RACE 1: BE ACTIVE 2YO STAKES (2130 MBL)

General

After viewing the official film of an incident in the front straight to the finish Andrew De Campo driver of the fourth placed NOWUSEEME, protested against Kevin Keys, driver of the second placed SECRET INTERLUDE, alleging interference in the run to the finish. After taking evidence from both drivers, viewing the official videos and acting on their own observations, Stewards dismissed the protest and gave All Clear on the judges' numbers.

PRISCILLA ROCKS - (Chris Lewis) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

SECRET INTERLUDE – (Kevin Keys) held up until obtaining a run inside the 100m.

NOWUSEEME - (Andrew De Campo) contacted a sulky, and raced roughly inside the 100m.

SPECIAL DIVA – (Morgan Woodley) checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.

Genera

Stewards inquired into the reason for SPECIAL DIVA (Morgan Woodley) being checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion. It was established that SECRET INTERLUDE (Kevin Keys) had eased towards the marker pegs to obtain a trailing position, however, SPECIAL DIVA had worked to its inside momentarily and over reacted when being eased. In the circumstances, no action was taken.

Stewards inquired into the reason for NOWUSEEME (Andrew De Campo) racing roughly racing in the front straight on the final occasion. It was established that SECRET INTERLUDE (Kevin Keys) initially followed PRISCILLA ROCKS (Chris Lewis) up the track when that filly shifted out under pressure and continued to shift wider on the track having gained an advantage on NOWUSEEME racing to its outside. However, Mr De Campo resisted that shift. In consequence NOWUSEEME contacted the sulky of SECRET INTERLUDE and raced roughly for a short distance. Stewards took no action over the matter; however, Mr De Campo was reminded that he should not attempt to retain a position when unable to do so.

RACE 2: VEOLIA WASTE MANAGEMENT CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2102 SS)

LEADING STAR – (Morgan Woodley) held up, until obtaining a late inside run.

JASPER COUNTY – (Kade Howson) began badly, placed on its last chance in the draw. Unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

JILLIBY CRUISING – (Jamie Rigoli) dwelt momentarily at the start.

HYPOTHERMIA – (Mark Reed) galloped out. Unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

SHINING KEY – (Gary Hall Jnr) raced roughly after the start. Shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

FLYBOYS FUN – (Martin Wilson) commenced slowly.

VEOLIA INDUSTRIAL WASTE SOLUTIONS STAKES (1730 MBL)

BLACKANSWEET - (Shannon Suvaliko) held up until passing the 100m

RACE 4: **VEOLIA RESOURCE RECOVERY 3YO STAKES (2130 MBL)**

JACK CANTELL – (Nathan Turvey) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

WALKAWAY LOADED - (Kade Howson) severely checked shortly after the start.

CAPTAIN BLUFF - (Andrew De Campo) hung inwards after the start, despite the driver's efforts. A warning was issued. Driver cautioned for dropping his right leg from the sulky rest for a short distance in the run to the

HALF A MILL – (Brad Stampalia) after racing wide in the early stages to gain the lead of the one wide line. failed to run on over the concluding stages. Driver explained that he had been instructed to obtain a forward position in the early stages. However, the effort told on the gelding, which will now be sent for a short let up.

CHOOKS REWARD - (Colin Brown) locked wheels racing out of the back straight to receive the bell. Severely checked at the apex of the turn racing out of the front straight on the final occasion.

BARJOHBIL - (Aiden Warwick) hung inwards racing out of the back straight to receive the bell, locking sulky wheels with another runner for a short distance. Hung inwards despite the driver's efforts at the apex of the turn racing out of the front straight on the final occasion. A warning was issued.

CASSIE ROX – (Kevin Keys) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

ADDA DOUBLE DIP - (Susan Roberts) had a tendency to over race when racing at the lead of the one wide line in the middle stages.

VEOLIA – A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE STAKES (2130 MBL)

ALKIRA JET - (Stephen Reed) shifted up the track under pressure in the run to the finish. Driver reprimanded for carelessness [Rule 168(1)] for having made insufficient effort to straighten the mare.

PRIDE OF TARA – (Kade Howson) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

TIRANO PALEFACE - (Colin Brown) driver dropped his whip passing the 50m.

