Stipendiary Stewards Report

Race 1: BURSWOOD PARK PUBLIC GOLF COURSE STAKES (2130 MBL)

SMARTIES ARTY – (Beau Tindale) obtained an inside run approaching the finish.

THE JACKMAN – (Colin Brown) was forced wider from the 900m.

WALLY WIZARD – (Ryan Bell) broke the off hind hopple loop and was retired from the event in the front straight on the first occasion. No action was taken when the gear was found to be of sound quality.

PRIVATE NUMBER – (Gary Hall Jnr) which led the field throughout, shifted outwards in the home straight approaching the finish.

THE LAST PADRON – (Craig Goldfinch) was retired from the event at the 1000m mark. A veterinary examination following the race revealed atrial fibrillation. Connections were advised that the horse would be stood down for a period of six days and must complete one satisfactory trial.

MAGIC LOCH – (Morgan Woodley) post race specimens were taken, trainer Peter Gravolin.

General

This race commenced two minutes passed the advertised starting time when MAGIC LOCH underwent a veterinary examination prior to the race which revealed a slight laceration, however was passed fit to run.

Race 2: BURSWOOD PARK GOLF DRIVING RANGE MARES STAKES (2130 MBL)

UMA TADA – (Adam Mellso) shifted outwards in the home straight approaching the finish. Driver fined \$200 under the provisions of rule 168(1) for being careless.

CEE GEORGINA – (Ryan Bell) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

General

Stewards questioned Chris Lewis driver of (LADY DE BEAU) in regard to his driving tactics, in particular after commencing a three wide forward move from the 1100, why he didn't continue that forward move at that time. Mr Lewis explained it was his instruction to gain a trailing position, he did consider once the speed of the race steadied going forward earlier than the 1100m, however when MON POPPIES (Colin Brown) shifted and went forward earlier left him with no option but to rate back and hope for a trailing position later. However when commencing his three wide forward move at the 1100m was mindful of horses ahead of him taking him wider at that point which would have been to his disadvantage. After considering the explanations, Stewards noted the comments.

Also Stewards questioned Justin Prentice drive of (MOMENT IN TIME) in regard to his driving tactics and in particular whilst racing towards the rear in the one wide line, did he consider moving to a three wide line prior to being covered by LADY DE BEAU (Chris Lewis). Justin Prentice advised the Stewards that the previous performances of MOMENT IN TIME was such that it was best saved for a late run, although he did consider at this time to go earlier, decided to wait and take the back of LADY DE BEAU when that mare began a forward move from the 1100m, as was evidenced. However due to the slow speed of the race in the early part, was unable to made ground over the concluding stages. Stewards noted the comments.

Race 3: BE ACTIVE STAKES (2130 MBL)

Justin Warwick of the fourth placed (GRUBBY SHANNON) lodged a protest against the second placed ALL RAPT UP (James Schrader) alleging interference at the 250m mark. However after giving some evidence

and viewing those films on a number of occasions, requested to withdrawal his protest, therefore Stewards declared all Clear on the Judges numbers.

GRUBBY SHANNON – (Justin Warwick) held up, contacted sulky raced roughly, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish. Driver reminded of his obligations when attempting to take a position when insufficient room.

BANK THE MONEY – (Edward Knight) which made a three wide forward move in the middle stages to race at the lead of the one wide line, failed to run on over the concluding stages.

Race 4: BURSWOOD PARK GOLF PRO SHOP CLAIMING STAKES (1730 MBL)

DIGGER OF FORTUNE – (Hayden Charles) broke under pressure approaching the finish, will not be permitted to race for six days and must complete one satisfactory trial.

TIGERS BEST – (Callan Suvaljko) momentarily tightened racing out of the front straight on the first occasion

FRANCO NOVELLA – (Shannon Suvaljko) hung inwards momentarily racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

NEXT BELLE – (Ryan Warwick) held up and inconvenienced approaching the finish when attempting to take an inside run.

STANLEY MOORE – (Colin Brown) after racing three wide during the early and middle stages before racing at the lead of the one wide line, failed to run on over the concluding stages.

General

FRANCO NOVELLA and MASSARUA were claimed following the event.

Stewards delayed the All Clear when Ryan Warwick driver of second placed (NEXT BELLE) wished to view the official video films of the finish. After viewing those films on a number of occasions, did not wish to proceed. Stewards declared All Clear on the Judges numbers.

