Race 1: BE ACTIVE 2YO STAKES (1730 MBL)

JACCKA LONDONDRY – (Garry Hall Jnr) which began badly, was excluded from the Mobile Barrier draw.
FIVE STAR JAKE – (Shane Young) was inconvenienced shortly after the start. Returned with the Buxton breastplate detached. The gear was inspected and found to be of good quality.
LOMBO ELECTRON – (Kade Howson) was checked shortly after the start. After failing to run on over the concluding stages, was placed on its last chance to race competitively.
LOMBO BROADBAND – (Beau Tindale) which began badly, losing considerable ground, was excluded from the Mobile Barrier draw.
FRORLINE – (G Devenny) the nearside lugging pole became detached racing out of the front straight after receiving the bell. Failed to run on over the concluding stages.
NO MEAN FEET – (Callan Suvaljko) was inconvenienced shortly after the start.

Race 2: TOYOTA GENUINE PARTS, SERVICE & ACCESSORIES HANDICAP (2503 SS)

MCCLEODS DAUGHTER – (Beau Tindale) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the Standing Start draw.
TUANAKI – (Colin Brown) was inconvenienced racing out of the back straight to receive the bell when the pace in the one wide line eased.
BEEP BEEP ZAP – (Chris Lewis) was inconvenienced racing out of the back straight to receive the bell when the pace in the one wide line eased.
YORK STAR – (Kade Howson) which began badly, will remain excluded from the Standing Start draw.
MY SMILIN ASSASSIN – (Mark Reed) gave ground from the 500m mark to finish some distance from the remainder of the field.
LOMBO APOLLO – (Des Stockman) commenced slowly.
VINTAGE CONCERTO – (Gary Hall Jnr) the gelding had a tendency to hang outwards, when being taken forward to the lead of the one wide line, racing in the back straight to receive the bell. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Driver advised that the stable intended having the gelding undergo a further veterinary examination and would report any findings.

Race 3: XXXX GOLD STAKES (1730 MBL)

CENTREMAN – (Gary Herbert) failed to run on over the concluding stages.
ULRICH – (Gary Hall Jnr) was checked racing into the back straight on the first occasion. When questioned on the performance, driver explained that the gelding had been unsuited by the circumstances of the race, as he was unable to commence a three wide move in the middle stages. His comments were noted. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.
YEEHAH COWBOY – (Mark Reed) failed to run on over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for ULRICH (Gary Hall Jnr) being checked and losing its position racing into the back straight on the first occasion. Gary Herbert (CENTREMAN) pleaded guilty to a charge of causing crossing, issued under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(a), for having shifted inwards when not clear of another runner and had his Reinsperson's licence suspended for twelve days. In assessing penalty, Stewards took into account Mr Herbert's guilty plea and his good driving record.

Race 4: CHANNEL NINE STAKES (2536 MBL)

TAIHAPE TICKLER – (Morgan Woodley) failed to run on over the concluding stages. When questioned on the performance, trainer explained that the gelding had not performed to expectations and as it was racing second-up this evening, it may not have been as forward in condition as he had anticipated.

THE DIE IS CAST – (Vance Stampalia) contacted several marker pegs in running. Driver was advised to make greater effort to keep his drive off the pegs. Failed to run on over the concluding stages.

LOOKSLIKELIGHTNING – (Mark Reed) when questioned on the performance, driver was of the opinion that the gelding had been disappointing and may not have been suited to racing over the same distance in consecutive weeks. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Trainer reported that he would have blood tests done on the gelding and would report any findings.

Race 5: 2007 W.A. TROTTERS CUP (2503 SS)

KEEPER OF DREAMS – (Beau Tindale) which broke at the winning post on the first occasion, losing considerable ground, was placed on its last chance to race competitively.

ROCKA BILLY – (Ryan Warwick) was checked at the winning post on the first occasion. Broke under pressure racing towards the front straight on the final occasion and was placed on its last chance to race competitively.

PAPARAZZO – (Terry Wegner) broke in the back straight on the first occasion and was placed on its last chance to race competitively.

EXUBERANT – (Brian Kersley) was checked racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.

PRIDE OF ALHAMBRA – (Colin Brown) which broke under pressure in the front straight in the run to the finish, was placed on its last chance to race competitively.

Race 6: THE WEST AUSTRALIAN NIGHTS OF THUNDER CONSOLATION (1730 MBL)

COLONIAL BLAZE – (Gary Hall Jnr) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

SOSA – (Matthew Scott) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

HER MAN MURRAY – (Kim Prentice) had difficulty obtaining a clear run to the finish.

ANOTHER NOTCH UP – (Aldo Cortopassi) raced three wide throughout.

Race 7: THE WEST AUSTRALIAN 2007 NIGHTS OF THUNDER FINAL (1730 MBL)

MIGHTY RIVER – (Justin Warwick) was held up in the early stages of the straight and then locked sulky wheels with another runner.

DEMORALIZER – (Chris Lewis) raced three wide throughout.

BULLION BILL – (Bob Mellsop) hung outwards under pressure in the run to the finish, locking sulky wheels with another runner.

Race 8: GANNON'S CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2102 SS)

RUMOR HAZIT – (Gregory Schofield) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

DALLAS FLIGHT – (Aiden Warwick) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the Standing Start draw.

AZERBAIJAN – (Nigel Johns) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

IDEAL LAVROS – (Ryan Warwick) galloped out.

ALBERT CHIEF – (Gary Hall Jnr) raced roughly racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.

Race 9: TOYOTA YARIS HANDICAP (2503 SS)

SILVERTAIL ICON – (Brian Ferguson) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

WIZARD OF SCAR – (Ian Davie) raced roughly at the start.

PATS DILEMMA – (Jason Vella) was inconvenienced behind a tiring runner in the back straight on the final occasion.

EAGLE EYE LOMBO – (Terry Ferguson) hung inwards racing out of the back straight and towards the front straight on the final occasion.

TROUBLESCENE – (Jarrad Humphries) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the Standing Start barrier draw. Checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for TROUBLESCENE (Jarrad Humphries) being checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion. Aiden Warwick (COBARGO WIND) pleaded guilty to a charge of causing crossing, issued under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(a), for having shifted inwards when not clear of another runner and had his Reinsperson's licence suspended for twelve days. Mr Warwick was given a seven-day stay of penalty to enable him to fulfil his driving engagements at Harvey on Friday 26th January 2007.

Race 10: BURSWOOD ENTERTAINMENT COMPLEX PATHWAY SERIES STAKES (2536 MBL)

WHAT LIES BENEATH – (Mark Reed) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

BIRDCAGE – (Michael Tenardi) raced three wide in the early and middle stages before being restrained to the rear. Performed poorly from there on before being retired from the event. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. The gelding will not be permitted to race for a period of six days and until the completion of one satisfactory trial.

PATRICK ARMAGH – (James Schrader) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.
