### **Stipendiary Stewards Report**

#### **Race 1: CADBURY DAIRY MILK 2YO STAKES (1730 MBL)**

JACCKA LONDONRY – (Kade Howson) hung outwards as the start was effected.  
ARGENT TREASURE – (Chris Lewis) momentarily inconvenienced as the start was effected.  
TORN TO SHREDS – (Aaron Beckett) raced three wide throughout, failed to run on over the concluding stages. A veterinary examination following the race revealed no abnormalities. Driver explained when questioned regarding his driving tactics in particular when racing in a three wide position, why he didn't consider restraining to the rear in the early stages. Aaron Beckett advised that as he felt that BUCKING BEAUTY (Colin Olsen) which was racing at the lead of the field would have handed up to MACRAIDER (Gary Hall Jnr) at that point, it would have availed him of the opportunity to race at the lead of the one wide line and when that didn't eventuate elected to rate outside in a three wide position. Consequently TORN TO SHREDS began to give ground from the 500m mark, because of the torrid run elected not to punish the horse over the concluding stages. Stewards noted the comments and took the matter no further.

#### **Race 2: OLD GOLD CLASSIC CLAIMING STAKES (2130 MBL)**

MAL MCGREGOR – (Martin Wilson) failed to muster speed at the start.  
MOTORING ALDEBARAN – (Mark Reed) held up, failed again clear running approaching the finish. Contacted a marker peg when attempting to take an inside run.  
SILENT FIVE – (Shannon Suvaljko) which raced at the lead of the one wide line, gave ground to finish some distance at the rear. A veterinary examination following the race revealed no abnormalities, Stewards advised when questioned regarding the disappointing performance, that he felt the quick lead time of the race and the continued fast speed throughout had a bearing on the horse's performance, it was his opinion that the horse is not suitable to be driven forward from wide barriers in mobile starts, and comparing to today's performance with last week's winning performance being a Standing Start when able to rate at the lead of the one wide line in a slower time enabling the gelding to run on satisfactorily contrary to the speed of today's event and further advised the Stewards that in future SILENT FIVE will be driven with a trailing position throughout to enable the gelding to run on best at the end of his races. Stewards noted the comments and took the matter no further.

#### **Race 3: SCHWEPPERVESCENCE STAKES (2130 MBL)**

This race commenced three minutes past the advertised starting time due to the late withdrawal of DIANALYN – (Ryan Warwick) on veterinary advise when the mare was found to be lame in the preliminary.  
LOMBO PROFILE – (Adam Mellsop) had a tendency to hang outwards throughout the score up, held up until gaining clear running inside the final 100m.  
VILLAGE HERO – (Justin Prentice) which led the field throughout, shifted outwards in the home straight approaching the finish.  
TWICE THE PLEASURE – (Nathan Turvey) held up for clear running before gaining late inside run.  
HOLLYWOOD STRIDE – (Callan Suvaljko) held up before gaining clear running in the closing stages.  
TOTAL MOTIVATION – (Lang Inwood) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish. Checked in the home straight to the finish.

CUNNINGHAME – (Kim Prentice) severely checked in the home straight racing towards the finish.  
NELSON STREET – (Gary Hall Jnr) shifted outwards under pressure approaching the finish.

All bets made on DIANALYN were refunded. Deductions from winning bets were made in accordance with RWWA Rule of Wagering 56.

**General**

Stewards inquired into the reasons for CUNNINGHAME (Kim Prentice) being severely checked racing towards the finish after taking evidence from Kim Prentice, driver of CUNNINGHAME, Callan Suvaljko (HOLLYWOOD STRIDE) and Grant Williams (BACKSEAT DREAMER) Callan Suvaljko driver of HOLLYWOOD STRIDE was given the benefit of the doubt as to whether he was solely responsible as NELSON STREET which had raced at the lead of the one wide line shifted outwards at that point carrying runners to his outside up the track. No action was taken in the circumstances.

