#### **RACE 1: TOYOTA PARTS MANAGERS TOTTERS STAKES (2130 MBL)**

Nothing to report.

#### **RACE 2: TOYOTA SERVICE MANAGERS HANDICAP (2503 SS)**

SNEAKYN ON OVER – (Gary Hall Jnr) swung sideways shortly after the start and whilst unbalanced and being urged forward, broke gait. Placed on its last chance in the draw. Connections advised that the gelding would be sent for an immediate spell. Unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

MYSTYS GIRL – (Beau Tindale) severely checked at the start.

WILLOWLEAF STAR – (Mark Reed) checked at the start.

ALBERTS FANTASY – (Chris Lewis) began badly and placed on its last chance in the Standing Start draw.

JAYDEE BARTON – (Stephen Reed) raced at the lead of the one wide line for the majority of the event, before failing to run on over the concluding stages.

ON THE AGENDA – (Clinton Hall) inconvenienced at the start.

SMOOTH ADVANCE – (Matthew Scott) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

#### **RACE 3: THE SLATE BOURBON STAKES (2130 MBL)**

BACKSEAT DREAMER – (Grant Williams) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

TIGERS BEST – (Colin Brown) inconvenienced in the front straight to receive the bell.

WALESA – (Clinton Hall) bled from one nostril in running. Will not be permitted to race until it completes a satisfactory trial. In addition will be required to undergo an endoscope examination immediately following the trial.

JACCKA TANA – (Mark Reed) inconvenienced in the front straight to receive the bell.

OUT TO KILL – (Gary Hall Jnr) inconvenienced in the front straight to receive the bell.

SIGNLINE – (Morgan Woodley) inconvenienced in the front straight to receive the bell.

COLONIAL BLAZE – (Vance Stampalia) broke gait racing towards the front straight on the final occasion. Completed the event with the off side knee boot down. Will not be permitted to race for six days and until the completion of one satisfactory trial.

BEEN IN TROUBLE – (Kade Howson) broke racing in the front straight to receive the bell. A post race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be sore in the near fore suspensory. Will not be permitted to race or trial until a veterinary certificate of soundness is produced.

MADISON CENTRAL – (Terry Ferguson) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

#### **RACE 4: TOYOTA WA DISTRIBUTOR MARES STAKES (1730 MBL)**

NITRO NINA – (Justin Prentice) held up until obtaining a late inside run.

PRECIOUS MAIDEN – (Ryan Warwick) began badly losing considerable ground, was excluded from the mobile barrier draw.

TWICE THE PLEASURE – (Nathan Turvey) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.  
THE POWER WITHIN – (Colin Brown) raced roughly shortly after the start.

**RACE 5: TOYOTA FINANCIAL SERVICES STAKES (2130 MBL)**

EARL OF LOCKSLEY – (Callan Suvaljko) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.  
GEE WHIZ FIZZ – (Ryan Warwick) driver questioned on his tactics in the early stages in particular his reasons for restraining to the rear from the start. Driver explained that the trainer had instructed him, that as the gelding was first up in this preparation, he was not to be involved in an early speed battle. He formed the impression in the latter stages of the score up that runners drawn to his inside intended to go forward, and therefore elected to restrain. As a position did not present itself in the field he restrained to the rear. Stewards will question trainer Steven Burton to clarify his instructions.  
PATCHES – (Vance Stampalia) had a tendency to pull hard at various stages.  
TRIAL BY JURY – (Chris Lewis) held up until obtaining a late inside run.  
ALL IN TECK – (Grant Williams) tightened racing into the back straight on the final occasion.  
JAILBIRD – (Kim Prentice) driver reminded of his obligation to ensure that he was clear of other runners when shifting position for having momentarily tightened another runner racing into the back straight on the final occasion.