Race 5: SKY CHANNEL STAKES (1730 MBL)

This race commenced five minutes passed the advertised starting time when the Starter was obliged to turn the field away on the first occasion when the earplug on TAIHAPE TICKLER released prematurely due to the gelding's fractiousness and was future delayed on the second occasion when the head check clip had broken once again on TAIHAPE TICKLER resulting that gelding being placed on its last chance in the barrier draw.

ATLANTA GEORGIA – (Kim Young) broke gait free of interference on the home turn on the final occasions. Connections were advised that the gelding would not be permitted to race for six days and must complete one satisfactory trial.

NO BLUE MANNA – (Justin Warwick) raced three wide throughout.

Race 6: 2006 BURSWOOD PARK SPRING PACE (2130 MBL)

PEDAL TO THE METAL – (Ron Young) momentarily tightened and raced roughly, racing towards the front straight on the first occasion.

ATOMIC SEELSTER – (Callan Suvaljko) hung inwards momentarily racing towards the front straight on the first occasion. Race at the lead of the one wide line, gave ground over the concluding stages.

MIGHTY ASLAN – (Justin Warwick) held up and checked when being carried back through the field by a tiring runner.

LORD VERMAX – (Morgan Woodley) held up and inconvenienced when being carried back by a tiring runner.

JOHNSTAN MONEIL – (Ryan Warwick) underwent a veterinary examination upon arrival on course, when trainer John Graham reported the gelding had a stable mishap resulting in slight swelling to the near fore leg, however it was passed fit to run.

Race 7: BURSWOOD PARK ACADEMY OF GOLF HANDICAP (2503 SS)

DEMORALIZER – (Chris Lewis) began badly from the Standing Start, will be placed on its last chance in the barrier draw.

SEELSTER CUT – (Nicolaas Van Der Snoek) raced roughly as the start was effected.

ARABARAMA – (Clinton Hall) raced roughly as the start was effected.

JAKE THE MUS – (Justin Prentice) began badly from the Standing Start, will continue to be excluded from the Standing Start barrier draw.

Race 8: THE WILD CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2102 SS)

GIVONI – (Chris Lewis) the front centre carrier strap became detached entangling in the mare's legs, placing her at a disadvantage throughout.

EL PRESIDENTE – (Ryan Warwick) began slowly from the Standing start, held up before gaining clear running passing the 100m, returned with a flat tyre sustained at the 400m mark.
 EFFORTLESS – (Greg Schofield) galloped away from the Standing Start.
 FORWARD POCKET – (Brad Stampalia) jumped sideways at the start, will continue to be drawn wide in Standing Start events.

Race 9: BURSWOOD PARK CORPORATE GOLF CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2102 SS)

WATERLOO BAY – (Justin Warwick) galloped away from the Standing Start, obtained a late inside run.
 JASPER COUNTY – (Jon Gavin) galloped way from the Standing Start.
 CAPITOL V – (Colin Brown) galloped away from the Standing Start.
 RUMOR HAZIT – (Gregory Schofield) which raced at the lead of the one wide line, failed to run on over the concluding stages.
 BALTHAZAR – (Jason Vella) which led the field, shifted outwards under pressure approaching the finish.
 SPIN DOCTOR – (Morgan Woodley) returned following the race having cast the off hind plate in the front straight to receive the bell.
 CHELSEA VILLAGE – (Kade Howson) began badly from the Standing Start, will be excluded from the Standing Start barrier draw.
 ONAVENTURE – (Callan Suvaljko) began badly from the Standing Start, placed on its last chance in the barrier draw.

Race 10: SCHWEPPE TROTTERS STAKES (2130 MBL)

EXUBERANT – (Ryan Bell) which led the field throughout, failed to run over the concluding stages.

GENERAL

Gloucester Park 15th September 2006 Race 9 XXXX GOLD STAKES (2130 mobile)

Stewards inquired into the reason for ROLLON SEYMOUR (Shane Butterworth) and FLOYD BROMAC (Ryan Bell) jostling for some distance racing in the front straight to receive the bell. Shane Butterworth pleaded guilty to a charge of contributing to jostling (Rule 163(1)(a)) and was fined \$200. Ryan Bell was found guilty to a charge of contributing to jostling (Rule 163(1)(a)) and was fined \$200.
