#### **Race 1: PERTH PLASTERBOARD STAKES (2143 MBL)**

BRIGHT SIDE – (Chris Lewis) obtained an inside run over the concluding stages.  
FIVE COUGARS – (Kim Young) was held up until obtaining clear running inside the 100m.  
OSCAR LOMBO – (Colin March) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.  
SIMBOLO – (Justin Warwick) had a tendency to over race in the early and middle stages.

#### **Race 2: BORAL PLASTERBOARD HANDICAP (2503 SS)**

SERGEANT SANDS – (Stephen Miller) which began badly was placed on its last chance in the draw.  
JUSTALITTLEFELLA – (Justin Warwick) galloped out and was unable to obtain clear running over the concluding stages.  
AFTER THE RAIN – (Mark Reed) galloped briefly at the start.  
ISRALIES SON – (Ryan Bell) galloped out.  
ALBERT RAINER – (Colin Brown) which began badly will remain excluded from the Standing Start draw.  
OUR GOLDEN FINALE – (Jason Woodworth) which began badly was excluded from the Standing Start draw.

#### **Race 3: RC PLASTERING CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2503 SS)**

LITE RED – (Kate Kersley) galloped briefly at the start. Raced roughly racing towards the back straight on the first occasion when being eased to surrender the lead. Momentarily inconvenienced racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.  
JACCKA TAINE – (Kim Prentice) galloped briefly at the start then hung inwards racing towards and in the front straight on the final occasion.  
DISBANDED – (Vance Stampalia) which began badly will remain excluded from the Standing Start draw. Driver fined \$100 under Rule 154(1) for failing to immediately restrain the gelding to its correct gait.  
EASY MONEY – (Chris Lewis) galloped out.  
BUCK THE ODDS – (Aaron Skalecki) galloped briefly at the start.  
NATS NIFTY – (Callan Suvaljko) after racing wider on the track over the middle and late stages failed to run on.

#### **Race 4: 2006 PERTH PLASTERBOARD SALES CLASSIC 2YO COLTS & GELDINGS FINAL (1742 MBL)**

BAD LOSER – (Kevin Keys) hung inwards after the start and raced roughly making contact with several marker pegs. The colt was excluded from the mobile barrier draw.  
CAPGUN – (Colin Brown) which hung inwards slightly and broke racing out of the front straight on the first occasion will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.  
HILLVIEW STRIKE – (Ryan Bell) which broke racing out of the front straight on the first occasion, will not be permitted to race for fourteen days and until such time as it completes two satisfactory trials.  
ATHENS GEORGIA – (Callan Suvaljko) was momentarily inconvenienced racing in the back straight on the first occasion, gave ground over the concluding stages.

**Race 5: 2006 PERTH PLASTERBOARD SALES CLASSIC 2YO FILLIES FINAL (1742 MBL)**

RACY DEAGO – (Mark Reed) raced roughly shortly after the start. Racing in the back straight on the final occasion, hung inwards racing inside the line of the marker pegs for a short distance, a warning was issued.  
DORA THE DESTROYER – (Justin Warwick) which began badly was excluded from the mobile barrier draw. A warning was placed on the filly's racing manners for performing poorly.  
PURE GRACE – (Des Stockman) gave ground over the concluding stages.  
VILLAGE TEASE – (Ryan Bell) which raced roughly after the start was placed on its last chance in the draw. Raced roughly at various stages of the event. Trainer Mr Jesse Moore was advised to endeavour to correct the filly's racing characteristics otherwise action may be taken.

**Race 6: 2006 PERTH PLASTERBOARD SALES CLASSIC 3YO COLTS & GELDINGS FINAL (2143 MBL)**

LOMBO WAVE LINK – (Kim Prentice) raced fiercely at various stages placing the driver at a disadvantage. Driver reported that he had recommended a gear change to connections.  
NOMORE FORUSIR – (Colin Brown) after racing at the lead of the one wide line gave ground in the final lap. When questioned on the performance trainer explained that with hindsight he may have erred in effecting a gear change and as a result the gelding over raced before commencing to give ground. He further advised that he would make gear changes and would also consider trialling the gelding before racing it again.  
JUSTANOTHER FELLA – (Craig Goldfinch) the offside sulky tyre was flattened with just over 800m to travel.  
MICHAEL FINNIGAN – (Brad Stampalia) was slightly out of position at the start and then checked when giving ground racing into the front straight on the final occasion.  
WALESA – (Clinton Hall) had difficulty obtaining clear running in the early stages of the straight.  
SPORTS ADDA – (Ryan Bell) had difficulty obtaining clear running until the concluding stages.

