Race 1: GLOUCESTER STANDARDBREDS YEARLING SALES TROTTERS STAKES (2130 MBL)

TRUSCOTT STORM – (Kim Young) the gelding sprung a hind plate enroute to the course. Connections were granted permission to race the gelding bare behind. Broke shortly after the start, was excluded from the mobile barrier draw.

DASH OF LIGHT – (Aldo Cortopassi) checked racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.

ROCKA BILLY – (Ryan Warwick) broke racing towards the front straight on the final occasion. Will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

DAVE STAR – (Bob Mellsop) raced roughly after the start.

RISK AND REWARD – (Aaron Skalecki) broke racing towards the front straight on the first occasion. It was subsequently established that the gelding broke when checked as a result of the pace easing in the one wide line. Under the circumstances, no action was taken.

Race 2: BE ACTIVE CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2503 SS)

CASHMORE VANCE – (Nathan Turvey) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the Standing Start draw. Checked racing into the back straight on the second occasion, gave ground over the concluding stages.

FORWARD POCKET – (Brad Stampalia) contacted a sulky and broke gait racing into the back straight on the second occasion when the pace eased.

Race 3: CHANNEL NINE CLAIMING STAKES (2130 MBL)

ONA REINBOW – (Shannon Suvaljko) hung outwards after the start, shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

IANALBERT – (Callan Suvaljko) which broke racing out of the back straight on the first occasion, will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

COBARGO WIND – (Nigel Johns) failed to run on over the concluding stages. The offside hopple shortening pin became entangled in the rear hopple loop in running placing the gelding at a disadvantage.

MAGIC LOCH – (Chris Lewis) jumped an object on the track racing out of the back straight on the second occasion and broke gait. Under the circumstances, no action was taken.

AUSSIE ATTACK – (Colin Brown) checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion and severely checked racing out of the back straight on the second occasion.

THE DIE IS CAST – (Brad Stampalia) severely checked racing out of the back straight on the second occasion, then was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

HONAN – (Matthew Scott) severely checked racing out of the back straight on the second occasion.

Race 4: GLOUCESTER STANDARDBREDS CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2503 SS)

The Starter was obliged to call a false start at the first attempt when CULLENS COVER failed to face the barrier.

TIGERS BEST – (Jason Woodworth) began badly, hung inwards slightly racing towards the back straight on the final occasion.

PERFECT ORDER – (Colin Brown) galloped out.

CULLENS COVER – (Callan Suvaljko) stood flat-footed at the start losing considerable ground. Placed on its last chance in Standing Start events.

VANLO YORKER – (Michael Tenardi) began badly. Pulled hard for a major part of the race and racing towards the back straight on the final occasion hung outwards, contacted a sulky wheel and broke gait. The gelding was placed on its last chance to race truly.

Race 5: 2007 WESTWOOLS 2YO COLTS & GELDINGS WA SALES CLASSIC FINAL (1730 MBL)

CUZIN JUDD – (Ron Young) held up in the early stages of the straight. Tightened, contacted a sulky and raced roughly over the concluding stages.

TORREVEAN RAIN – (Sam Torre) hung outwards after the start, placed on its last chance in the draw. Raced erratically at various stages and racing out of the back straight on the final occasion broke gait. Will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

JACKSRTUMPS – (Joe Suvaljko) checked shortly after the start. Racing towards the front straight on the first occasion contacted a sulky and broke gait when the pace in the one wide line eased slightly. Under the circumstances, no action was taken, however the driver was advised to be more aware in similar circumstances.

NO MEAN FEET – (Colin Brown) checked shortly after the start.

Race 6: 2007 WESTWOOLS 2YO FILLIES WA SALES CLASSIC FINAL (1730 MBL)

FURPHYS RAINBOW – (Callan Suvaljko) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

ART ON THE BEACH – (Terry Ferguson) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

SHOPPING SPREE – (Aldo Cortopassi) which broke racing out of the front straight on the first occasion and again racing in the front straight to receive the bell, will not be permitted to race for twenty eight days and until such time as it completes four satisfactory trials.

CLEVER DRAGON – (Ryan Warwick) was slightly out of position at release point. The driver was reprimanded under the provisions of Rule 162(1)(h). Obtained an inside run over the concluding stages.

BUCKING BEAUTY – (Colin Olsen) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

MADE OF DREAMS – (Colin Brown) inconvenienced racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

PARSONS STORM – (Justin Warwick) gave ground over the final stages.

Race 7: 2007 WESTWOOLS 3YO COLTS & GELDINGS WA SALES CLASSIC FINAL (2130 MBL)

BARJOHBIL – (Aiden Warwick) was held up until the final 100m.

CHOOKS REWARD – (Colin Brown) after being challenged for the lead on several occasions, failed to run on over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. An inquiry into the driving tactics was open and adjourned until 10.00am on Wednesday 28th February 2007.

CHESTERS CHARGE – (Callan Suvaljko) raced roughly racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.

MISTER MONA LISA – (Shannon Suvaljko) after challenging for the lead on several occasions, failed to run on over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. An inquiry into the driving tactics adopted was opened and adjourned until 10.00 am on Wednesday 28th February 2007.

TURBO DIESEL – (Beau Tindale) which was slow in the score up, was placed on its last chance in the mobile barrier draw. After performing poorly, the gelding will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

Race 8: 2007 WESTWOOLS 3YO FILLIES WA SALES CLASSIC FINAL (2130 MBL)

SAAB EXPRESS – (Beau Tindale) checked racing out of the front straight on the first occasion then failed to run on over the concluding stages.

MY SPECIALTY – (Garry Elliott) which began badly, trailing the field, was excluded from the mobile barrier draw.

General

An inquiry into the reason for SAAB EXPRESS (Beau Tindale) being checked racing out of the front straight on the first occasion, was adjourned to a time and date to be fixed as driver Jason Fry (IM GORGEOUS) was unavailable.

Race 9: 2007 SUMMER CUP (2130 MBL)

SILENT FIVE – (Stephen Reed) broke racing out of the back straight on the first occasion. It was established that the near side hopple shortening pin had released prematurely. Under the circumstances, no action was taken.

BLACK LINE – (Beau Tindale) completed the event with the middle hopple carrying strap detached and entangled in the geldings legs.

DUCATI – (Chris Lewis) which broke racing towards the front straight on the final occasion, will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

TRIAL BY JURY – (Kody Charles) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

BULLION BILL – (Adam Mellsop) raced roughly shortly after the start. Hung outwards racing in the front straight to receive the bell.

Race 10: 6IX JUNIOR DRIVER STAKES (2130 MBL)

YORK STAR – (Justin Prentice) hung inwards racing out of the back straight on the first occasion and was placed on its last chance to race truly. Unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

PATS DILEMMA – (James Schrader) was slightly out of position at release point.

NELSON STREET – (Ryan Hayter) was slightly out of position at release point.

HOLLYWOOD STRIDE – (Kody Charles) was severely checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for HOLLYWOOD STRIDE (Kody Charles) being severely checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion. It was established that YORK STAR (Justin Prentice) when being restrained by its driver, hung inwards quickly, despite the efforts of its driver, making contact with the front legs of HOLLWOOD STRIDE, which broke gait. YORK STAR was placed on its last chance to race truly
