vance Stampalia) which began badly was excluded from the mobile barrier draw until it has completed four satisfactory starts in races or trials.

FRANCO NOVELLA – (Callan Suvaljko) broke approaching the finish. A post race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be sore in both fore legs. Trainer Mr A Kirke was advised that FRANCO NOVELLA would not be permitted to race or trial until such time as a Veterinary Certificate of Soundness was produced.

SOVEREIGN HEIR – (Chris Lewis) hung inwards in the score up and as a result was slightly out of position at release point.

JACCKA FROST – (Ryan Warwick) was checked shortly after the start.

General

ROYAL APPLAUSE, KING CAREY and IAM CLIVE were claimed.

Race 2: MORE 'F' IN FUN STAKES (1742 MBL)

NON COMMITAL – (Chris Lewis) which began badly was excluded from the mobile barrier draw.

EARL OF LOCKSLEY – (Callan Suvaljko) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

STANLEY MOORE – (Aldo Cortopassi) had a tendency to over race for the majority of the event.

JAILBIRD – (Kim Prentice) experienced difficulties in obtaining clear running to the finish.

Race 3: SEPPELT STAKES (2143 MBL)

CROUCH ON PREY – (Morgan Woodley) had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 80m. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

JOIE DE VIVRE – (Kade Howson) after leading the event failed to run on as anticipated over the concluding stages. Driver Kade Howson was at a loss to explain the performance and indicated that the gelding had been disappointing. A post race veterinary examination revealed nothing amiss. Trainer Mr G Hall Snr was of the opinion that the gelding may not have been suited by racing in three consecutive weeks. He was further of the opinion that tonight's field was a slight increase in class over the fields met previously and also felt that the gelding may have performed better had it been rated slightly quicker in the early stages. It was now his intention not to race the gelding for two weeks.

DION MORRIS – (Chris Lewis) raced roughly racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.

CALLING ELVIS – (Nicolaas Van Der Snoek) after being obliged to race wider on the track racing in the front straight to receive the bell, gave ground over the concluding stages.

GIFTED OPERATOR – (Jason Woodworth) had some difficulty obtaining clear running over the concluding stages.

Race 4: LINDEMANS CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2503 SS)

DREAM SOFTLY – (Callan Suvaljko) which stood flat-footed at the start losing ground, was placed on its last chance in the draw. After racing at the lead of the one wide line the gelding gave ground over the concluding stages.

SMOOTH ADVANCE – (Matthew Scott) the tail tie became detached in running.

ON THE BEACH – (Brad Stampalia) which began badly will remain RODS.
WALTON FLYER – (Ryan Warwick) raced roughly after the start.
MON SHEKHAN – (Colin Brown) was retired from the event after breaking the offside hind hopple loop and breaking gait racing out of the back straight to receive the bell. Under the circumstances no action was taken.
FINAL QUEST – (Kate Kersley) was checked racing out of the back straight to receive the bell. After racing wide over the concluding stages gave ground.

Race 5: PENFOLDS STAKES (2143 MBL)

IL CASINO – (Justin Prentice) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.
WESTICE – (Colin Brown) after leading for the majority of the event, gave ground over the concluding stages.
LEVITYS RAINBOW – (Clinton Hall) locked wheels briefly racing in the front straight on the first occasion.
MISTER BOCELLI – (Ryan Bell) which began badly, was excluded from the mobile barrier draw.
KENDALL CASTLE – (Michael Tenardi) had difficulty obtaining clear running over the concluding stages.
HONAN – (Jarrad Humphries) locked wheels briefly racing in the front straight on the first occasion.
AFTER THE RAIN – (Nicolaas Van Der Snoek) had difficulty obtaining clear running over the concluding stages.
AM I TOUGH – (Kade Howson) raced roughly racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.

