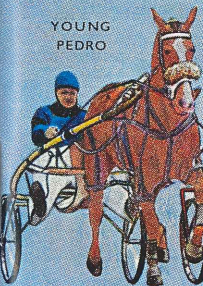

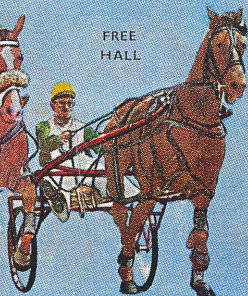

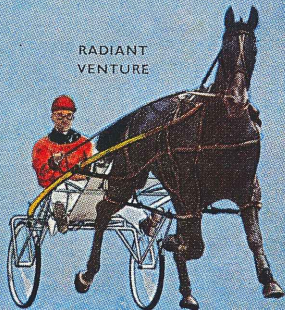

STEWARDS' REPORT

WAYVILLE — WEDNESDAY, 13th FEBRUARY, 1963

Brisbane Handicap:

RADIANT FORTUNE (D. Toole) broke immediately after the start and dropped back through the field. Toole stated that his horse appeared sour and it is his intention to spell him for some weeks.

PLEASANT HALL and RADIANT BARBARA collided at the start, causing PLEASANT HALL to break. AMPERE suffered interference as a result of this scrimmage.

Inter Dominion Championship (1st Div.):

GENDARME and MARY MAVIS missed the start and BLUE MARLIN broke when pulled away sharply to miss one of the horses on the front line.

A. Turner (MARY KATHLEEN) was reprimanded for driving too close behind MARY MAVIS, causing inconvenience to the driver of that horse.

Inter-Dominion Championship (2nd Div.):

As the field made the top turn in the first lap, a sudden check caused BLACK DOUGLAS to hit the back of CELE's gig and break. SHADY ACRES, which was coming fast from behind, ran over BLACK DOUGLAS' wheel and unseated Gilbert. Gilbert was dragged for some considerable distance behind his gig, but managed to scramble back on to his seat and continue in the race. JIDALUK received a bad check as a result of this incident.

V. L. Dullard Free-for-All:

R. Hearl (RED ENVOY) was severely reprimanded for allowing his horse to gallop for some considerable distance after it had broken. He was told that only the fact his horse lost ground in the break, he would have been disqualified from the race. He was warned against a repetition.

Inter-Dominion Championship (3rd Div.):

STAUNCH OAK, BEAU DESIGN, FIRST DIVISION and LAST COMMAND missed the start.

At the request of the Police Department the following by-law under the Adelaide Showgrounds Act (1929) is published for the information of patrons.

CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR

- (1) No person shall at any time on the Showgrounds, without the written consent of the Council, consume any liquor whatsoever except in such booths, luncheon or refreshment rooms, stalls or other places as set apart by the Council for the consumption of liquor.
- (2) Whereas any consent is given in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (1) of this by-law, the Council may impose any terms or conditions it thinks fit and if any person consume liquor otherwise than in accordance with such terms and conditions or any of them, he shall be guilty of an offence.
- (3) In this by-law "liquor" shall have the same meaning as assigned to it in Section 4 of the Licensing Act, 1922-1945.

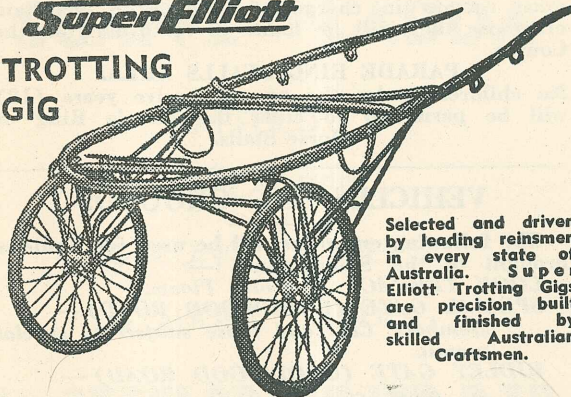