**RACE 6: 2007 TOYOTA GENUINE PARTS, SERVICE & ACCESSORIES 3YO COLTS & GELDINGS STATE SIRES SERIES FINAL (2130 MBL)**

BARDEN TEE – (Gregory Schofield) carried back behind a tiring runner from the 600m to the 400m.  
SO NOT WALKIN – (Terry Ferguson) failed to run on over the concluding stages.  
NATIVE GARDEN – (Gary Hall Jnr) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.  
STAR OF DALVEY – (Ryan Warwick) began badly, as the gelding had offended in a similar manner previously, it was excluded from the mobile barrier draw until the completion of four satisfactory race or trial starts.  
MY POCKET ROCKET – (Sam Torre) underwent a pre race veterinary examination after trainer/driver Sam Torre expressed concern over the gelding's fore leg action, and was passed fit to start.

**RACE 7: 2007 GANNON'S WA OAKS (2536 MBL)**

DUSTY ROSE – (Kade Howson) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.  
TIFFANY CASE – (Gary Hall Jnr) broke gait racing out of the front straight on the first occasion. Will not be permitted to race for six days and until the completion of one satisfactory trial. Checked and raced roughly racing into the back straight on the first occasion.  
OUR JODI LEE – (Morgan Woodley) checked racing out of the front straight on the first occasion, failed to run on over the concluding stages.  
FIVE TIN LIDS – (Shannon Suvaljko) underwent a pre race veterinary examination after appearing sore in its preliminary, however, was passed fit to start. Failed to run on over the concluding stages.  
CHARLOTTE CHURCH – (Grant Williams) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

**RACE 8: GANNON'S PACING COLOURS CLAIMING STAKES (1730 MBL)**

AMARYLLIS SPIRIT – (Peter Tilbrook) commenced slowly.  
ONAVENTURE – (Callan Suvaljko) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.  
NATS NIFTY – (Ryan Warwick) claimed from this event.  
OXFORD DEBATE – (Gary Hall Jnr) claimed from this event.  
THE DIE IS CAST – (Vance Stampalia) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

**RACE 9: GANNON'S TROPHIES & PRESENTATION RUGS STAKES (2130 MBL)**

MASTER BEAUDALE – (Ryan Warwick) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.  
MAKA MILLION LOMBO – (Adam Nafranec) failed to run on over the concluding stages.  
BAYETE NKOSI – (Andrew De Campo) contacted a sulky and raced roughly racing towards the front straight on the final occasion. Unable to obtain a clear run to the finish and over the concluding stages shied and raced roughly making contact with a marker peg.  
MARLEDO – (Kim Prentice) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

**RACE 10: GANNON FAMILY HANDICAP (2503 SS)**

CHILLI DAWN – (Ryan Warwick) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

I LIKE IT –(Justin Prentice) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

PRIDE OF TARA – (Colin Brown) began badly and placed on its last chance in the Standing Start draw.

NO SHENANAGANS – (Peter Tilbrook) began badly and placed on its last chance in the Standing Start draw.

SOSA – (Matthew Scott) began badly and placed on its last chance in the Standing Start draw.

BROOKLYN ROAD – (Brian Kersley) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

FORDVIEW – (Jon Gavin) checked at the start.

COVENT GARDEN – (Shannon Suvaljko) began badly and will remain excluded from the Standing Start draw.

HOLLYWOOD STRIDE – (Callon Suvaljko) began badly and will remain excluded from the Standing Start draw.

**General**

Stewards tonight concluded an inquiry into a report from Racecourse Investigator Mr Geoff Johnson into an incident that occurred in the Birdcage area at Gloucester Park following the running of Race 7 on Friday 4th May 2007. It was established that following the running of the race, driver Grant Williams approached driver Callan Suvaljko, upset over his perception of Mr Suvaljko's tactics during the race. In the course of a heated verbal altercation Mr Williams inadvertently made contact with the face of Mr Suvaljko. On the evidence presented, Stewards were satisfied that the contact had not been intentional. Mr Williams pleaded guilty to a charge issued under the provisions of Rule 243, for behaving in a manner detrimental to the industry and was fined \$2,500. In assessing penalty Stewards took into account Mr Williams' guilty plea, the degree of remorse he had shown following the incident, his record and the forthright manner in which he presented his evidence.
