Stipendiary Stewards Report

Race 1: TENDER RIDGE MARES STAKES (1730 MBL)

SPORTSMANS LADY – (Martin Wilson) which finished a considerable distance from the remainder of the field, was placed on its last chance to race competitively.

DIANALYN – (Aldo Cortopassi) hung inwards shortly after the start and then was momentarily inconvenienced racing out of the front straight on the first occasion before giving ground over the final stages.

ELECTRACITED – (Justin Warwick) when questioned on his driving tactics, in particular his reason for when racing at the lead of the one wide line, applying pressure to the leader, driver explained that after unsuccessfully attempting to lead the event, the mare commenced to race keenly and under the circumstances he felt his best option was to attempt to rate rather than restrain it.

Race 2: MORE 'F' IN FUN CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS SERIES HEAT 3 (1730MBL)

CLASSIC JOSH – (Grant Williams) after racing at the lead of the one wide line, commenced to give ground racing out of the back straight on the final occasion with the near side sulky tyre being contacted and flattened shortly thereafter.

MATTY JACCKA – (Justin Warwick) raced three wide throughout.

Race 3: 10TH LIGHT HORSE MEMORIAL TROOP STAKES (1730 MBL)

PERFECT ORDER – (Colin Brown) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

THE FINAL WORD – (Callan Suvaljko) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

Race 4: TOYOTA GENUINE PARTS, SERVICE & ACCESSORIES CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS SERIES HEAT 4 (1730 MBL)

VANDERARDEN – (Ryan Bell) after gaining the lead of the one wide line, failed to run over the concluding stages.

IRON GLOVES – (Vance Stampalia) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

Race 5: 2006 SKY CHANNEL WA DERBY CONSOLATION (2536 MBL)

MARLEDO – (Colin Brown) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

COLE YOUNGER – (Andrew De Campo) had a tendency to race erratically at various stages.

LOUDSPEAKER – (Graeme Hammond) had a tendency to over race whilst leading.

TOO MUCH POWER – (Ron Young) was momentarily inconvenienced racing out of the back straight to receive the bell.

Race 6: 2006 MEMORIAL DAY STAKES (2130 MBL)

AM I TOUGH – (Hayden Charles) which began badly, was excluded from the mobile barrier draw.

Race 7: 2006 SKY CHANNEL WA DERBY (2536 MBL)

DEVASTATING – (Chris Lewis) obtained an inside run to the finish.

MR YANKEE – (Kade Howson) hung outwards shortly after the start and shifted up the track slightly under pressure in the run to the finish.

PARKYS DILEMMA – (Robert Cassian) was checked at the start and then shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

SPORTS ADDA – (Jarrad Humphries) hung inwards shortly after the start.

NOMORE FORUSIR – (Colin Brown) had difficulty obtaining clear running over the concluding stages.

PERFECT SPRING – (Sam Torre) was inconvenienced racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for PERFECT SPRING (Sam Torre) being inconvenienced racing out of the front straight on the first occasion. Grant Williams (MY BOY ROY) was reprimanded for causing crossing (Rule 163(1)(a)).

Race 8: PETERS & BROWNES HANDICAP (2503 SS)

LIQUOR LAD – (Clinton Hall) raced roughly after the start.

YORK STAR – (Ryan Bell) which began badly, was excluded from the Standing Start draw. Locked wheels racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

NEXT TIGER – (Michael Tenardi) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw. When questioned on his driving tactics, in particular his reason for commencing a three wide move racing into the back straight on the first occasion, driver explained that he had intended to race forward to gain the lead of the one wide line, however he had mistaken the runner racing in that position. When he realised that the runner was unlikely to relinquish the lead of the one wide line he attempted to rate in the three wide line as his gelding would not have appreciated being restrained to the rear. Stewards were of the opinion that he had erred in his tactics, however given his relative inexperience, took no action over the matter. He was advised that he was expected to show greater judgement otherwise a repetition of such tactics may result in action being taken.

CHILLI DAWN – (Gary Hall Jnr) galloped out.

MR ACEMAN – (Mark Reed) was checked shortly after the start.

ONAVENTURE – (Callan Suvaljko) galloped briefly at the start.

MONEY MASTER – (Wesley Andrews) was severely checked racing out of the front straight on the first occasion when locking wheels with another runner.

Race 9: COLLEX STAKES (1730MBL)

WENEEDA EARL – (Gary Hall Jnr) was unable to obtain clear running until the late stages and was reluctant to make ground in restricted room racing roughly approaching the winning post.

EASY ON THE POCKET – (Chris Lewis) was severely checked racing into the front straight on the final occasion.

WAKE NED DEVINE – (Kade Howson) raced roughly shortly after the start.

SWAPS – (Vance Stampalia) had difficulty obtaining clear running.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for EASY ON THE POCKET (Chris Lewis) being severely checked racing into the front straight on the final occasion. Matthew Scott (SMOOTH ADVANCE) pleaded guilty to a charge of causing interference issued under the provision of Rule 163(1)(a) and had his reinsperson's licence suspended for twenty four days to take effect following his driving engagements on Monday 24th April 2006.

Race 10: PERTH PLASTERBOARD CLAIMING STAKES (2130 MBL)

SUNSET SCOTT – (Morgan Woodley) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

HOOTER – (Bruce Stanley) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

JUSTALITTLEFELLA – (Colin Brown) was checked racing in the back straight on the completion of a lap.

PACIFIC ATOLL – (Justin Warwick) was claimed.

EASY MONEY – (Chris Lewis) was claimed.

WALTON FLYER – (Grant Williams) was checked racing in the back straight on completion of a lap.

ROBUST KARL – (Aaron Skalecki) was checked and broke gait racing in the back straight on completion of a lap when the pace eased.

General

Steward inquired into the circumstances of JUSTALITTLEFELLA (Colin Brown) regaining a position in the field after racing inside the line of the marker pegs racing in the back straight on completion of a lap. It was established that the horse had been taken inside the line of the marker pegs to avoid the galloping ROBUST KARL. Prior to returning to the track proper, ROBUST KARL regained its gait placing him at a disadvantage, therefore Aaron Skalecki eased to allow JUSTALITTLEFELLA to re-enter the field.
