Race 1: DBC TALK ABOUT TASTE JUNIOR DRIVER STAKES (2536 MBL)

BRILLIANT VIEW – (Nicolaas Van Der Snoek) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish and on the winning post made broke gait when being eased in restricted room. The driver was reminded of his obligations.

NORTH SEA ADMIRAL – (Morgan Woodley) was unable to obtain clear running until passing the 100m.

SOVEREIGN FELLA – (Beau Tindale) had a tendency to hang outwards at various stages.

Race 2: MORE 'F' IN FUN HANDICAP (2503 SS)

SEELSTER CUT – (Nicolaas Van Der Snoek) galloped briefly at the start. Was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

AWESOME ELLA – (Colin Brown) raced roughly at the start.

THE JOBS ON – (Mark Reed) which began badly, was placed on its last chance in the draw.

ISRALIES SON – (Shane Butterworth) which broke shortly after the start, was excluded from the Standing Start draw.

Race 3: DBC TIMBER HILL PORK MARES STAKES (1730 MBL)

BABY MAKER – (Kim Prentice) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

PARIS HEARTBEAT – (Steven Jelf) shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

RIDE SALLY RIDE – (Murray Lindau) commenced to race roughly racing out of the back straight on the first occasion and broke gait racing into the front straight on the first occasion before being retired from the event.

A post race veterinary examination revealed a laceration to the off fore leg. The mare will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it has completed a satisfactory trial.

SOVEREIGN BEEJAY – (Callan Suvaljko) was momentarily inconvenienced racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

Race 4: SWAN BREWERY STAKES (2130 MBL)

HALF HITCH – (Joe Suvaljko) which gave ground over the final 600m to finish some distance from the remainder of the field, will not be permitted to race in the metropolitan area until such time as it has regained form.

EASY ON THE POCKET – (Mark Reed) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

JAMES VICTOR – (Ryan Warwick) had difficulty obtaining clear running to the finish.

COLORADO CODE – (Chris Lewis) racing towards the front straight on the first occasion when being eased to a position in the one wide line, raced roughly for a short distance.

ANOTHER TRAVELLER – (Jarrad Humphries) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

Race 5: DBC VALLEY SPRING LAMB STAKES (1730 MBL)

JUSTABITJOLLY – (Chris Lewis) pulled hard when leading opening up a considerable gap on the field in the middle stages, however gave ground over the final 800m to finish some distance from the remainder of the field. A post race veterinary examination revealed nothing amiss. Trainer Mrs Carol Warwick was advised the

gelding would not be permitted to race for fourteen days and until such time as it has completed two satisfactory trials. She advised that the gelding would be sent for an immediate spell.

Race 6: 2006 DBC TENDER RIDGE 2YO FILLIES STATE SIRES SERIES FINAL (1730 MBL)

SAABS SIBLING – (David Young) hung outwards racing in the back straight on the final occasion and gave ground over the concluding stages.

SHEER DREAMS – (Mark Reed) hung inwards and raced inside the line of the marker pegs racing out of the back straight on the final occasion when commencing to give ground.

AMONGST ROYALTY – (Chris Lewis) broke racing towards the back straight on the first occasion. After racing three wide throughout, failed to run on over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Co-trainer Mr Sam Torre was advised the filly would not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

MISS NARLA – (Ryan Warwick) raced roughly racing out of the back straight on the final occasion.

DUCHESS OF BATH – (Kim Prentice) the driver momentarily dropped his right leg from the sulky rest racing into the front straight on the final occasion.

Race 7: BE ACTIVE STAKES (2130 MBL)

General

CULLENS COVER (Clinton Hall) underwent a veterinary examination after the driver expressed concern at a respiratory sound the gelding had made whilst undergoing its preliminary. CULLENS COVER was passed fit to start. As a result of the veterinary examination this race started approximately three minutes after the advertised start time.

MEGAINTEREST – (Ray Retzlaff) locked wheels racing out of the front straight on the final occasion.