**Race 7: 2006 PERTH PLASTERBOARD SALES CLASSIC 3YO FILLIES FINAL (2143 MBL)**

JUPITERS DARLING – (Ryan Bell) which raced roughly racing out of the back straight and towards the front straight on the first occasion was placed on its last chance to race truly.  
SOUTH CENTRAL RAIN – (Mark Reed) when attempting to regain a position in the one wide line contacted a sulky and broke racing in the front straight on the first occasion. Under the circumstances no action was taken.  
GO ON TEMPT ME – (Chris Beckett) was slightly out of position at release point.  
FRIDAY ON MY MIND – (Aldo Cortopassi) was slightly out of position at release point.  
RED HOT DATE – (Chris Lewis) hung inwards and broke racing out of the back straight to receive the bell and then continued to hang inwards from thereon. Trainer Mr Barry Warwick was advised that the filly would not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completed a satisfactory trial.

**Race 8: KINKY BOOTS STAKES (2143 MBL)**

JACCKA FROST – (Jon Gavin) which performed poorly underwent a post race veterinary examination, which revealed nothing amiss. Trainer Jon Gavin was advised that the gelding would not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it has completed a satisfactory trial.  
GIFTED OPERATOR – (Jason Woodworth) after leading the event gave ground over the concluding stages. When questioned on his driving tactics driver explained that he had been instructed that the gelding raced best in front and if possible to lead. He had therefore been reluctant to hand up to WESTICE when challenged for the lead. He further added had CRANKY JACK been racing at the lead of the one wide line at that time he would have considered handing up to that gelding.  
WESTICE – (Justin Prentice) when questioned on his driving tactics driver explained that he had been instructed that the gelding raced best when racing in the lead or at the lead of the one wide line and that if possible he was to race in either of those two positions and not hand up. It was the trainer's opinion that the gelding was not suited by racing behind other runners. Given that advice he had been reluctant to relinquish the lead of the one wide line when challenged by CRANKY JACK.  
CRANKY JACK – (Beau Tindale) after racing three wide in the early and middle stages before gaining the lead of the one wide line gave ground over the concluding stages. When questioned on his driving tactics driver explained that he had been instructed to attempt to gain the lead of the one wide line if possible. He therefore attempted to gain that position as he was of the view that WESTICE (Justin Prentice) would elect to obtain a trailing position on his drive as it was better performed. After issuing a challenge in the front straight on the first occasion he attempted to balance CRANKY JACK until racing into the back straight on completion of a lap when he again issued a strong challenge to gain the lead of the one wide line. The inquiry was adjourned until Monday afternoon.  
WESTERN APACHE – (Justin Warwick) raced three wide throughout.

**Race 9: MORE THAN JUST PLASTERBOARD MARES DISCRETIONARY HANDICAP (2503 SS)**

PROMISING GIFT – (Ryan Bell) racing out of the back straight on the final occasion when attempting to move wider on the track to avoid a tiring runner, made contact with a sulky wheel and broke gait. Under the circumstances no action was taken.

JESSICA CLARE – (Gary Hall Jnr) when began badly and jumped sideways losing considerable ground, trailed the field throughout. The mare was placed on its last chance in Standing Start events.

TOP OF THE LINE – (Chris Lewis) galloped out and then after leading the event performed poorly to finish at the rear of the field. Trainer Mr Neil Lloyd was advised that the mare would be placed on its last chance to race competitively.

SANA SANO – (Justin Prentice) was severely checked at the start.

AMARYLLIS SPIRIT – (Peter Tilbrook) was severely checked at the start.

**Race 10: KEITH LAVELLE HANDICAP (2907 SS)**

**General:** This race started approximately five minutes after the advertised time due to IAM CLIVE (Kim Prentice) having to leave the track to have a damaged breastplate replaced.

JACK FORCE – (Clinton Hall) which began badly was placed on its last chance in the draw. Unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

FIVEBYFIVE – (Colin Brown) gave ground over the concluding stages.

CASHMORE VANCE – (Mark McGuire) which broke shortly after the start was placed on its last chance in the draw.

ONAVENTURE – (Callan Suvaljko) had difficulty obtaining clear running to the finish.

ALKITTO – (Ryan Bell) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

MOTOR HOLMES – (Aaron Skalecki) which began badly will remain excluded from the Standing Start draw.

AUSSIE ATTACK – (Colin Reeves) galloped out and after being obliged to race wide on the track in the final stages gave ground.
