Race 1: BE ACTIVE WALK IT STAKES (1730 MBL)

ELITE ARMBRO – (Kim Prentice) raced roughly racing towards the back straight on the first occasion.
RIEWOLDT – (Justin Warwick) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

Race 2: CLUB BURSWOOD STAKES (2130 MBL)

MINDLIKEA DIAMOND – (Mark Reed) commenced slowly.
BULLION BILL – (Bob Mellsop) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

Race 3: HEALTHWAY CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2503 SS)

MAL MCGREGOR – (Brad Stampalia) galloped out, checked racing in the back straight on the final occasion.
FLOYD BROMAC – (Andrew De Campo) raced roughly after the start.
VINTAGE TRAPPER – (Craig Goldfinch) raced roughly racing into the back straight on the first occasion and then broke racing into the back straight on the final occasion. Driver was of the opinion that the gelding had cross fired at various stages. Will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.
VANLO YORKER – (Greg Bennett) held up until obtaining a clear run over the concluding stages.

Race 4: SKY CHANNEL WA DERBY CONSOLATION (2536 MBL)

CAPTAIN BLUFF – (Ryan Bell) the offside deafener released prematurely and as a result the gelding had a tendency to race erratically at various stages. Racing off the back straight on the final occasion made contact with a sulky wheel and raced roughly. Racing towards the front straight on the final occasion when the driver was attempting to manover wider when not in a position do so, made contact with a sulky wheel and broke gait.
KAMWOOD TITAN – (Stephen Reed) severely checked and fell racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.
ICE COOL JAKE – (Gary Hall Jnr) severely checked and dislodged its driver racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.
OHOKAS POCKET – (David Pellew) checked racing towards the front straight on the final occasion.
CASSIE ROX – (Kevin Keys) inconvenienced racing in the front straight to receive the bell as runners shifted to its inside.

General

Prior to the All Clear Kevin Keys driver of the fifth place CASSIE ROX requested a viewing of the official films to ascertain whether or not he had grounds for protesting against the third placed CAPTAIN BLUFF (Ryan Bell), however after viewing the videos he elected not to proceed with the matter.

Stewards inquired into the reason for CAPTAIN BLUFF (Ryan Bell) contacting a sulky and breaking gait racing towards the front straight on the final occasion severely checking other runners. Ryan Bell pleaded guilty to a charge of careless driving issued under the provisions of Rule 168(1) for attempting to move wider on the track when not in a position to do so and making contact with a sulky. Had his reinsperson's licence

suspended for a period of twenty two days. The commencement of the penalty was deferred to enable Mr Bell to complete his driving engagements on Tuesday 3rd April 2007.

Race 5: 2007 BURSWOOD ENTERTAINMENT COMPLEX EMPRESS STAKES (2536 MBL)

MON POPPY MIA – (Mark Reed) performed poorly to finish some distance from the remainder of the field. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Trainer was extremely disappointed with the performance and advised he intended having the mare undergo a full veterinary examination and would report any findings to the Stewards. MON POPPY MIA will not be permitted to race for a period of six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

PRECIOUS MAIDEN – (Ryan Warwick) held up until entering the front straight on the final occasion.

Race 6: 2007 SKY CHANNEL WA DERBY (GROUP 1) (2536 MBL)

BARJOHBIL – (Aiden Warwick) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

LIVELY EXIT – (Greg Bennett) broke at the apex of the turn racing towards the front straight on the final occasion. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Trainer was extremely disappointed with the performance and could offer no explanation. LIVELY EXIT will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

CHOOKS REWARD – (Colin Brown) racing in the back straight on the final occasion when being taken inwards towards the marker pegs, raced erratically and despite the efforts of its driver, raced inside the marker pegs for some distance before giving ground over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination revealed nothing amiss. The colt will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

Race 7: BE ACTIVE EVERYDAY AUSTRALIAN PACING CHAMPIONSHIP CONSOLATION (2130 MBL)

OK WINDERMERE – (Chris Lewis) shifted out slightly in the run to the finish.

LEFT PRIDE – (Kevin Keys) which began badly, was excluded from the mobile barrier draw.

JAILBIRD – (Kim Prentice) held up until obtaining a late inside run.

Race 8: 2007 BE ACTIVE AUSTRALIAN PACING CHAMPIONSHIP (GROUP 1) (2130 MBL)

LOOKSLIKELIGHTNING – (Mark Reed) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

LUCKY PUNCH – (Kade Howson) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

FLASHING RED – (Anthony Butt) after being taken three wide in the middle stages, raced wide from thereon before giving ground over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Trainer was of the opinion that the horse had not been suited by the circumstances of the race.

Race 9: BE ACTIVE TRIP TO GOLD COAST CONDITIONED HANDICAP (2102 SS)

The start was delayed by several minutes due to JACCKA LAIRD (Gary Hall Jnr), WIZARD OF SCAR (Ian Davie) and MORGANATOR (Nathan Turvey) being fractious. At the first attempt at the start, the Starter was obliged to call a false start when the 10m barrier strand failed to fully clear the track severely inconveniencing TROUBLESCENE (Justin Warwick) and FORDVIEW TIME OUT (Chris Lewis). At the second attempt at a start, JACCKA LAIRD continued to be fractious and was ordered to start from the outside of the front.

JACCKA LAIRD – (Gary Hall Jnr) delayed the start and was excluded from the Standing Start draw.

BABY JAMES – (Callan Suvaljko) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

WIZARD OF SCAR – (Ian Davie) delayed the start, was excluded from the Standing Start draw. Unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

LETHAL POWER – (Ryan Bell) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

RENOUNCE – (Nigel Johns) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

LEFT A COOKIE – (Shannon Suvaljko) unable to obtain a clear run to the finish.

General

Stewards delayed the All Clear to determine whether MORGANATOR (Nathan Turvey) had been denied the opportunity of a fair start. After viewing the video replays of the start, interviewing the Starter and Mr Turvey, Stewards declared MORGANATOR a non-starter. As in their opinion the gelding had reared and swung sideways prior to the barriers being released. All bets made on MORGANATOR were refunded. Deductions from winning bets were made in accordance with RWWA Rule of Wagering 56. MORGANATOR was excluded from the Standing Start draw.

Race 10: BURSOOD POKER – ALL IN TROTTERS DISCRETIONARY HANDICAP (2503 SS)

DASH OF LIGHT – (Hayden Charles) commenced slowly. Broke racing out of the front straight on the first occasion and again racing into the back straight on the first occasion losing considerable ground. Placed on its last chance to race truly.

NACOKEE – (Natalie Duffy) stood flat footed and then swung sideways at the start losing considerable ground. Excluded from the Standing Start draw.

PRIDE OF ALHAMBRA – (Colin Brown) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

COUNT THE LUTE – (Callan Suvaljko) checked at the start.

DAVE STAR – (Bob Mellsop) checked at the start.

GENERAL

Gloucester Park Tuesday 13th March 2007 Race 6 XXXX GOLD DISCRETIONARY HANDICAP (2503 SS)

On Thursday 29th March 2007, Stewards concluded an inquiry into the manner in which Jarrad Humphries (TIRANO PALEFACE) shifted from the marker pegs inside PAISLEYS MARCH (Wayne Price) racing out of the front straight on the first occasion. Mr Humphries pleaded guilty to a charge of improper driving issued under the provisions of Rule 168(1) in that when shifting wider he leaned to his right putting his right elbow onto PAISLEYS MARCH which raced roughly. His reinsperson's licence was suspended for a period of six weeks with immediate effect.
