Race 1: WALK THERE TODAY 2YO STAKES (2130 MBL)

TARTARY SPARTACUS – (Grant Williams) raced roughly in the latter stages of the score up. Racing out of the back straight on the first occasion raced roughly for a short distance.

KEPT CALM – (Aldo Cortopassi) failed to run on over the final 800m. Driver reported that the colt completed the event with its tongue over the bit.

TUSCANY SON – (Greg Kersley) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

Race 2: HEALTHWAY 3YO STAKES (2130 MBL)

WALESA – (Clinton Hall) driver cautioned under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(d) for momentarily tightening a runner onto marker pegs racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.

MINDPLAY – (Mark Reed) was held up until inside the final 100m.

TOMS FELLA – (Grant Williams) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

PERFECTAMAI – (Joe Suvaljko) hung inwards and contacted a marker peg racing into the front straight on the first occasion.

MISTER RADAR – (Ryan Warwick) was tightened and contacted several marker pegs racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.

AREYOUENVIIOUS – (Callan Suvaljko) driver dropped his whip approaching the winning post.

Race 3: HEALTHY CHOICE 3YO STAKES (2130 MBL)

THE MIDNIGHT ROCKET – (Grant Williams) hung inwards racing out of the front straight on the first occasion.

Race 4: BE ACTIVE WALK IT JUNIOR DRIVER STAKES (2130 MBL)

OUR CHRISTIE LEE – (Morgan Woodley) raced three wide in the early stages and when being restrained to the rear of the field, over raced. Gave ground over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination revealed nothing amiss. Trainer Grant Williams was of the opinion that gear changes made for this evening's event had had an adverse effect and it was his intention to revert to the gear previously worn on the mare.

Race 5: BE ACTIVE EVERYDAY STAKES (2130 MBL)

IDEAL LAVROS – (Grant Williams) which broke racing out of the back straight on the first occasion, will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

ANOTHER TRAVELLER – (Colin Brown) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

IANALBERT – (Callan Suvaljko) raced roughly when being restrained racing out of the back straight on the first occasion. Was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

STOKE ON KENT – (Kade Howson) which led, failed to run on over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Driver and trainer Greg Harper were both disappointed in the performance which they could not explain as the gelding had been working well in the lead up to the race. TRUCKERS WARRIOR – (Donald Harper) was checked racing out of the back straight on the first occasion.

Race 6: 2006 BE ACTIVE AUGUST CUP (2536 MBL)

ALL IN TECK – (Morgan Woodley) severely checked racing out of the front straight on the final occasion.

DIAMOND PAUL – (Kim Young) checked racing out of the front straight on the final occasion.

SHARDONS AFLYIN – (Grant Williams) checked racing out of the front straight on the final occasion, failed to run on over the concluding stages.

HILTON ADONIS – (Justin Warwick) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

KOTARE FLAME – (Clinton Hall) after working hard in the early stages to lead, failed to run on over the concluding stages.

WHIZ BANG OPERA – (Aldo Cortopassi) checked racing out of the front straight on the final occasion, failed to run on from thereon.

EARL OF LOCKSLEY – (Callan Suvaljko) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

COSMIC FLIGHT – (Shannon Suvaljko) inconvenienced racing out of the front straight on the final occasion.

MONEY MAGNET – (Colin Brown) checked racing out of the front straight on the final occasion.

General

Stewards inquired into reason for MONEY MAGNET (Colin Brown) being checked racing out of the front straight on the final occasion. It was established that COSMIC FLIGHT (Shannon Suvaljko) had crossed towards the marker pegs to follow the inward movement of HILTON ADONIS (Justin Warwick) which raced to the lead at that point, however HILTON ADONIS switched off losing momentum quickly. Shannon Suvaljko was inconvenienced shifting outwards at that point causing MONEY MAGNET to be checked.

Race 7: BE ACTIVE FIND THIRTY HANDICAP (2503 SS)

THE ARCH DEACON – (Darren Kerr) which began badly, will remain excluded from the Standing Start draw.

LOMBO APOLLO – (Des Stockman) galloped out.

MR ACEMAN – (Mark Reed) galloped out.

Race 8: SLATER GARTRELL SPORTS HANDICAP (2503 SS)

MACHINE GUN – (Chris Lewis) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

BREAKING WAVES – (Donald Harper) which broke after the start, was placed on its last chance in the draw. Unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

PADDY O'BRIEN – (Kade Howson) which delayed the start by being fractious and then galloped out, will remain excluded from the Standing Start draw.

ETOILE DU NORD – (Clinton Hall) raced roughly after the start. Raced inside several marker pegs racing towards the front straight on the final occasion before obtaining an inside run.

General

Stewards delayed the All Clear to examine the circumstances of ETOILE DU NORD (Clinton Hall) racing inside several marker pegs prior to entering the front straight on the final occasion. Stewards were satisfied that the incident had no effect on the finishing position of ETOILE DU NORD and therefore gave the All Clear, however Mr Hall was reprimanded under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(c).

Race 9: HEART FOUNDATION MARES CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2102 SS)

THE ADMIRALS BYRD – (Wayne Price) severely checked when giving ground racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

GIVONI – (Grant Williams) raced roughly after the start. Raced roughly under pressure in the run to the finish.

PAYNIN – (Chris Lewis) was unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

BONSHAR – (Aldo Cortopassi) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw.

TILLY WINS – (Shannon Suvaljko) which began badly, will remain excluded from the Standing Start draw.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for THE ADMIRALS BYRD (Wayne Price) being severely checked racing out of the back straight on the final occasion. Jarrad Humphries (JUST BELLA) was found guilty to a charge of causing interference issued under the provisions of Rule 163(1)(a) and had his reinsperson's licence suspended for a period of sixteen days. In assessing penalty, Stewards took Mr Humphries excellent driving record into account.

Race 10: HEALTHY HEART CLAMINING STAKES (2536 MBL)

FREDDY RAMA – (John Filardo) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.
FRANCO NOVELLA – (Callan Suvaljko) shifted out slightly under pressure in the run to the finish.
NEXT BELLE – (Ryan Warwick) was tightened over the concluding stages.
MONEY MASTER – (Mark Reed) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.
DEMORALIZER – (John Sangalli) raced roughly racing out of the front straight on the first occasion, was held up for a clear run to the finish.

General

SMARTY ART and RAP TALK were both claimed prior to this event.

GENERAL

RACE 2: NEIL & ROY PACE CENTRAL WHEATBELT SUNDAY 13TH AUGUST 2006

Stewards concluded an inquiry into the whip action of Mr John Sangalli (DOCS ORDERS) over the concluding stages.

After taking evidence from Mr Sangalli and viewing the film, Stewards found him guilty of a charge issued under the provisions of Rule 168(1) for driving in an improper manner in that he attempted to strike the driver or the horse to his outside racing in the home straight. Mr Sangalli's reinsperson's licence was suspended for six weeks up to and including 6th October 2006.
