Race 1: MORE 'F' FUN 2YO FILLIES STAKES (1730 MBL)

MISS ANVIL – (Grant Williams) which led the field throughout, shifted outwards under pressure approaching the finish.

DUSTY ROSE – (Chris Lewis) broke gait free of interference racing out of the front straight on the first occasion, will be stood down for a period of six days and must complete one satisfactory trial. Locked wheels when being forced wider in the front straight to receive the bell.

OUR JODI LEE – (Ryan Warwick) broke gait in the front straight to receive the bell, was retired from the event.

EMMA GRACE – (Aldo Cortopassi) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

RAINBOW DRAGON – (Joe Suvaljko) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

LAST IMPULSE – (Brad Stampalia) obtained a late inside run.

General

Stewards inquired into the reason for OUR JODI LEE (Ryan Warwick) breaking gait in the front straight to receive the bell. It was established when taken to a three wide position obliging DUSTY ROSE wider on the track, locked wheels momentarily and with the momentum of DUSTY ROSE carried OUR JODI LEE forward accidentally contacting the sulky wheel of SHEZA CLOUT. No action was taken in the circumstances.

Race 2: PUNT AND PUTT COMPETITION STAKES (2536 MBL)

STAR ALLIANCE – (Brad Stampalia) began badly, will be excluded from the mobile barrier draw. After commencing a three wide forward move to race at the lead of the one wide line, had a tendency to over race.

VANDERARDEN – (Mark Reed) gave ground over the concluding stages.

RENOUCE – (Nigel Johns) inconvenienced racing towards the back straight on the first occasion.

MIDNIGHT CHILL – (Susan Roberts) gave ground over the concluding stages.

FIVE COUGARS – (Grant Williams) hung inwards at various stages.

SCENIC SAGA – (Callan Suvaljko) accidentally contacted a sulky and raced roughly.

ELITE ARMBRO – (Justin Prentice) inconvenienced racing towards the back straight on the first occasion. Returned with a flat tyre sustained at the 600m.

HIGHLANDER HANOVER – (Donald Harper) inconvenienced after the start.

Race 3: BE ACTIVE STAKES (2130 MBL)

MEGAINTEREST – (Ray Retzlaff) raced roughly as the start was effected, placed on its last chance in the barrier draw.

MORGANATOR – (Donald Harper) checked, racing into the front straight on the final occasion when being carried back by tiring runners.

LUCKY PUNCH – (Ryan Bell) hung inwards whilst racing in a three wide position prior to leading the one wide line. Failed to run on over the concluding stages.

WENEEDA EARL – (Gary Hall Jnr) driver was advised to make a greater effort to be in position at the start.

UMERE LAD – (Mark Reed) inconvenienced as the start was effected.

Race 4: BURSWOOD ENTERTAINMENT COMPLEX STAKES (2130 MBL)

DAY IN MANHATTEN – (David Young) failed to muster speed at the start, held up in the home straight until passing the 100m mark before gaining clear running approaching the finish.

SHEZA STAR – (Martin Wilson) which raced at the lead of the one wide line before obtaining a trail in the middle stages, performed poorly to finish some distance at the rear. A veterinary examination following the race revealed swelling to the near side tendon and will be stood down for a period of six days and must complete one satisfactory trial. A veterinary Certificate of Soundness is required.

TAIHAPE TICKLER – (Gary Hall Jnr) broke gait free of interference in the front straight on the first occasion, was retired from the event shortly after. A veterinary examination following the race revealed atrial fibrillation, the gelding will be stood down for a period of six days and must complete one satisfactory trial.

Race 5: ARNOTT'S TASTY JACKS MARES STAKES (1730 MBL)

MOTU FLARE AND STYLE – (Ryan Warwick) checked and carried back by tiring runners from the 400m to the 200m.

SANA SANO – (Justin Prentice) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

ANGRYLITTLEBEAVER – (Stephen Reed) raced three wide for the majority of the event before being restrained to the rear.

PARIS HEARTBEAT – (Steven Jelf) after racing at the lead of the one wide line from its wide barrier, gave ground over the concluding stages.

Race 6: 2006 PAST PRESIDENTS CUP (2536 MBL)

IONTHEBALL – (Clinton Hall) inconvenienced in the back straight on the first occasion when the speed eased. After commencing a three wide forward move from the 1100m performed poorly to finish some distance at the rear. A veterinary examination following the race revealed no abnormalities, placed on its last chance to race competitively.