Race 6: 2006 CADUCEUS CLUB CLASSIC (2143 MBL)

MY BOY ROY – (Grant Williams) broke in the latter stages of the score up at the first attempt obliging the Starter to call a false start. Driver Grant Williams was granted permission to remove the hood type blinkers for the gelding's second attempt however MY BOY ROY again broke in the latter stages of the score up obliging the Starter to call a false start. MY BOY ROY was withdrawn at 8.13pm. All monies wagered on MY BOY ROY were refunded, deductions from winning bets were made in accordance with RWWA Rule of Wagering 56. MY BOY ROY was excluded from the mobile barrier draw.
EL GUERROUJ – (Aldo Cortopassi) began badly, under the circumstances no action was taken.
BILLS LEGACY – (Chris Lewis) gave ground over the concluding stages after leading the event.
DILINGERS REIGN – (Kim Prentice) pulled hard in the early and middle stages and was inconvenienced racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.

General

Due to the delays in starting Race 6, Race 7 was rescheduled to start 11 minutes after the advertised start time and Race 8 was rescheduled to start 5 minutes after the advertised start time.

Race 7: LINDEMANS 4YO HORSES & GELDINGS SIRES CLASSIC (2143 MBL)

WHAT ANOTHER FELLA – (Craig Goldfinch) gave ground over the concluding stages.
THE LAST DIRECTION – (Ryan Bell) gave ground over the concluding stages.
CLASS BLASTER – (Errol Ashcroft) was obliged to race three wide racing in the front straight to receive the bell before giving ground over the final stages.

Race 8: DEVILS LAIR FIFTH LEG HANDICAP (2503 SS)

JACK FORCE – (Clinton Hall) began badly, driver was given the benefit of the doubt to whether or not he had been fully prepared for the start, under the circumstances no action was taken against the barrier manners of JACK FORCE.
OUR SAFELY STAR – (Colin Brown) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.
PAISLEYS MARCH – (Wayne Price) shied at marker pegs, which had been contacted by other runners and broke gait racing into the front straight to receive the bell. Under the circumstances no action was taken.
AMARYLLIS SPIRIT – (Morgan Woodley) was held up until obtaining a late inside run.
JUSTALITTLEFELLA – (Justin Warwick) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.
ONAVENTURE – (Callan Suvaljko) galloped out.

Race 9: ROSEMOUNT STAKES (2548 MBL)

RENOUNCE – (Nigel Johns) unable to obtain clear running to the finish.
COOL PUBLICAN – (Callan Suvaljko) severely checked racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.
THE REAL DEAL – (Aaron Skalecki) experienced difficulty obtaining clear running to the finish.
OHOKA JAZ – (Kim Prentice) unable to obtain clear running to the finish.
DIANALYN – (Aldo Cortopassi) inconvenienced racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.
LUCKY PUNCH – (Colin Brown) hung outwards racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.
ALL IN TECK – (Grant Williams) hung inwards slightly racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

Race 10: WYNSS MARES STAKES (2143 MBL)

The Starter was obliged to abort the first attempt at the score up due to a computer malfunction in the mobile barrier.

GEIGER COUNTER – (Bruce Hawkins) which broke in the latter stages of the score up missing the start by some distance was excluded from the mobile barrier draw.

ATOMIC DUSK – (Ryan Warwick) the driver momentarily dropped his left and then his right foot from the sulky rests racing into the front straight on the final occasion.

JESSICA CLARE – (Gary Hall Jnr) hung inwards after the start and was unable to obtain clear running to the finish. When questioned on his driving tactics in particular his reasons for moving from the one wide line to the marker pegs racing towards the front straight to receive the bell, driver explained that due to the moderate pace in the early stages of the event he was of the opinion that it would have been extremely difficult for JESSICA CLARE to have made ground wide on the track over the concluding stages. He therefore elected to move to the marker pegs in an effort to make ground on several runners before endeavouring to obtain clear running. It was also his opinion that had he commenced a three wide move with over a lap to travel he would have been obliged to race wider on the track as other runners shifted to his inside which would have been beyond the capabilities of the mare.

MILLION DOLLA GIRL – (Ryan Bell) hung inwards in the latter stages of the score up. The driver momentarily dropped his right foot from the sulky rest in the run to the finish.