**Race 4: GATORADE STAKES (2130 MBL)**

MOTOR HOLMES – (Aaron Skalecki) held up for a clear run until passing the 80m mark.  
KOBIAASHI MARU – (John Jelf) severely checked in the front straight to receive the bell.  
MORGANATOR – (Justin Prentice) severely checked in the front straight to receive the bell.  
FLOYD BROMAC – (Andrew De Campo) severely checked racing into the front straight to receive the bell. Driver reprimanded under the Provisions of Rule 162(1)(h) for failing to be in his position at the start.  
FRANCO AMON – (Gary Hall Jnr) severely checked racing in the front straight to receive the bell.

**General**

Stewards inquired into the reasons for FRANCO AMON (Gary Hall Jnr) being severely checked racing in the front straight to receive the bell along with a number of runners found Kody Charles, driver AM I TOUGH guilty of causing interference under the Provisions of Rule 163(1)(a) when attempting to regain his position in the one wide line when not sufficiently clear of the front legs of FRANCO AMON causing contact to the gelding Mr Charles' reinspersons licence was suspended for a period of twenty two days. In determining penalty Stewards took into account his good driving record the suspension will be deferred until the completion of his driving engagement Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> April.

**Race 5: 2007 MEMORIAL DAY STAKES (2130 MBL)**

BULLION BILL – (Bob Mellsop) underwent a veterinary examination following the race when the gelding failed to run on after travelling in a favourable position throughout. That examination did not reveal any abnormalities. However, trainer Bob Mellsop advised that the horse although had been a little disappointing may have come to the end of its preparation and will discuss the future programme with the connections. However, should anything arise in the coming days in relation to tonight's performance will inform the Stewards.

**Race 6: 10<sup>TH</sup> LIGHT HORSE MEMORIAL TROOP STAKES (2130 MBL)**

CHICO VERANO – (Chris Lewis) held up, failed again clear running approaching the finish.  
PERIPHERIQUE – (Craig Saligari) held up, failed again clear running approaching the finish.  
BAYETE NKOSI – (Andrew De Campo) held up, failed again clear running approaching the finish.  
RACKANOVER – (Ryan Warwick) broke gait shortly after the start, will be excluded from the mobile barrier draw.  
ARMBRO INGERSOLL – (Donald Harper) raced roughly racing towards the home straight on the final occasion.

**Race 7: 2007 CADBURY RACE FOR ROSES (2503 SS)**

SATINKA – (Morgan Woodley) began badly from the Standing Start and will be excluded from the barrier draw and failed to run on over the concluding stages.  
JESSICA JASPER – (Justin Prentice) began badly from the Standing Start, placed on its last chance in the barrier draw.  
MOMENT IN TIME – (Kim Prentice) began badly, placed on its last chance in the barrier draw.

**Race 8: SCHWEPES TONIC STAKES (2130 MBL)**

BREAK SOME HEARTS – (Nicolaas Van Der Snoek) severely checked racing off the back straight to receive the bell.  
RYLEE JO – (Vance Stampalia) obtained an inside run approaching the finish.  
AVEROSS JOY – (Craig Murphy) checked racing off the back straight to receive the bell.  
PALE ROSE – (Martin Wilson) checked racing off the back straight to receive the bell.

### **General**

Stewards inquired into the reasons for AVEROSS JOY (Craig Murphy) being checked along with a number of runners Lang Inwood, driver of MOTORING VICOLO pleaded guilty to a charge of causing crossing under the Provisions of Rule 163(1)(a) and his reinspersons licence was suspended for a period of fifteen days. When determining penalty Stewards took into consideration Mr Inwood's good driving record and his guilty plea. The suspension was deferred four days to allow Mr Inwood to fulfil his driving engagements on Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> April.

### **Race 9: PEPSI HANDICAP (2503 SS)**

DOCTEL RAGER – (David Young) began badly from the Standing Start and will be excluded from the barrier draw.

SMOOTH ADVANCE – (Beau Tindale) gave ground to finish some distance at the rear, underwent a veterinary examination following the race. Driver explained the horse was asked to work hard in the early stages in an effort to make a position, which had an effect on the overall performance. Connections are advised that the gelding would be placed on its last chance to race competitively.

### **Race 10: RED BULL JUNIOR DRIVER STAKES (1730 MBL)**