BUCK THE ODDS – (Mark Reed) inconvenienced in the back straight on the first occasion when the speed eased.

EARL OF LOCKSLEY – (Callan Suvaljko) inconvenienced in the back straight on the first occasion when the speed eased.

Race 7: TOYOTA GENUINE PARTS, SERVICE & ACCESSORIES CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2102 SS)

This race commenced five minutes passed the advertised starting time when KNIGHTWORKMAN delayed the start and was re-handicapped to the outside of the front line at the same time the barrier strand had entangled in the sulky wheel of ETOILE DE NORD adding to the delay.

NEXT BELLE – (Chris Lewis) began badly, however no action was taken because of the delay.

KNIGHTWORKMAN – (Adam Mellsop) excluded right out of the draw in Standing Start events.

THE JOBS ON – (Gary Hall Jnr) began badly, no action was taken due to the delay, trailed the field thereafter.

General

The Stewards delayed the All Clear when Starter Mr Colin Campbell advised the Stewards that he was of the opinion that SMOOTH ADVANCE may have been denied the opportunity of a fair start. Matthew Scott driver upon returning to scale wished to view the film to determine whether SMOOTH ADVANCE was denied the opportunity of a fair start. After viewing those films on a number occasion, taking evidence from Matthew Scott, Stewards were satisfied that SMOOTH ADVANCE was denied the opportunity of a fair start and declared SMOOTH ADVANCE a non-runner. Stewards ordered all monies to be refunded on SMOOTH ADVANCE and deductions from winning bets were made in accordance with RWWA Rule of Wagering 56.

Race 8: ALLTOOLS HANDICAP (2503 SS)

ARABARAMA – (Mark Reed) raced roughly at the start. Underwent a veterinary examination following the race when it was revealed that the gelding had returned with a puncture wound to the near fore hoof. No treatment was required. Trainer Jason Fry advised that he would have his veterinary surgeon examine the horse in the coming days.

SPIN DOCTOR – (Ryan Warwick) galloped briefly at the start.

RYLEE JO – (Clinton Kimes) galloped briefly at the start.

I LIKE IT – (Chris Lewis) began badly from the Standing Start, placed on its last chance in the barrier draw. Accidentally contacted a sulky wheel at the winning post with a lap to run and blundered momentarily.,

CLINTONS CIGAR - (Kim Prentice) inconvenienced in restricted room in the closing stages.

PAYNIN – (Aaron Beckett) tightened in restricted room at the winning post with a lap to run.

BIG RIVE HANOVER – (Aaron Skalecki) jumped sideways at the start.

ANOTHER TRAVELLER – (Jarrad Humphries) checked at the start.

FORWARD POCKET – (Brad Stampalia) began badly from the Standing Start, placed on its last chance in the barrier draw.

Race 9: SWAN BREWERY 3YO FILLIES STAKES (2130 MBL)

ROLL ON DISCO – (Kim Young) which led the field throughout, shifted outwards under pressure approaching the finish.

OUR VANESSA – (Beau Tindale) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

BACK IN THE BLACK- (Aaron Beckett) out of position at the start, driver reprimanded under the provisions of Rule 162(1)(i).

SO PERFECT – (Mark Reed) obtained an inside run and in so doing contacted several marker pegs. Driver reminded of his obligations in similar circumstances.

FRIDAY ON MY MIND – (Aldo Cortopassi) held up, failed to gain clear running approaching the finish.

Race 10: 6PR SPORTS CENTRAL CLAIMING STAKES (1730 MBL)

TAR SEELED – (Hayden Charles) gave ground over the concluding stages.

SUNSET SCOTT – (Jason Vella) had a tendency to over race whilst racing at the lead of the one wide line, gave ground over the concluding stages and claimed following the event.

MACAR – (Phillip Duggan) which raced three wide throughout, gave ground over the concluding stages.

GENERAL

Stewards concluded their inquiry into Donald Harper's (PERFECT SPRING) driving tactics in race 5 THE EMU BITTER STAKES at Geraldton on 23rd July 2006.

After considering the evidence tendered by Mr Harper, trainer Sam Torre, viewing the official video film and from their observations Mr Harper was reprimanded under Rule 149(1) which states:- "A driver shall take all reasonable and permissible measures to ensure that the horse driven by that driver is given full opportunity to win or obtain the best possible placing in the field".

As by electing to shift to the pegs from the one wide line at the 1200m, was held up for a clear run until entering the front straight and ran home strongly.
