RACE 1: DBC VALLEY SPRING LAMB STAKES (1730 MBL)

PERFECT SPRING – (Shane Butterworth) when questioned on his driving tactics, in particular, his reasons for rating a 28.0 third quarter of the final mile, driver explained that the gelding had commenced to over race despite his efforts at that point. Further, he advised that PERFECT SPRING had not shown its customary gate speed and his opinion may not be suited to racing consistently over sprint distances. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Trainer, Tracey Reed confirmed that the gelding had been working well in the lead up to this evening's race. It was now her intention to vary the distance of its future race starts and she would also endeavour to make minor gear adjustments in an effort to assist the gelding to race more tractably.

UMERE LAD – (Kade Howson) when questioned on his driving tactics, in particular, his reasons for commencing a three wide move racing out of the back straight to receive the bell to gain the lead of the one wide line racing out of the front straight on the final occasion, driver explained, given that the moderate 29.6 second quarter he had elected to gain a forward position racing outside the leader. The gelding, however, had not been suited by the up-tempo 28.0 third quarter.

MATTY JACCKA – (Mark Reed) driver reported that the sulky seat became loose turning into the front straight on the final occasion placing him at a disadvantage.

RACE 2: DBC TIMBER HILL PORT CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2102 SS)

The Starter was obliged to call a false start at the first attempt when MYSTYS GIRL (Beau Tindale) broke through the barrier prematurely. Beau Tindale was fined \$100 under the provisions of Rule 136(1) for having anticipated the start.

SHINING KEY – (Gary Hall Jnr) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

RACE 3: DBC ORIGINAL FERGUSON VALLEY VEAL MARES STAKES (1730 MBL)

FALCONOVA – (Nicolaas Van Der Snoek) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

NITRO NINA – (Giles Inwood) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

EVER SO FAIR – (Ryan Warwick) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

RACE 4: DBC EVERTENDER 3YO FILLIES STAKES (2130 MBL)

PARSONEMBY – (Callan Suvaljko) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish. Driver reprimanded under the provisions of Rule 168(1) for failing to make sufficient effort to straighten the filly.

MISS SHANLEY – (Justin Prentice) after commencing a three wide move in the middle stages, raced wide from thereon before giving ground over the concluding stages.

AMONGST ROYALTY – (Chris Lewis) had difficulty obtaining clear running in the late stages.

RACE 5: EASY FOR ME WITH DBC STAKES (2130 MBL)

Nothing to report.

RACE 6: LOU & MARG AUSTIN STAKES (2536 MBL)

PATCHES – (Vance Stampalia) contacted a sulky and raced roughly racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

RACE 7: 2007 DBC TENDER RIDGE 2YO FILLIES STATE SIRES SERIES FINAL (1730 MBL)

SAVE ON ME – (Chloe Tindale) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

MELEXY GOLD – (Aldo Cortopassi) raced roughly and broke shortly after the start. After galloping for a considerable distance was retired from the event racing in the back straight on the first occasion. A post race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be sore in the off fore. Will not be permitted to race or trial until a veterinary certificate of soundness is produced.

KETCHIKAN – (Kim Prentice) broke racing out of the front straight on the first occasion. Will not be permitted to race for fourteen days, and until the completion of two satisfactory trials. Trainer advised that the filly would now be spelled.

HILO DIVA – (Stephen Reed) checked racing into the back straight on the first occasion.

ORION EXPRESS – (Sam Torre) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

DIAL A TAXI – (Mark Reed) hung outwards in the latter stages of the score up. Severely checked racing into the back straight on the first occasion.

APACHE SUNRISE – (Ryan Warwick) inconvenienced shortly after the start. Checked racing into the back straight on the first occasion.

RACE 8: DBC TALK ABOUT TASTE HANDICAP (2503 SS)

VINTAGE TRAPPER – (Giles Inwood) began badly, placed on its last chance in the draw. Momentarily eased racing in the back straight on the first occasion.

CRYSTAL JOURNEY – (Kade Howson) began badly, placed on its last chance in the draw.

FINEGANS WAKE – (Vance Stampalia) galloped out.

LADY DE BEAU – (Chris Lewis) commenced slowly.

RACE 9: AUSTRALIAN ROAD RESCUE ORGANISATION HANDICAP (2503 SS)

General

The start of this race was delayed slightly due to the hobbles on LOADING STAR (Donald Harper) having been fitted incorrectly. Trainer Prue Willis was fined \$100 (Rule 225)

HYPOTHERMIA – (Mark Reed) raced roughly after the start. Shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

PAEKAKARIKI EXPRESS – (Jason Woodworth) began badly, placed on its last chance in the draw.

BELL OPERATIVE – (Shane Young) galloped out.

WHOSYOURDADDAY – (Aiden Warwick) galloped out.

EAGLE EYE LOMBO – (Michael Plozza) began badly, excluded from the Standing Start draw.

WENEEDA EARL – (Brian Ferguson) began badly, excluded from the Standing Start draw.

RACE 10: WESTERN RESCUE 2007 CLAIMING STAKES (2536 MBL)

CRANKY JACK – (Callan Suvaljko) gave ground over the concluding stages.

IMAGREEKTOO – (Tonia Stampalia) after racing wide in the early stages before gaining the lead of the one wide line gave ground to finish a considerable distance from the remainder of the field. Placed on its last chance to race competitively.

TOTAL MOTIVATION – (Shane Young) failed to run on over the concluding stages.