VEOLIA INDUSTRIAL CLEANING SERVICES STAKES (2536 MBL)

LONGSHOREMAN - (Mark Reed) led for the majority of the event. Failed to run on over the concluding

GLEES JASPER - (Chris Lewis) driver reported that the gelding was hampered throughout, by striking the sulky wheels.

DEMORALIZER – (Beau Tindale) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

BACKSEAT DREAMER - (Shannon Suvaliko) out of position at release point. Driver reprimanded for failing to come up into position, [Rule 162(1)(h)].

ATOMIC SEELSTER - (Morgan Woodley) out of position at release point. Driver reprimanded for failing to maintain his position [Rule 162(1)(j)].

2007 VEOLIA ENVIORNMENTS SERVICES PEARLE CLASSIC FINAL (2130 MBL)

The Starter was obliged to turn the field away at the first attempt at a score up when the nearside hopple shortening pin on ARGENT TREASURE (Chris Lewis) released prematurely. The field was then held to avoid an interstate clash, in consequence the race started six minutes after the advertised start time.

APPLADAY - (Callan Suvaliko) over raced whilst leading.

NOT BAD JOHNNIE - (Shannon Suvaljko) broke under pressure in the run to the finish. Will not be permitted to race for six days, and until the completion of one satisfactory trial.

ARGENT TREASURE (Chris Lewis) inconvenienced racing in the front straight on the first occasion.

Checked racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

ON ALL FOURS – (Colin Brown) checked racing in the front straight on the final occasion.

TRUNKEY DAYDREAM – (Greg Graham) driver questioned on his reasons for remaining at the rear of the one wide line in the early stages rather than commence a forward move in moderate time. He explained that in anticipation of the speed being reasonable throughout his instructions had been to save the gelding for the final 600m of the event. Stewards noted his comment, however, advised him that far greater judgment was expected in similar circumstances. Driver was also reminded of his obligation for having dropped his foot from the sulky rest in the final lap.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for ARGENT TREASURE (Chris Lewis) being checked racing out of the back straight on the final occasion. Morgan Woodley (CONRAD BLACK) was found guilty to a charge of causing interference issued under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(a) for shifting out when not sufficiently clear of ARGENT TREASURE making contact with that gelding's fore legs causing it to break gait for a short distance. His reinspersons's' licence was suspended for a period of sixteen days to take effect following his driving engagements on Tuesday 26 June 2007. In assessing penalty Stewards took into account his good driving record.

VEOLIA LIQUID WASTE COLLECTION DISCRETIONARY HANDICAP (2503 SS) RACE 8:

LEACRAIG - (Michael Sangalli) galloped out.

IAM CLIVE – (Morgan Woodley) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

SHELLSTAR – (Stephen Reed) galloped out. Unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

ITS NO FAKE – (Brad Stampalia) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

VEOLIA RECYCLING SOLUTIONS PATHWAY SERIES STAKES (2130 MBL) RACE 9:

Stewards delayed the All Clear to examine the circumstances of the start. It was established that the mobile barrier had been unable to draw away from the field due to the track conditions caused by the adverse weather. Stewards were satisfied that ROSEWORTHY LAD (Gary Hall Jnr) had been denied the opportunity of a fair start, by being hampered by the mobile barrier and declared the gelding a non starter.

All bets made on ROSEWORTHY LAD were refunded and deductions from winning bets were made in accordance with RWWA Rule of Wagering 56.

FIND THIRTY CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2503 SS)

SMOOTH ADVANCE - (Matthew Scott) held up until obtaining an inside run approaching the 100m. MYSTYS GIRL - (Beau Tindale) the hopple shortening pins failed to release placing the mare at a disadvantage throughout.

WILLOWLEAF STAR - (Mark Reed) began badly, placed on its last chance in the draw.

ARABARAMA – (Colin Brown) held up until inside the 100m.

BLACK LINE – (Vance Stampalia) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

FINEGANS WAKE - (Stephen Reed) the nearside lugging pole became detached in running. Failed to run on over the concluding stages.

VANLO YORKER - (Craig Saligari) broke, racing out of the back straight on the first occasion. Will not be permitted to race for six days, and until the completion of one satisfactory trial.