LEVITYS RAINBOW – (Mark McGuire) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

JESSICA CLARE – (Mark Reed) hung inwards at the start and raced roughly. A warning was placed on its barrier manners. Severely checked racing towards the front straight on the first occasion.

CULLENS COVER – (Clinton Hall) severely checked racing towards the front straight on the first occasion.

FAKE EMBRACE – (Kim Prentice) inconvenienced racing towards the front straight on the first occasion.

When questioned on the performance, trainer Kim Prentice explained that prior to the gelding's previous run at Gloucester Park on the 23rd June it had not raced for two weeks therefore he had increased its workload between starts. This combined with the gelding having worked hard in the early stages of that race had contributed to the improved performance. Since that run he had eased the gelding's workload. As the gelding appeared suited by this approach he would continue to work it sparingly between race starts.

HONAN – (Matthew Scott) which broke racing towards the front straight on the first occasion, will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial. Locked wheels racing out of the front straight on the final occasion.

Race 8: DBC ORIGINAL FERGUSON VALLEY VEAL HANDICAP (2503 SS)

DALLAS FLIGHT – (Clinton Hall) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

LIQUOR LAD – (Jason Vella) which began badly, was excluded from the Standing Start draw for four satisfactory race or trial starts.

GOOD HEAVENS HOLMES – (Mark Reed) was unable to obtain clear running to the finish.

FORWARD POCKET – (Ryan Warwick) which galloped out will remain excluded from the Standing Start draw.

ALL IN TECK – (Mark McGuire) which galloped out will remain excluded from the Standing Start draw. When questioned on his driving tactics, in particular his reasons for commencing a three wide move with approximately 1200m to travel driver explained that at that stage with what he considered to be his two main dangers racing in forward positions he elected to endeavour to improve his position. These tactics had not suited the gelding, which in future would be driven more conservatively.

Race 9: TOYOTA GENUINE PARTS, SERVICE & ACCESSORIES JUNIOR DRIVER STAKES (2536 MBL)

SORRENTO TUESDAY – (David Young) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

REIGNING SUCCESS – (John Jelf) failed to run on over the concluding stages.

ELITE ARMBRO – (Justin Prentice) raced roughly shortly after the start when being eased and again raced roughly racing towards the back straight on the first occasion. After commencing a three wide move racing in for the bell failed to run on over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination revealed nothing amiss. When questioned on the performance trainer Kim Prentice explained that the gelding had not been suited by racing wider on the track over the final lap as it brushes its knees in those situations.

Race 10: DBC TENDER RIDGE BEEF CLAIMING STAKES (2536 MBL)

SON OF A BEACH – (Martin Wilson) was severely checked racing towards the back straight on the final occasion.

SMARTY ARTY – (Ryan Warwick) was claimed.

MON SHEKHAN – (Wesley Andrews) which hung inwards and broke gait racing towards the back straight on the final occasion, will not be permitted to race for six days and until such time as it completes a satisfactory trial.

GENERAL

Gloucester Park Friday 23rd June 2006 Race 3 BE ACTIVE STAKES (2536m MBL)

Stewards questioned Donald Harper (MORGANATOR) into his reasons for failing to move wider on the track in the back straight on the final occasion when racing behind the tiring FAKE EMBRACE (Justin Prentice). Mr Harper explained he had anticipated being carried further into the race by FAKE EMBRACE. He did not initially realise that FAKE EMBRACE had commenced to give ground and as a result had not moved wider on the track. In hindsight he conceded that he had erred in his tactics but he had been mindful of trainer Mr Anderson's advice that MORGANATOR was best suited when driven with cover for as long as possible and had difficulty in making ground wide on the final turn. Stewards advised Mr Harper that in their opinion he had erred in his tactics, however taking his relevant inexperience into account took no action over the matter other than to remind him in the strongest terms of his obligations to ensure that all his drives were given full opportunity to win or obtain the best possible placing.
